


DEREK SMITHERS.

John managed to catch three of the birds and he took them home where he reared them in his garage under a lamp.

That one incident aroused such an interest in ducks that John and his wife Sylvia sold their house in Basingstoke and moved to their current home in Church Lane, Sherborne St John, where they had plenty of room for John's new hobby - call-duck breeding!

These days John shows his ducks all over the country, from Scotland to Cornwall.

"I have about 100 stock birds which I breed from," he says. "I keep the best ones to show and I sell the youngsters on."

John's prize bird is a 1997 grey call-duck who recently won the title "supreme champion" at the Domestic Waterfowl Clubs Championship Show, and a cup to go with it.

John insists: "She won the cup, not me! She is my champion of champions!"

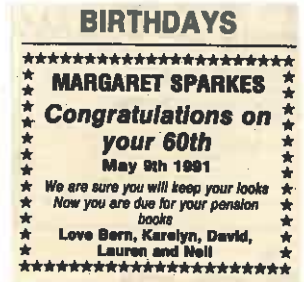
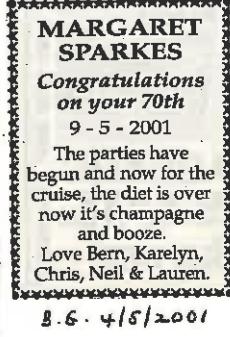
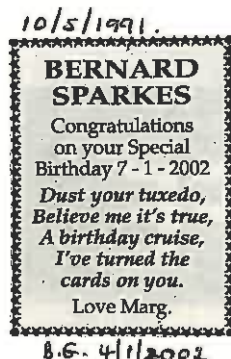

FRIENDS, family and former patients have been paying tribute to a popular former Tadley doctor, who cared for the local community for almost half a century.

Michael Speight, of Soke Road, died at the North Hampshire Hospital on Tuesday December 4, and his funeral took place in Thatcham on Wednesday, December 12.

Dr Speight was born in 1930, in India, where his father was professor of English at Hyderabad University. He came to England in 1944 and attended St Peter's School, York.

He studied medicine at St Mary's Hospital, London, and after qualifying as a GP, moved to Tadley in 1957 to join Dr Morland at his surgery in Silchester Road.

The population of Tadley grew quite quickly over the next few years, as AWE Aldermaston was established, and the surgery moved to Franklin Avenue.

Following the retirement of Dr Morland, Dr Speight became senior partner at Holmwood

Health Centre, until his own retirement in 1992.

He prided himself in looking after his own patients personally and there was great sadness when he retired. However, he was a very gregarious person and many of his old patients remained lifelong friends.

He was a marvellous cook and for eight years after retirement provided cooking demonstrations at local ladies' clubs,

until an accident in 2000, when his neck was broken, and he was confined to a wheelchair for the last seven years of his life.

"Fortunately, he had so many friends that the cottage was always full of visitors and he managed to still have his 'boys lunches' every Thursday until two weeks before he died," said his widow, Sandra Speight.

"He was dearly loved by all who knew him and he will leave a great gap in all our lives."

Dr Speight leaves his wife, son Mark, daughter Charlotte, two stepsons Christian and Simon and their families.



Doctor feared paralysed

THE WIFE of a retired Tadley GP fears her husband may have been left paralysed after a car accident near his Silchester home.

Dr Michael Speight diagnosed his own injuries as he sat trapped in his Audi Coupe after it was involved in a collision with an Astra van at Brimpton crossroads on the B3051.

His wife Sandra said: "There is just the faintest glimmer of hope that he will regain his movement, but the doctors have prepared me for the worst."

"He has broken his neck. They have operated on his smashed vertebrae at the bottom of his

skull but the spinal chord is damaged.

"He is relatively cheerful. He has told me that he can cope with life as a paraplegic because he can rely on me.

"We are a very close couple and have wonderful sons and lots of friends to rely on."

A police spokesman said Dr Speight, of Soke Road, told rescue workers that he could not feel his feet and that he needed an air ambulance to take him to the specialist Stoke Mandeville Hospital spinal injuries unit.

Fire crews worked to cut the retired doctor free of the wreckage following the accident ar-

ound 4.20pm on Thursday. The other male driver was treated for shoulder and hand injuries.

The 70-year-old doctor was taken by air ambulance to the Royal Berkshire Hospital in Reading, where his condition was yesterday described as "fairly comfortable". He will be moved to Stoke Mandeville as soon as a bed becomes free.

It is the second time in 10 years that the GP has been involved in an accident at the dangerous crossroads.

Dr Speight, who used to work at the Holmwood Health Centre in Franklin Avenue, is well-known in the Tadley area and

has received a steady stream of visitors to his hospital bed.

He is renowned for his vigorous campaigning for better health care facilities in Tadley.

Tadley Town Council chairwoman Jo Slimin and borough councillor David Leeks both know Dr Speight and said many people would be thinking of him.

Cllr Slimin said: "Dr Speight was my doctor when I first moved here 31 years ago and my son was a baby. He is a lovely man."

Cllr Leeks added: "Dr Speight is held in very high regard by the people of Tadley, who he looked after tirelessly over many years."

Crash driver recovering

THE retired Tadley GP, who was seriously hurt following an horrific car crash at the notorious Brimpton crossroads on the B3501, is showing signs of recovery.

It is feared that Dr Michael Speight, of Soke Road, Silchester, may be paralysed after his Audi Coupé was involved in a collision with an Astra van at the crossroads.

But his wife, Sandra, believes that her husband is progressing, albeit slowly, following his transfer to the specialist Stoke Mandeville spinal hospital in Buckinghamshire.

Sandra now spends four days a week visiting her 70-year-old husband who suffered acute spinal cord damage in the accident.

She said: "He is now able to spend several hours a day in a wheelchair, which is progression, but it is very early days at the moment."

She added: "He is very cheerful and still getting lots of visitors and wants to thank the emergency services for their actions following the accident as well as everyone in the town who has offered him support."

Mrs Speight said: "Fortunately, he had so many friends that the cottage was always full of visitors and he managed to still have his 'boys lunches' every Thursday until two weeks before he died." She added: "He was dearly loved by all who knew him and he will leave a great gap in all our lives."

The 77-year-old died at Basingstoke hospital on Tuesday, December 4, and his funeral took place in Thatcham on Wednesday, December 12.

As well as his wife, he leaves a son Mark and daughter Charlotte, and two stepsons Christian and Simon.

Defending the Spinnaker

THE SPINNAKER TOWER, PORTSMOUTH

A DIRECTOR of an international consultancy headquartered in Basingstoke has hit back against an article about the Spinnaker Tower in the national press, which stated: "It's tall but it's pointless."

Dr John Tubman, director of structures and advanced technology at Scott Wilson, on Basing View, described Tom Dyckhoff's article in *The Times* as being among one of the most mean spirited and thoroughly negative pieces of architectural criticism recently published.

Scott Wilson is the lead consultant for the £30million Spinnaker Tower which rises 558ft into the skyline of Portsmouth, but was put on the "D-list" of landmark projects in *The Times* story.

Work is still under way on the controversial tower, which is now due to open this summer.

Dr Tubman said: "Mr Dyckhoff will not have experienced the views from the observation decks at about 110 metres above sea level. I can confirm they are indeed spectacular - arguably unsurpassed by any other observation structure in the UK, with the possible exception of one or two 'cityscape' view decks in London.

"Ultimately, the judges of the Spinnaker Tower's worth as an icon and observation platform will be the residents of, and visitors to, Portsmouth."

Mr Dyckhoff's report also stated: "At 170m (558ft) high, the Spinnaker Tower is certainly big, but it isn't

pointing down at Portsmouth. It will grace city marketing brochures perfectly."

Bob McKittrick, a past president of the Institution of Structural Engineers, defended Scott Wilson's involvement in the project. In a letter to *The Times*, he said:

"The inference in his article is that Scott Wilson, a civil engineering firm, was the sole designer. I know for a fact that the structural design was by Scott Wilson, a very well respected company employing many chartered structural engineers, but it became involved



only after the preparation of an outline design by both an architect and a world-renowned structural engineering company of tower designers.

"I also know that the people of Portsmouth selected the tower following a design competition.

"Inaccuracies of this nature are a slur on Scott Wilson as well as on the structural engineering profession at large."
