**Historical Information:** GREENWICH CEMETERY CEMETERY INDEX NUMBER, LONDON 29. GREENWICH Cemetery, on Shooters Hill, is within the Metropolitan Borough of Greenwich and belongs to the Borough Council. It covers an area of 15 acres. The Cemetery contains 570 War Graves, which may be classified as follows:- Soldiers of United Kingdom units-500 Royal Navy-16 Overseas Military Forces of Canada-11 Australian Imperial Force-11 German Army-15 Royal Air Force-6 Royal Marine Light Infantry-2 Queen Alexandra's Imperial Military Nursing Service-2 New Zealand Expeditionary Force-2 Merchant Navy-2 British West Indies Regiment-2 South African Expeditionary Force-1 Of this number, 263 are buried in the "Heroes' Corner", a large War Plot on almost the highest point in the cemetery. The Cross is erected on the West side of this plot, and flanked by two curved screen walls carrying bronze panels; eleven panels bear the names of those who are buried in the plot, and ten the names of those whose graves are not marked by headstones. The majority of the dead were buried from the Herbert Hospital, one of the permanent Military Hospitals, or from the Brook War Hospital, established in the Metropolitan Asylums Board's Fever Hospital. The graves of 15 Belgian soldiers have been removed to Belgium. The Register records particulars of 555 War Graves.

# Mr William Rampton

THE grand old man of Tadley, Mr William John Rampton of Winston Avenue, has died at Basingstoke Hospital at the age of 104, after a stay of eight days.

Two days previously he had been out and about as usual.

His stamina and health had been so good that he continued to work in Pamber Forest until shortly before his 100th birthday.

With his passing, Tadley has not only lost its oldest inhabitant but also one with a link to Victorian days—for he was born in the village and attended Tadley County Primary School which was only a short distance from his home at Winston Avenue.

His working life spanned 90 years—he left school at the age of 11 to work in a shop.

His family had long connections with the area and his father hailed from Padworth just over the Berkshire border.

He worked in a shop for only a short period before becoming a timber feller. Then he learnt the art of besom broom making. He must have made thousands of brooms which were despatched country-wide. He made his last besom at the age of 99.

His work was his life and he literally knew every inch of Pamber Forest.

A God-fearing man, he was a member of the Methodist Church in his

younger days but later joined the United Reformed Church to worship at Tadley Old Meeting.

In latter years he used to like to meet friends at the 'Fighting Cocks'. He had never driven a car, making all his journeys on a bicycle.

A widower, he was married to Elsie who bore him ten children, eight of whom survive him—Florence, Maurice, Rose, Tom, Marge, Walter, Vera and Edith. Vera lives at Baltimore in the United States.

He also leaves 12 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

The funeral was held on Tuesday at Tadley Old Meeting and was followed by burial.

**Location:**

Lijssenthoek Military Cemetery is located 12 kilometres west of Ieper town centre, on the Boescheepseweg, a road leading from the N308 connecting Ieper to Poperinge. From Ieper town centre the Poperingseweg (N308) is reached via Elverdingsestraat, then over two small roundabouts in the J. Capronstraat. The Poperingseweg is a continuation of the J. Capronstraat and begins after a prominent railway level crossing. On reaching Poperinge, the N308 joins the left hand turning onto the R33, Poperinge ring road. The R33 ring continues to the left hand junction with the N38 Frans- Vlaanderenweg. 800 metres along the N38 lies the left hand turning onto Lenestraat. The next immediate right hand turning leads onto Boescheepseweg. The cemetery itself is located 2 kilometres along Boescheepseweg on the right hand side of the road.

**Historical Information:** During the First World War, the village of Lijssenthoek was situated on the main communication line between the Allied military bases in the rear and the Ypres battlefields. Close to the Front, but out of the extreme range of most German field artillery, it became a natural place to establish casualty clearing stations. The cemetery was first used by the French 15th Hospital D'Evacuation and in June 1915, it began to be used by casualty clearing stations of the Commonwealth forces. From April to August 1918, the casualty clearing stations fell back before the German advance and field ambulances (including a French ambulance) took their places. The cemetery contains 9,901 Commonwealth burials of the First World War, a few of which were brought in from the battlefields after the Armistice, and 883 war graves of other nationalities, mostly French and German. It is the second largest Commonwealth cemetery in Belgium. The cemetery was designed by Sir Reginald Blomfield.

Nothing fancy, but fresh food and hot coffee. So close too so that you don't waste too much time. Research time is precious in that building. I will be thinking of you both there.

Of course I haven't done any genealogy for four months now. I had a letter from Susan with some certificates in that I had asked her to get when I was in the U.K. I must get busy this week while I am feeling better and get them entered into the appropriate places and then filed away for safe keeping. I also have at least a dozen other letters that need answering. Some from friends and others enquiring about family names. There are also a few names in journals that I have to write to re some of my research names.

I talk to Vicki most mornings - everyone keeps tabs on me. She is having great fun with the twins at the moment - they are into the water and were found last week shampooing hair etc. So you can imagine they keep her hopping. She also is having to deal with teenagers and that is a full time job in itself.

I think that is all my news for now. As I say, my mind is not too active at the moment and also my fingers will not work properly all the time. I apologise for feeling sorry for myself but everyonce in a while, I say 'why me'
