The village of Loos-en-Gohelle is just north of Lens on the N43, Lens to Bethune road. Turn right off the N43 onto the D165, signposted for Wingles and La Basse, and continue along this road for 0.5 kilometres. Turn left at the village square and left again. Continue along this road and the cemetery is on the right after approximately 200 metres.

**Historical
Information:**

St. Patrick's Cemetery was begun during the battle by French and British troops, and used in 1916 very largely by the units of the 16th (Irish) Division. It was closed in June, 1918, but a small number of graves were brought into it after the Armistice from the battlefields between Loos and Hulluch. The irregular arrangement of the rows is due to the conditions under which the burials were carried out. There are now nearly 600, 1914-18 war casualties commemorated in this cemetery. Of these, over 40 are unidentified and the graves of 23, destroyed by shell fire, are now represented by special memorials. The cemetery covers an area of 3,001 square metres and is enclosed by a brick wall.

Charity walk OAPs ready for a knees up

PENSIONERS Dorothy and Fred Appleton are all set to step out for a good cause – even though they have three replacement knees between them!

Dorothy and Fred from Ellisfield are to walk a mile on Sunday in aid of a charity which helps people needing joint operations.

Having suffered with arthritis since her 40s, Dorothy said she has had a new lease of life since the latter of her two knee operations.

"Nothing's stopping me now," said the 82-year-old great-grandmother. "I was not able to go out and I could not walk. I was miserable because of the pain."

Fred, 79, is also taking part in the walk at Exbury Gardens in the New Forest on Sunday. He had one knee replaced in January and is to have his hip and other knee replaced.

Dorothy was encouraged to walk by the surgeon who carried out both operations

Obituary Fred Appleton (1918-2004)

FRED Appleton, of Ellisfield – a remarkable countryman who embodied what is great about village communities – died earlier this month at the age of 86.

He is remembered for his kindness, for his huge and affectionate family, which now numbers more than 170 members, and for surviving when lightning struck the milking parlour that he was hosing down.

He was born in Itchen Abbas and worked first as a shepherd and later as a cowman on many farms in north Hampshire.

He came to Ellisfield in 1957 to work for Eddie Cole, at Hill Farm.

This was where, hosing down the milking parlour in a thunderstorm, lightning struck.

Fred was whirled around three times, while the cows were floored. All survived. Fred thought it was because he was wearing wellies.

After his wife died, leaving him with five children, he married Dorothy Harman, also of Ellisfield, earlier widowed with eight children.

The families, through their children, had long been close friends and so a happy, affectionate and successful dynasty was born.

Fred was known as "the carer of Cannon Close" – a cluster of houses near Ellisfield's Lower Common – because he would look in on the neighbours every morning, for example making tea for them and helping the frail.

He was a true countryman – very knowledgeable and versatile.

His bird tables were in great demand, as were his "wheelbarrow" flower pots.

As a sideline he also swept chimneys, and for many years he looked after the central heating in St Martin's Church, sledging there twice a day on a piece of corrugated iron in the terrible winter of 1962/3 until the thaw arrived.

He was indomitable and had two hip replacements and two new knees.

Eventually, when walking long distances became too difficult, he navigated his way around the village on "Nellie", his motorised chair.

In later years, he and his beloved wife Dorothy were regulars – and favourites –

on the 309 bus every other Tuesday. When getting out and about became more difficult, the bus used to slow down outside their home just to check how they were.

That's why – among the cards and letters of condolence – is one signed: "With love from Jenny and Vince and all the passengers on the 309 bus".

It was his wish to die in the village where he had lived so long, with the sun shining and the birds singing.

His family is thankful that final wish was granted.
