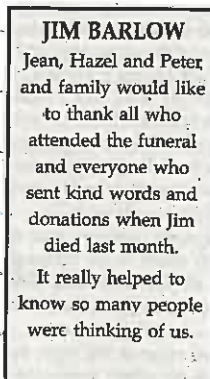

Cocktail of drugs and alcohol blamed for death

A NEWBURY man who failed to arrive for Sunday lunch at his parents' home was lying dead from a cocktail of drugs, an inquest heard.

The lifeless body of 43-year-old Martin Bean was later discovered in his Hambridge Road flat by his father, the hearing in Newbury was told on Wednesday last week.

In a statement to the inquest, Roy Bean explained how he had arrived at his son's home at about 1pm on Sunday, February 8, and saw him lying on the floor. He immediately contacted the emergency services, who arrived at the scene and pronounced his son dead.

Assistant deputy Berkshire coroner Anna Burnside said that police also found alcohol, cigarettes and a white substance wrapped in polythene lying nearby.

A post-mortem examination later revealed that a combination of heroin, cocaine and alcohol had caused the man's death.

Mr Bean told the coroner that his son had been suffering with personal problems and had recently lost his job.

He added: "He had been having some problems at the time. It just had an effect on him and I think that left him feeling a bit low.

"I feel that he was down but I do not think he took his own life."

Recording a verdict of accidental death, Ms Burnside said: "If used individually it would not have caused a problem, but the combination of the drugs and the alcohol had caused his death."

MR TADLEY

IF anyone ever deserved the title of Mr Tadley, it was Councillor George Beavers. Mr Beavers, who was 70 and lived at Huntsmoor Road, died in Basingstoke District Hospital on Thursday night after a long illness.

After coming to Tadley in 1955 he devoted much of his life to serving the village community through his work as a councillor and as an individual, caring for the community.

He got the idea of forming the local community centre and was instrumental in arranging a lease between the trustees and the Ministry of Defence, who owned the property. In its early years he was the association secretary and then he was elected chairman for over 12 years.

Elected

Mr Beavers was even elected chairman at the last annual meeting when he was housebound - such was the regard he was held in by his fellow office bearers.

He was a founder member of the residents' association and also set up a youth club with Councillor Ron Carrington.

He was a member of Kingsclere and Whitchurch RDC for about 20 years and was chairman for two years until the formation of Basingstoke District Council in 1974, where he continued as a councillor.

Mr Beavers was also elected to Tadley Parish Council and served as chairman many times over the years and only retired from the parish and Basingstoke councils because of his illness.

He was born in Portsmouth and, since his father was an Army man, spent his early life in South Africa and India

where he was educated.

When he returned to the UK at the age of 16 he followed in his father's footsteps and joined the 10th Royal Hussars.

He reached the rank of warrant officer in the Army but was invalided out in 1942 after an accident.

Head

Mr Beavers worked at AWRE Aldermaston and was section head of one of the non-technical departments until he retired five years ago.

He leaves a wife, Elsie, two sons and a daughter and seven grandchildren.

There will be a funeral service at Tadley's St Mary's Church in Bishopswood Road tomorrow morning at 11.15, followed by cremation at Aldershot.

Tributes paid to 'selfless' Elsie

A DAUGHTER has paid tribute to her mother – a community stalwart in Tadley who was involved in numerous local initiatives, including the creation of the community centre.

Elsie Beavers, who moved to Tadley in the 1950s with her husband Gordon, was involved in all aspects of community life.

Born Elsie Edna May Leavey, in Northampton in May 1915, she grew up in Basingstoke and married Mr Beavers at All Saints Church, in Southern Road, Basingstoke.

The couple (pictured right) lived in Sarisbury Green, near Southampton, throughout the 1940s, where they began bringing up their three children Derek, Peter and Jean before moving to Huntsmoor Road, in Tadley in 1954.

In the town, Mrs Beavers will be remembered for her dedication to St Mary's Church, in Bishopswood Road, her involvement in the Burnham Cope Women's Institute – of which she was a past secretary and president – and the Tadley Community Centre, in Newchurch Road, which she started with her husband in 1957.

Mrs Beavers set up baby clinics, a nursery school and children's dance classes at the centre, while Mr Beavers – who worked at the Atomic Weapons Establishment – became heavily involved in local government and was a chairman of Tadley Town Council.

The councillor, who passed away in 1980, is remembered through Beavers Way, in Tadley, which is named after him.

Mrs Beavers' daughter Jean Foister, 63, paid tribute to her mum, who died on January 17 at



the age of 98.

She said: "Mum was selfless and unassuming with a golden heart. It was impossible for her to be anything but kind and helpful to anyone whether family or stranger. I do miss her dreadfully."

She added: "My parents gave so much service to Tadley. We were all brought up with that gene to look after the local people."

"My mum was very well liked, a leader of ladies, and my dad was 'Mr Tadley' – it was public service second to none."

The Reverend Barry Norris, the priest at St Mary's Church, where Mrs Beavers' funeral service was held on February 2, said: "She was a lovely lady who was always on the go and made a considerable impact on the community. She was a pillar in this church from day one."

Man of 80 killed in sailing accident

AN 80-YEAR-OLD man from Basingstoke died on Thursday when his dinghy capsized in Fareham Creek.

Jack Bechelet, of Margaret Road, South Ham, was giving sailing instruction to his friend, 41-year-old Mark Minter, from St Stephens Close, Up Natley.

Mr Minter swam 100 yards to the shore after the boat capsized and raised the alarm before trying to swim back with a life belt.

A man working nearby rowed out to Mr Bechelet and managed to haul him in and attempt mouth-to-mouth resuscitation.

Ports-mouth coastguards say they scrambled their Sikorsky helicopter as soon as the call came in at about 1.10pm.

It lifted both the stricken men to Haslar naval hospital where Mr Bechelet was pronounced dead. Mr Minter was treated for shock and went home later in the afternoon.

Jennifer Taylor of Ports-mouth coastguards said the wind was at force six at the time and the sea was "moderate to rough" but with good visibility.

She said: "There were not a lot of people out there. It is a spot used for dinghy sailing."

Pc Tim Young of Fareham Police said the creek is about 400 yards wide at the spot where the accident happened. "The wind was up and the current is strong," he said.

"The man who hauled Mr Bechelet out of the water partially submerged his boat in doing so. It appears that Mr Minter and Mr Bechelet were friends and Mr Minter was learning about sailing. It is a very unfortunate accident."

He said there were no suspicious circumstances and the matter is now in the hands of the coroner.

Coroner's officer David Thomas said an inquest into the death of Mr

Bechelet would be opened and adjourned tomorrow.

Neighbours of Mr Bechelet say he was a quiet man who liked animals.

Sophy Walsh, 66, who lives in the flat next to Mr Bechelet's, said: "He was very generous and liked to help people."

Sheila Anderson, who lives opposite, said she had seen Mr Bechelet manoeuvring a boat on a trailer on Wednesday or Thursday morning. She said: "It was the first time I had seen him with a boat. He looked very happy."

"Perhaps he died doing what he liked best."
