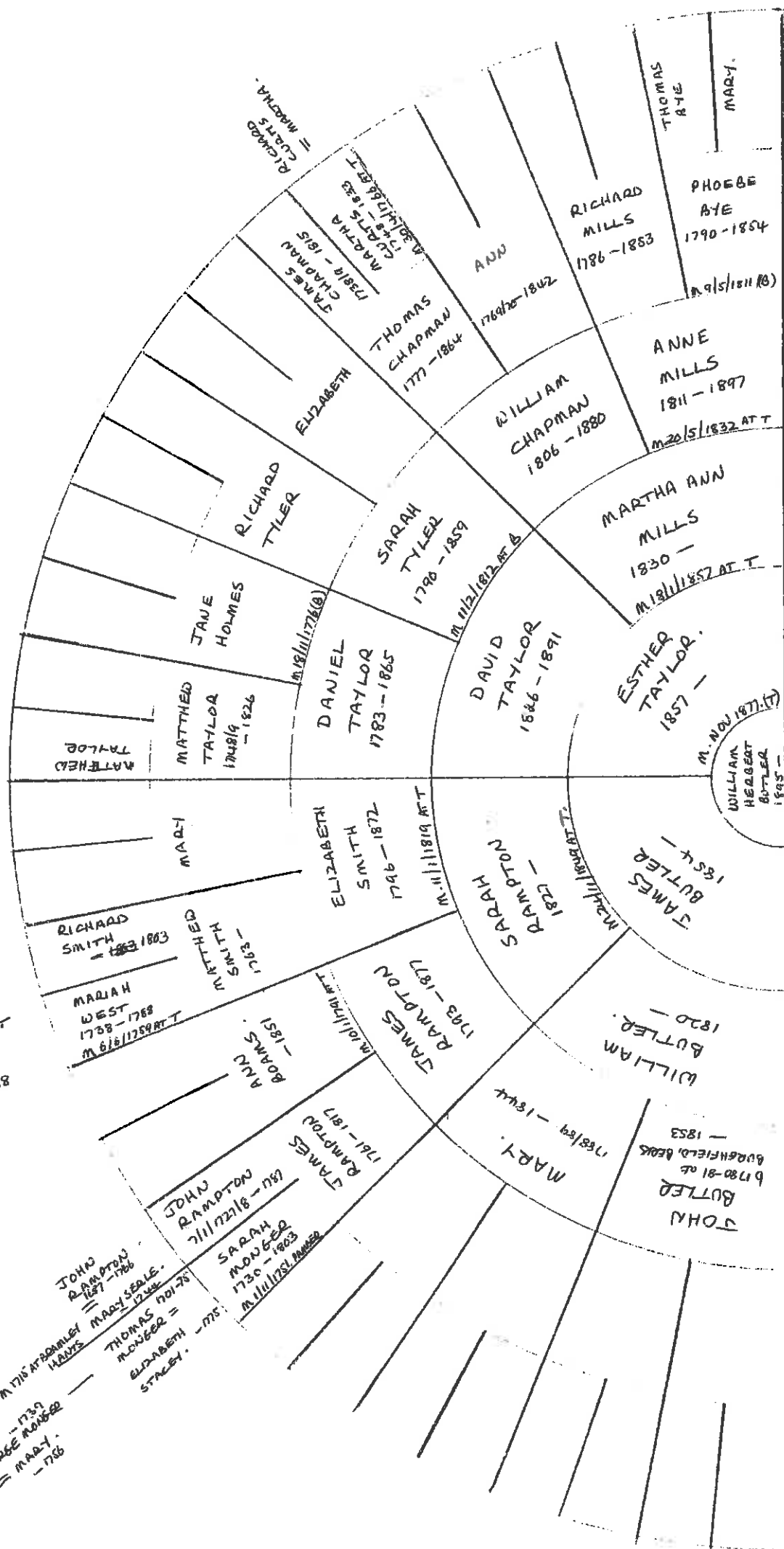

I have recently been in e-mail correspondence with David Aldworth of Maryland, USA, who suggested I write to you on the subject of Baughurst and it's people.


I am starting out on a journey to discover my family and the places in which they lived. One of my ancestors was born in Baughurst in 1854. His name was James Butler, and his parents were William Butler, an agricultural labourer, and Sarah Rampton. William had several other children, they were:

Mary Ann Butler (1849)
William Butler (1851)
John Butler (1856 but died in infancy)
Hannah Butler (1859)
Fanny Butler (1861)
David Butler (1863)
Thomas Butler (1868)
Elizabeth Sarah Butler (1870)

James was still living in the area, probably in Baughurst, when his own first son, David James, arrived in 1883. By the time his third child (my grandfather William Herbert) was born in 1895, he was living in the Egham area. James died in 1928 in Woking.

All I have as proof of these names, so far, are entries in the family bible, and some checking to verify dates and places in the GRO Indexes. David Aldworth suggested that, as an authority on the families of Baughurst, you might be able to point me at sources of information on the subject, and I should be extremely grateful if you could. Dear Iris,

I was overjoyed to get your huge package of information today, and thrilled to see the past open up before my eyes as I read! I am so grateful to you for finding so many connections for me – I shall now be able to investigate all the byways that you have opened up for me. The thrill of the chase is very exciting – I mean the chase after ancestors of course! It was wonderful, too, to be able to see William's and Sarah's marks and James' and Esther's signatures on the parish register entries you included.

I was very interested to read your thoughts on the Taylor family, and I may have a little information to add to the wealth that you have uncovered. Since my Father had been unable to find his father's birth certificate in any of the cupboards, nooks and crannies, etc. in his house, I splashed out and bought a copy from the GRO. While I was at it, I sent for granddad's elder brother's certificate also (David James). This revealed an interesting fact. David James was born, as the family bible said, on 20 December 1883, to James BUTLER and Esther TAYLOR, at West Heath, Tadley. My grandfather, William Herbert, was born 4 February 1895, to James BUTLER and Louisa COLE, at Egham in Surrey. I have now sent away for the birth certificate of Louisa BUTLER, their sister who was born in 1893 to James BUTLER, but I suspect that she was also the daughter of Louisa COLE. Since David James was living with his grandparents at the time of the 1891 census (he is shown as "James D" on your entry of the 1891 census), but his father was not, and nor was there any mention of Esther at that time, I have concluded that Esther died some time between 1883 and 1891. I have been searching the GRO deaths indexes but haven't come up with anything yet.

Your information on the RAMPTONS was fascinating, and has uncovered distant and previously unknown cousins! I see that Sarah RAMPTON was the daughter of James and Elizabeth (Smith), and James was the son of James and Ann (Boams). That James was the brother of John who was married to Ann DEADMAN, the forbear of Mavis Aldworth. I had also been in touch with a lady in British Columbia, via e-mail, whose husband was also descended from RAMPTONS of Tadley. To cut a long story short, she has also traced the line back to James and Sarah (MONGER) through James and Ann (BOAMS – although she has spelled it BOWMAN in her letter to me). So all of a sudden, I have cousins galore! And all thanks to you!

I shall now start investigating some of the other names on the tree, as well as trying to get a handle on the other side of the family, the OTTAWAYS in Surrey. I shall let you know what I am able to find out about Esther TAYLOR.

Dear Alan,

You kindly offered help in "Ancestor Spotting" last year, and I was wondering if I could ask you about this family?:

David BUTLER lived in Browning Hill Baughurst at the turn of the century, with his widowed mother, Sarah. Sarah died in 1902 at Browning Hill (I have been unable to find where she was buried), and David married Mary Ann WOODS at Basingstoke Reg Office in May 1903 (they were both "resident at Monk Sherborne" at the time). Their first two children were baptised at Ramsdell - Elizabeth Mary and Edward James (both in 1903) - even though they were said to be resident in Baughurst. The next two, Esther Alice and David, were baptised in 1908 at Baughurst. So far I have been unable to trace them further, nor do I know if they had any more children. If you do have any sources of information (I have the Ramsdell PR for baptisms up to 1982, and the Baughurst PRs - bapts up to 1953, Marriages up to 1974 and Burials up to 1898), or there is anyone in TADS who remembers them, I should be very grateful for any additional information.

Dear Iris:

First I must apologise for not having replied to your letter of the 30th of January. I was away from home for the first two weeks of February, in London on a training course, and have still not caught up with all the things that needed doing when I got home! Needless to say, in my spare time away from the classroom, I pursued an ancestor or two on my Mother's side, who were Londoners!

Secondly, I must thank you, once again, for so comprehensively answering my rather vague question about David Butler. You have really turned up trumps for me, and I am thrilled to know more about the BUTLERS. As I think I told you when I wrote to you back in January 1999, I had an apparently accurate Family Bible, with all my great-grandfather James' siblings listed with their dates of birth, and although I have been able to find out a little of what happened to some of them, most have proved remarkably elusive! It doesn't help that BUTLER is such a common name, particularly in Hampshire and Berkshire. David is the first member of the family, other than James, whom I have been able to trace into the 20th century. Once the 1901 census is released, of course, a few other families may become clearer. Thank you also for the additional information, received today, on David and Mary Ann's burials. Next time I am in the library, I shall look up their death certificates, from which may glean further details.

I have a database on my computer which is an amalgamation of the telephone directories and the Electoral roles, and I searched in this for a Leonard or a Nina Butler. There was no Leonard, but Nina still lives in Spring Close Sherborne St John, at no 3A! There were two other Butlers also in Spring Close, I don't know if they are related, but it might be significant:

I will try writing to Nina explaining my relationship, and see if she is interested in her husband's family enough to help me.


I was very interested in the mention you made of the BARLOWs. I too have been in touch with Wilma Gulstad, as I had picked up on the RAMPTON connection. After we last corresponded, I started collecting every instance of the name RAMPTON, and now have a database of nearly 5,000 pieces of information from all over the world. I have most recently discovered a distant cousin in Queensland Australia. One of the sons of Thomas RAMPTON and Charlotte TULL, William, became an engine driver, married just outside Maidenhead, and settled in Berkshire for a number of years until 1883, when he and his family emigrated to Maryborough, Queensland, on board the Kapunda. There he had a few more children, and a second wife, and lived to the ripe old age of 89. My new "cousin" (or rather cousin-in-law, since it is his wife who was born a RAMPTON) is Peter Worley, and he has supplied me with masses of information, including a small booklet (a little inaccurate in places), which gives all the descendants of William, to the present day. The booklet was prepared by a member of the family in honour of the centenary of the landing of William and his family at Maryborough, in 1983. I would be happy to photocopy it for you if you are interested. Peter also sent me his family database of over 600

individuals, which I was able to incorporate into my own database, doubling the size of mine in one stroke!

I shall be in Hampshire in early April, as I have a very packed weekend of "festivities" on the 8th/9th. My friends are celebrating their Ruby Wedding on the Saturday, and the Hampshire Genealogical Society is holding its Spring open day on the Sunday. I don't know if you are intending to visit the open day, but if you are, I should love to meet you and thank you in person for all the help you have given me in the past year. Your help and interest really fired my enthusiasm for this most addictive of hobbies!
