# Man died after drinking methadone

A MAN died after drinking bottles of methadone belonging to a friend while he was staying at her Basingstoke home, an inquest heard.

Michael Monger, 38, had spent the evening of June 5 drinking at friend Dawn Shufflebotham's home in Sandys Road, South Ham.

The inquest was told that Miss Shufflebotham made Mr Monger a bed on the floor of her home at about 11.30pm, and they both went to sleep in the living room.

During the night, she heard a thud, but thought nothing of it and went back to sleep. In the morning, she saw he was not awake and realised he was cold.

Miss Shufflebotham, a registered methadone user, also noticed that bottles of the heroin substitute, which were in her handbag, were empty.

A post mortem examination found evidence of both methadone and diazepam in Mr Monger's blood.

Recording a verdict of misadventure, north Hampshire coroner Andrew Bradley said: "Michael clearly took a large dose of methadone and my understanding is he was not a methadone user. He would not have any degree of tolerance that would allow him to survive such a dose."

"I don't believe he intended to kill himself. He drank what was in front of him and he swallowed it all."

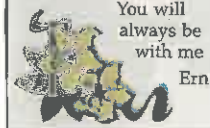

Dear Mrs. Stanley

I was interested to see your interest on the MONGER Family from the Members' Interests published by the Hants. F.H. Society. I am a member and have recently found Monger Family amongst my forebears, but it is in Glamorganshire.

As you seemed to have traced it back to c.1688 in Aldermaston, Berks. I am wondering if you have, during the course of your research work, found any clues or links between the Mongers of Glamorganshire and that of Surrey and London areas.

I believe that this name originated in Guildford as early as Henry VIII's reign and part of this family were merchants in London, as indicated in the Visitation pedigrees, Wills and other printed London registers.

My Monger ancestry comes in through the daughter of William Morris of Swansea and Cecilia Monger, Cecilia Morris who married John Ellery of Swansea in 1812 and their <sup>great</sup>granddaughter Mary Maude Ellery was my grandmother. Lansamlet was the earliest principal place of residence and seemed to have been there as early as 1739.

I would be most grateful to hear what you may have to offer and I am also anxious to know if there are any Wills in the P.C.C. for the 18th century as well as any in the Surrey Courts.

Thank you for your recent letter. I am very interested to hear of your extensive research of the Tadley records.

My association with Tadley is through my mother's side of the family. My great-grandfather was James Monger born on 19.9.1847 at Tadley. He was the based born son of Richard Saunders and Christina (or Christine) Monger. James was married in 1869 to a Mary (Jane) King (born at Bramley) and after initially living at Tadley and Pamber moved to Binfield in approx. 1877, and until his death in 1914 he was a gamekeeper on the Allanbay Park estate.

It was at the later part of last year that members of the Berks FHS were given the opportunity of submitting their family interests for inclusion in the next edition of the 'Members Interests' booklet. I had quite forgotten about that and ~~some~~ a few months ago I noticed an advertisement in a copy of the National Genealogical Directory of a baptism index compiled by a Mr K Smallbone of Basingstoke on a number of parishes in Hampshire bordering Berkshire.

I wrote to Mr Smallbone and in his reply he told me how because of lack of response to his index he was in the process of depositing it with the Hants FHS and the BFHS. However through someone that he knew who had made a research of the Tadley records (a coincidence but could it be you?) he forwarded to me a lot of information which added to the details I already had enabled me to piece together quite an informative tree of the Saunders family. On the Monger side I have drawn a blank by not being able to trace where Christina (e) Monger came from. I must admit that when looking at the 1851 census for Tadley, Christina is shown as the wife of James but I could not read the place of where she was born - the first few letters looked something like 'Shortis.....'. I did notice a number of entries for Monger and also Munger which I suppose could be a variation in the spelling of the same name, and I think there is probably a link with Christina Monger.

I should therefore like to take up your offer of any details you have of both the Saunders and Monger families. For information I enclose a copy of my family tree.
