THE FUNERAL of Mr Frank William Chapman, of Burney Bit, Pamber Heath, was held at Tadley Salvation Army Hall, and was followed by burial at Tadley Old Meeting churchyard.

Mr Chapman (60) had been the Young People's band leader for many years. He was the founder of the first band.

A native of Tadley, born at Tadley Hill by The Green, Mr Chapman had been ill since Christmas and died at home. He had worked at AWRE, Aldermaston for 36 years.

He was very devoted to the work of the Salvation Army, which was the centre of his life. The great esteem in which he was held was evident at the

funeral service attended by 150 and by the long procession led by the band, which marched from the Tadley Salvation Army Hall to the churchyard.

He leaves a widow Joyce, two daughters Yvonne and Elaine, two sons Martyn and Gerwyn, and five grandchildren, all of whom play in the Young People's Band.

But more travel was involved for the actual anniversary - a holiday they shared with their family.

The couple were initially told to pack their bags and make for an unknown destination - this turned

out to be Chandler's Ford where there was a family gathering at a hotel.

But the surprises weren't over for the golden couple.

They were taken to Southampton Airport where they were to fly off for a stay in Jersey.

But on handing in their baggage at the check-in they were told that a party of 11 was expected. It turned out many members of their family were to share the holiday.

The couple have a son and daughter, Paul and Marilyn, and five grandchildren.

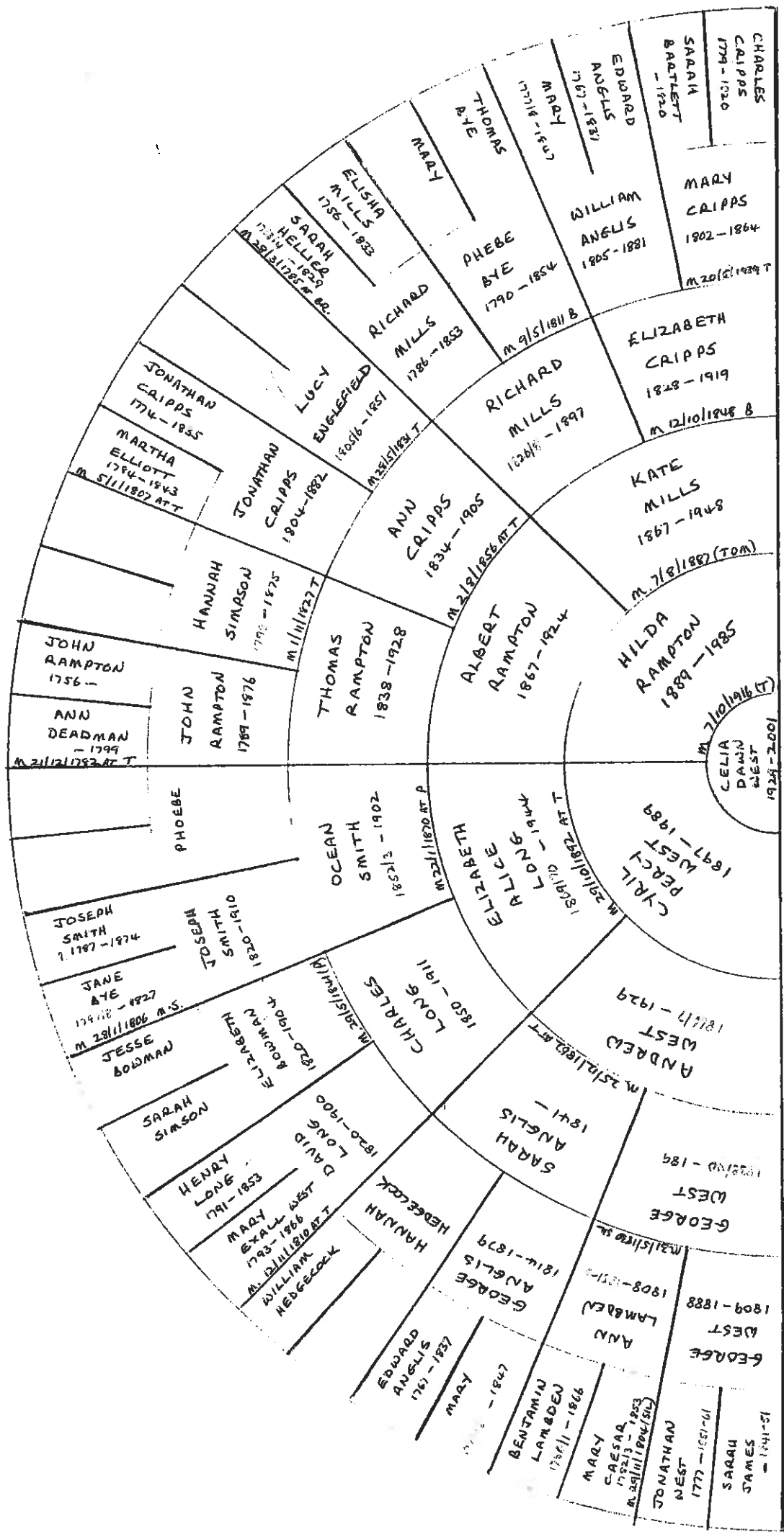
