
Arlott


MORE than the relayed

Stanley and Doreen Baker, of Franklin Avenue, celebrated their diamond wedding anniversary on Boxing Day.

And to mark the occasion, the couple

Mrs Baker, 79, said: "Even now I think that suit is the best one Stanley's got! The material doesn't show any wear, and it's still in a popular colour – it shows how

styles come back into fashion."
The couple met when they both worked for The Ministry of Civil Engineering in Aldermaston, later the Atomic Weapons Establishment.

Mrs Baker said: "Stanley was with his cousin when he saw me with two other girls. Apparently he said to his cousin, 'that's the one I'll marry'."

After a whirlwind romance, which included a first date to Basingstoke cinema, the couple married on Boxing Day in 1946, when Mrs Baker was 19 years

The couple have always lived in the Tadley area and have spent the majority of their married life in the same house, which used to belong to 85-year-old Mr Baker's parents.

The Bakers have two children - Ray, 58, and Berry, 53 – and two grandchildren Corrie, 23, and James, 26.

"I have a lovely family," said Mrs Baker. "They are all my diamonds."

To mark their diamond anniversary, the Bakers had their marriage blessed on Christmas Day at St Mary The Virgin, Burghfield, where they were married.

The couple didn't want any presents, and instead asked all the guests at the church blessing to take a single flower, which was made into a bouquet.

"We then took a photograph of the bouquet to remember everyone who came," explained Mrs Baker.

She said that the secret to a long and happy marriage was down to being ' instead of I".

She said: "My husband and I both made our vows and we have stuck by them. It is also down to saying 'I love you' every day and never going to bed angry."

Obituary Derrick Ball

Derrick was born in Purton, Wiltshire in 1918. He grew up with his mother and one older brother. As a child he spent time on his uncle's farm and helped with the horses.

After leaving school Derrick worked as a stonemason's apprentice for several years. He decided to volunteer with the RAF and became an apprentice electrician, and part of the ground crew for bomber operations. He eventually worked on most of the well-known planes such as Lancaster, Wellington and Hampden.

After the war and demobilisation, Derrick continued in the aircraft industry, working first for Vickers Weybridge, then BOAC at Aldermaston Airfield. When this came to an end in the early 1950's, he started at the AWRE. Here he was involved in preparing and setting up experiments, being responsible for a particular building and health and safety. He also took part in weather balloon launches during this period.

By now Derrick was living at his cottage Evenley at Axmansford with his wife Sybil. Spare time was spent gardening, travelling widely in Britain and sometimes abroad, and being very involved with Baughurst Parish Council for 29 years. During that time he saw the village change from a rural straggle of cottages to an expanding community. At the same time he also served as chairman for the Basingstoke District Association of Parish Councils and as a committee member for the Hampshire Association of Parish Councils.

Early retirement was forced in 1979 due to a coronary heart attack but a complete recovery was made over time. Sadly his wife Sybil died of cancer in 1984 and in 1987 he married Rachel.

Derrick loved walking the local countryside, especially the woods at Axmansford. where he walked daily when time allowed, with the neighbour's black Labrador. Up until his mid seventies Derrick enjoyed playing a round of golf or a session of snooker with Andrew.

Derrick was a bright and intelligent man who kept a sharp, clear mind right to the end. He grasped scientific and technical theories whilst being a thoroughly practical person. He was a generous and sociable man who could tell an entertaining story in a witty manner. I shall miss seeing his blue eyes sparkle with laughter as he did so. We all love and miss him so much.


