Torch burns bright for cinema couple

THEY may have had no time for wedding pictures or a honeymoon when they married, but devoted couple Mervyn and Shirley Adams have shared a lifetime of love.

And while they missed out on wedding day photos, the happy couple certainly made sure their golden wedding celebrations were captured on film for posterity as they celebrated reaching the marvellous marriage milestone with family and friends.

Mr and Mrs Adams, of Newtown, in Tadley, tied the knot in Kingsclere's register office in August 1957, in the middle of harvest time.

Mr Adams, who lived on a farm, said: "After the wedding, we went straight back to the farm to do the combine harvesting."

Mrs Adams, who turns 70 on September 8, said: "We met at the Savoy Cinema in Basingstoke, where I used to work as an usherette."

Mr Adams, now 78, added: "I would ride my bike from Baughurst and she used to issue the tickets and then show us to our seats in the dark with a torch."

Both from large families - Mr Adams is the second of nine children and his wife is one of four girls - the couple have brought up four daughters of their own.

After a few different homes, they moved to a small cottage in Newtown in the early 1960s, but as the family grew to six, the man of the house started to build a new, larger family home himself.

He built the property almost single-handed over a period of six years.

The couple moved in with their family in 1972 and have lived there ever since.

Angela McKay, 43, their youngest daughter, said: "Until we moved into the new house, when I was about seven, I used to sleep in my parents' bed and one sister

slept at the foot of the bed.

"It was a very cosy two-up, two-down for a family of six. At Christmas we'd have other family

to stay as well."

Over the years, Mr Adams worked at several local places, including on the railways and in security at nearby AWE.

Mrs Adams has had a series of jobs at local shops, including the Spar, in Tadley.

The couple are now the proud grandparents of seven and celebrated their five decades of marriage on August 16.

To mark the occasion, they held a barbecue at their home for 90 guests, including family, friends and neighbours, which was a great success despite poor weather.

A termination date of May 13th, 1988 had been placed on Owen Aldridge's contract with AWE and on April 27th his many friends and colleagues gathered at the Police Club to witness satisfactory completion of his contract term and to wish him a long and happy retirement.

Owen, who started his working life in the printing trade in Reading and also saw wartime service with the RAF in the Middle East, joined the Civil Service in July 1955 and was posted into the AWE Contracts organisation. Over the intervening years he has been responsible for placing contracts covering a variety of requirements but has always specialised in the printing, stationery and technical writing fields.

The presentation of a barometer and power plane was made by Mr. R. Simms, CB/NS31, who thanked Owen for his many years' service to the sometimes thankless task of MOD Contracting.

Barbara Webb, Editor of *AWE News*, then presented Owen with a book token in recognition of the ten years he had spent as Deputy Editor. In thanking him for his support, Barbara mentioned that Owen had nobly stepped into the breach when she was incapacitated for three months in 1978 and had produced three issues of the magazine.

Owen gave a brief speech in which he thanked his many friends throughout AWE for the gifts and for coming to see him off. His wife Jean, together with his son and daughter, was at the presentation. Jean, who until recently worked in R & D, joined Owen in retirement at the end of May.

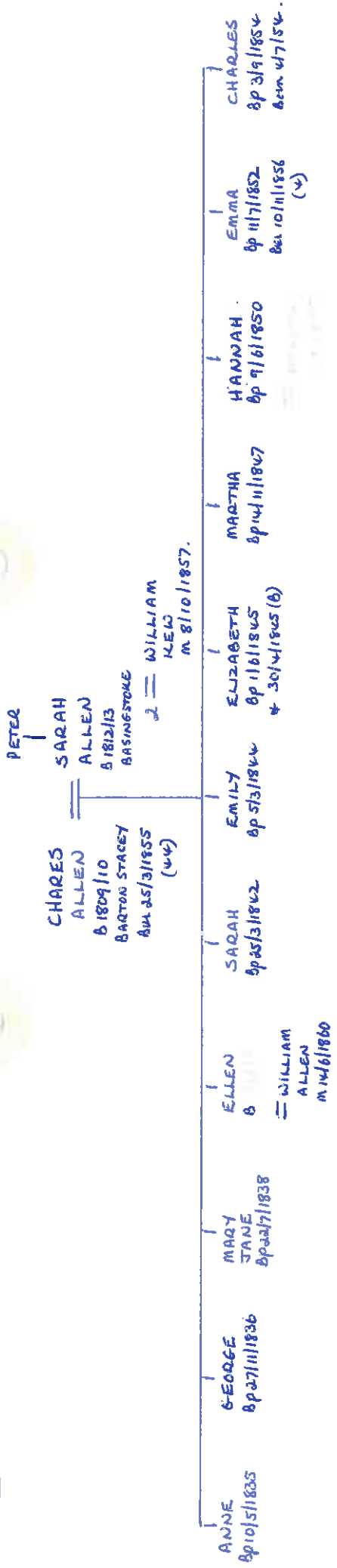

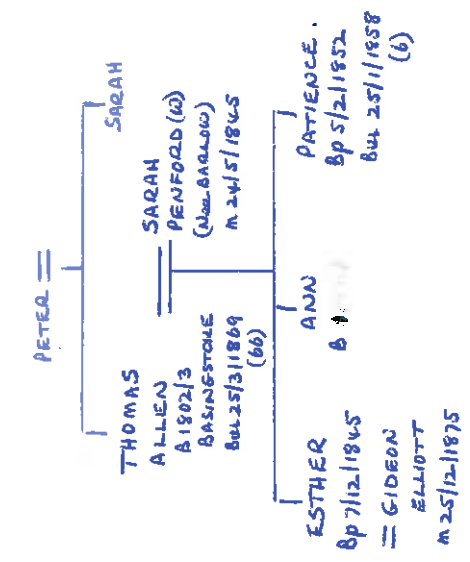

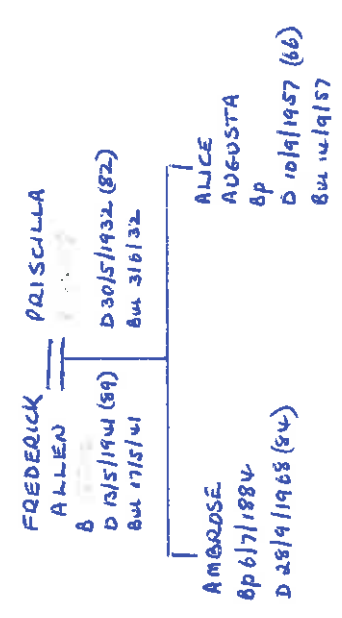

Elizabeth had also given birth to Dennis Webb (Allen) in 1846 in the village of Deane, also no father mentioned. After 1852 there is no mention of Elizabeth Allen (not sure if she died, was locked up or went off and married someone else) but Dennis and Arthur were brought up by there Uncle William Allen, at Bishops Farm, Tadley.

IAlthough no definate proof I have linked Dennis Webb with Elizabeth Allen. 1..We were told of connections-Southampton.

Funeral day

LAST respects will be paid to Hampshire's late education chief when his funeral is held today (Thursday, February 24). Don Allen, 65, died on February 12 after 16 years as county councillor for Tadley and Kingsclere, and eight years as head of Hampshire's schools. The funeral will be at St Paul's Church in Ashford Hill at 12.30pm.

Councillor mourned

CIVIC leaders from the Basingstoke area and Hampshire turned out in force for the funeral of well-respected and much-admired county education chief Don Allen.

Mourners - who included Basingstoke MP Andrew Hunter, Hampshire County Council leader Councillor Ken Thornber and borough mayor Cllr Gwen Richardson - filled St Paul's Church in Ashford Hill on Thursday afternoon as family, friends, colleagues and representatives from many organisations came to pay their last respects to the popular 65-year-old father of two.

The service was led by Father Kevin O'Brien, and included glowing and fond tributes to Cllr Allen (pictured), who was Hampshire County Council's Cabinet member for education, and had represented the Kingsclere and Tadley division of the county council since 1989.



Cllr Allen - who died in Basingstoke hospital on February 12 after a long battle with respiratory problems - lived in Baughurst.

He leaves a wife, Sheila, who is a Basingstoke and Deane borough councillor, and two sons, Richard and David.

Councillor's funeral held

Requiem mass well attended by colleagues

AN ASHFORD Hill church was packed on Wednesday afternoon with civic dignitaries, councillors, family and friends for the funeral of a popular Baughurst councillor.

Almost every seat was taken at the funeral service of long-serving Conservative borough and parish councillor Sheila Allen who died, aged 70, on September 24.

Mourners gathered for a requiem mass at 2pm at St Paul's Church, Ashford Hill Road.

They included the mayor of Basingstoke and Deane, Warwick Lovegrove, Lady Young (wife of North West Hampshire MP Sir George), the leader of Hampshire County Council Ken Thornber and the leader of the Conservative group on the borough council John Leek.

Many borough and Baughurst parish councillors, of which Mrs Allen was one for more than 20 years, attended including clerk Penny Waterfield and chairman Chris Surtees.

Mr Surtees said after the mass that Mrs Allen, who also sat on the borough council, would be sadly missed.

He said: "It's splendid to see so many people here wishing her farewell."

The mass began with a welcome by Father Vincent Henry, who said that

Mrs Allen was "always refreshingly honest".

He said that she said, "what had to be said and was never afraid of asking questions", adding that Mrs Allen was "highly motivated to make a better world", as reflected in the long list of organisations she was involved with.

This was followed by a reading by Basingstoke and Deane Borough councillor Elaine Still, the psalm *The Lord's My Shepherd*, and a reading and tributes by family friend John Taylor, who said that she was not one to let others take the strain and was "thoroughly committed and diligent in all she did".

He said: "She was quiet, she was modest and she was a significant presence in our lives."

Her strength of character was shown in the way she dealt with the death of her husband, Hampshire county councillor Don Allen in 2005, and in her own battle with cancer, he added.

Mrs Allen's close friend, Hampshire county councillor Marilyn Tucker, said that Mrs Allen was "always caring and interested in everyone and everything".

She said: "She made me feel special in that friendship."

Mrs Tucker also said that her friend showed special courage in

fighting her illness, and, in particular, by going straight to council meetings, immediately after chemotherapy treatment.

"Many people had no idea how ill she was. She said, 'I don't want a fuss, just tell people I went into hospital for tests,'" she said.

Harry Almond

A SERVICE of thanksgiving for the life of Sqn Ldr Harry Almond, 78, has been held at Baughurst Church.

One of the outstanding Pathfinder pilots of the Second World War, he lived at Pound Green, Ramsdell, since 1946.

He was Squadron Leader of 105 squadron, part of 8 Group and made numerous wartime sorties over Germany in Mosquito and Lancaster aircraft.

He received the Distinguished Flying Cross earlier in the war in recognition of his service and became closely involved in the OBOE blind bombing radar device which was successfully deployed for bombing raids on industrial Germany.

After one of these raids, on the railway marshalling yards at Cologne, Air Vice Marshal 'Bomber' Harris recommended him for the Distinguished Service Order.

His Mosquito aircraft was badly damaged by ack-ack, which put one engine and the hydraulics out of action.

He could not separate his flaps, the undercarriage only partly functioned and he was unable to release his bomb load.

He flew his crippled plane back to base at Bourne, Lincolnshire, and crash-landed on the grass with his bomb load.

Throughout his many sorties, he did not receive a scratch or have to bale out.

He moved to Pound

Green when he was appointed a flying instructor at the former BOA airfield at Aldermaston.

He continued as a flying instructor after BOAC moved to Heathrow and became one of the chief instructors.

In 1958 he transferred to the Comet 4 fleet and eventually became an airline pilot. When he retired in 1970, he was flying VC10s.

Sq Ldr Almond became active locally as a champion of the environment and was an active member of the local Conservative Party.

He leaves a widow, Peggy, a son and daughter, Gordon and Heather, and four grandchildren, Kate, Claire, Jamie and Matthew.

Leading light in town's Chamber of Trade dies

Obituary

THE secretary and former president of the Tadley Chamber of Trade has died.

Roy Edward Anderson, of Wellington Crescent, Baughurst, died aged 82 following a stroke on October 3.

He was born in Brockley, south east London, on August 20, 1920.

At the age of 11 he won a scholarship to Haberdashers Askes School, after which he went to Goldsmiths College, London, to undertake a teacher-training course.

He taught for a year before joining the RAF in 1940, first as a warrant officer and then as a pilot officer.

At a New Year's Eve party at Bromley Country Club in 1946, "Andy", as he was known, met Christabel Eteson, whom he married in 1949.

In the 1950s, with a young family to support,

Andy began working for firms such as Avon, Michelin, John Bull and the Rootes Group.

In 1963, the family moved from Surrey to Hampshire, where he set up his first business, The Mobil Garage in Mulfords Hill, Tadley, which he ran with his wife for five years.

He left the garage to establish Anderson Motor Store, also in Mulfords Hill, which he ran with the help of his wife until 1979.

Having worked in the motor industry for almost 30 years, he changed direction to develop Anderson House. He became sub-postmaster of the new post office in Mulfords Hill, which he ran until his retirement in 1987 at the age of 67.

Soon after his move to Tadley, Andy became an active and enthusiastic member of the Tadley Chamber of Trade.

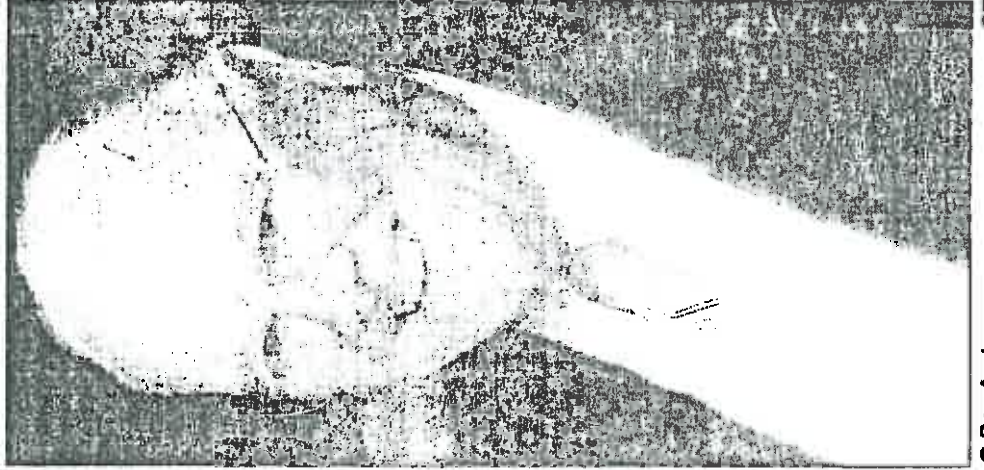
He also served as a councillor on Tadley Parish Council, and was a committee member of the Tadley Recreational Society and Tadley Green Housing Association.

He was also responsible for the creation of the hugely successful Chamber of Trade *Roundabout* publication which, over the years, has raised more than £20,000 for local charities.

After his retirement, Andy was heavily involved in fundraising projects, in particular helping to transform the Tadley Rugby football ground in Red Lane.

Andy lived life to the full and, through his business ventures, became a well-known figure in Tadley. He will be greatly missed.

He is survived by Chris, his wife of 50 years, three daughters - Judith, Erica and Jackie - and four grandchildren.
