Norman David Stacey [69]

'David'

David was born in 1938, the third son of John and Lily Stacey.

As a child he was always afraid of the dark. He would not go to the outside toilet without his brother going with him.

After attending Tadley School he worked in the local building industry.

In 1956 David married Pamela Baseley. They had three daughters, Sandra, Donna and Debra.

David completed his National Service with the Army, including a tour of duty in Cyprus, following which he joined the haulage and contracting company run by his father from the former quarry and brick works at Silchester Road, Tadley.

David was keen on all sports, playing football and cricket locally and then developing more than a passing interest in golf.

David was an avid reader and self-educator and undertook various studies in business and financial management. He became active in a number of trade federations covering the construction and haulage industry and was also a member of the Oakley Masonic Lodge in Basingstoke.

Together with his Father, David and his brothers, George and Joe, operated the business from the Brick Kiln Site. On the death of John Stacey in 1970 the three brothers became the principal directors of John Stacey & Sons Limited.

Under the control of the three brothers the haulage, plant hire and contracting business has expanded to become probably the largest private employer in the Tadley Area directly employing over 120 personnel.

It was by a chance encounter on 17th January 1973 that David met Audrey Bainbridge. They met at a champagne reception, held at The Angel at Woolhampton, to which Audrey was invited by a friend whose husband was not able to attend.

Audrey says, "We debated most of the evening about women's lib and a challenge was set which accompanied us through the whole of our relationship. He offered me a lift home. I declined, I had my own car. He offered to drive ahead of me through the dense fog until I was on the A340 to Basingstoke and he then branched off to his home."

When they first met Audrey went to watch David play cricket. Her dog at the time was a Yorkshire Terrier complete with a ribbon in its topknot. When it was David's turn to go out to bat he strode in manly fashion to the wicket, to the sound of much tittering from his team mates, to discover that the cause of their laughter was a pretty little Yorkie strutting proudly behind him!

Audrey and David married a year later in May 1974. Every year they went back to the Angel on 17th January to celebrate that first meeting with a bottle of champagne.

David was very much a people person, not an animal person. To him animals had their place and it wasn't in his house! Unfortunately for him he got himself a wife and later two children, Nicola and Abigail, who were passionate about animals.

When the children were young they had a goat called Tilly. She kept the family in milk and yogurt. Audrey milked her every day when she had a kid at foot. When Audrey had to go away for a few days she was amazed when David agreed to do the milking. He was given a lesson and she left the next day. Later Audrey was amused to learn that David each morning had dressed for the office except for his jacket and had

gone to the paddock to do the milking. Tilley was no problem at all but Barny the kid would wait for David to crouch to do the milking and then jump on his back and stay there until milking was finished. Having no time to change he went to the office each day with paw marks on his shirt and had to keep his jacket on all day.

They established a thriving equestrian centre close to their home. It is a credit to David, and shows his depth of commitment to his family, that he tolerated the animals that came to share their lives. In his own way he 'loved' the dogs and, although he never fully conquered his lack of confidence round the horses, he mucked out, harrowed fields and bale carted (with the help of willing drivers from the Company). He took great pride in watching his daughters reach high levels of equestrian achievements especially when representing his beloved Tadley at national level.

Staff shortages at the stables always seemed to occur when they were at maximum capacity. David often spent 3 hours in the morning helping us to muck out before going to work. Not his favourite thing so he would pretend he was practicing his golf swing whilst pitching the muck into the barrow. This situation often lasted for months at a time. He grumbled but he never let them down.

Each year in June, Audrey and David spent a month at their villa in Spain. This was 'their' time, away from the pressures of the business and horses. After the first couple of days of relaxation they would both get itchy feet and before they knew it were planning the next project on the villa. David with his dark looks was frequently mistaken for a Spaniard and the local builders would often discuss things with him in Spanish. In true 'Del Boy' fashion, not understanding a word they were saying, he would nod in agreement saying "si si" and then leave Audrey to sort it all out!

David loved to see his garden tidy and would spend hours collecting fallen wood and leaves and burning them. He would be found as dusk was falling sitting in the wheelbarrow watching the glow from the dying embers of the fire.

Walking after Sunday lunch was a regular pastime and the dogs went too. Tilly also went and, as you can imagine, he was greatly embarrassed when they met people who weren't sure what 'breed' of dog Tilly was. He never wanted Tilly to join the walk but was always outvoted. He never-the-less enjoyed her antics when nobody was watching.

His desire to create paths round the garden with points of interest came to fruition in time for Nickie's wedding in June. He enjoyed the results of his efforts and achieved his wish to see the seasons round. His pleasure in seeing the house refurbishment develop was a joy. Even in pain and heavily drugged he would wander round gazing at the rooms and enjoying the changes being made.

David was always keen to promote Tadley and pushed for improved facilities in the area, in the course of which he became a local Councillor and was instrumental in the establishment of football and cricket pitches together with the Jubilee Centre pavilion on Tadley Common.

He maintained a life long interest in Tadley Football Club and, with 26 acres of land made available by the John Stacey Group, played a pivotal role in providing additional pitches for the community on the recently opened Barlows Park Football complex. In addition to the extra sports facilities for the community, Barlows Park provides a new home for Tadley Calleva Football Club.

David was one of life's enthusiasts. Everything he got involved in was done with full commitment and energy. Whether it was with his family, or his business, or his other interests, his dedication was total.

David had a well rounded life in which his family was the most important element. His success in business with his brothers enabled him to make a considerable contribution to his local community. He recognised the importance of people in

everything that he did and was concerned for their wellbeing. He will be remembered for his kindness and generosity of spirit as a husband and father, a businessman and friend to the local community.

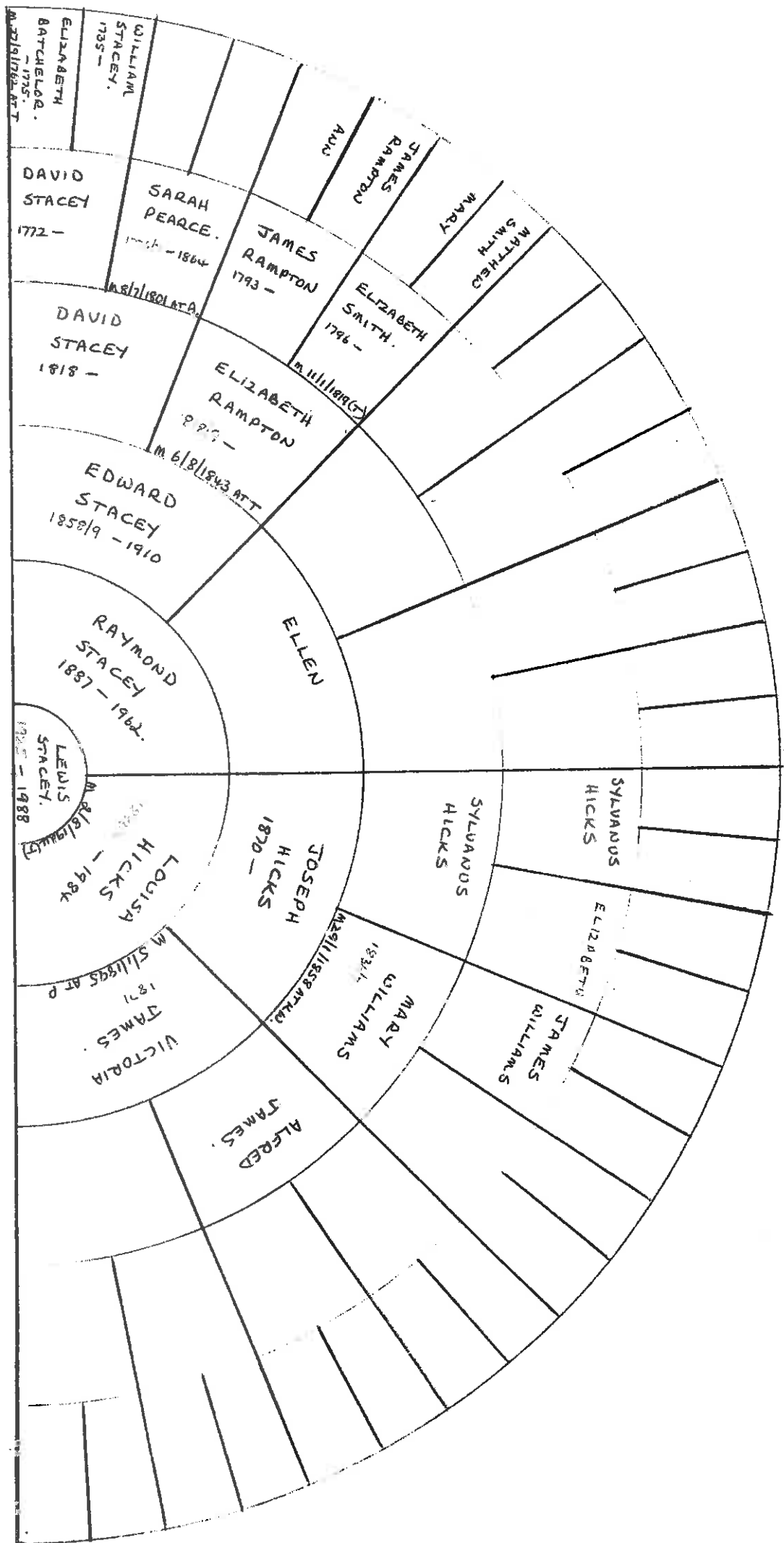
