

ARTHUR CHARLES COTTRELL

Former POW makes nostalgic French visit

A FORMER prisoner of war from Tadley has revisited northern France to help celebrate the 100th birthday of a woman whose family befriended him.

Arthur Cottrell, 75, from Mount Pleasant, this month journeyed to the town of Lille to take part in the centenary celebrations of Mme Jeanne Verdebout, who he met in 1939.

In 1940 Arthur was captured by the Germans and imprisoned in a succession of camps in Poland, Silesia, Czechoslovakia and the Sudeten Land.

But after being liberated by the Russians he kept in regular touch with Mme Verdebout and her three sons Roger, Michael and Jean-Marie.

After recently recovering from a brain tumor Arthur was not even sure he would be able to make the trip but his doctor gave him the all-clear.

"It was marvelous to go back and help celebrate Mme Verdebout's 100th birthday," said Arthur. "She and her family were very good friends to me while I was in France and it was an honour to go to her party.

"I even made a speech! Fortunately there were enough people there who spoke English to relay what I was saying to the rest of the guests."

Arthur has lived in Tadley since 1946.

Arthur's treasured Tadley news

RUMAGING through old drawers and boxes can uncover the most surprising things.

In the case of Arthur Cottrell it was a reminder of his life as a prisoner of war half a century ago.

Mr Cottrell, 75, of Mount Pleasant, Tadley, unearthed a letter sent to him by a local clergyman in 1941 while he was in the Stalag VIII B camp in Crapiz, Poland.

In the letter, the Rev J R Brooke-Davis, of Tadley, told the prisoner the latest news from home, including the christening of Mr Cottrell's baby nephew.

Mr Cottrell said: "It meant everything to me when I received the letter

back then.

"Letters were so precious, if anyone got one they let everyone else read them."

Mr Cottrell, a Royal Artillery gunner, was captured at Calais in May 1940 and remained a prisoner until the end of the war.

ROAD HORROR

Teenager dies in collision

A THATCHAM teenager died and two other people were injured in a two-car accident on the Old Oxford Road at Donnington on Tuesday evening.

Matthew Charles Cottrell, 15, from Bourne Road in Thatcham was a passenger in a Mini Metro which was involved in a collision with a Ford Sierra.

An inquest on the death was opened on Thursday morning, when his father, Mr Charles Cottrell, told assistant West Berks coroner Simon Barrett that he had formally identified the body.

The Metro was being driven by 18-year-old Nigel Langford from Bath Road, Thatcham, and the Sierra by Tim Paine from Priory Road in Newbury.

Mr Paine, son of local photographer John Paine, was slightly injured and was treated at the Royal Berkshire hospital in Reading and discharged.

His wife, Amanda, was also taken to the Royal Berkshire Hospital, along with Mr Langford. Mrs Paine went home on Wednesday and Mr Langford was said to be "comfortable" yesterday.

The accident happened about 50 yards north of the junction with Grove Road.

Road death: car going 'too fast'

CORONER RECORDS

ACCIDENT VERDICT

A VERDICT of accidental death was recorded by coroner Charles Hoile at the inquest into the death of road victim Matthew James Cottrell of Bourne Road in Thatcham.

At the inquest, held at Newbury Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, the coroner heard from pathologist Dr Leo Horton that Matthew, aged 15,

died from thoracic injuries that were sustained in a road accident on October 11.

The court heard how the cream-coloured Metro car in which Matthew was a front seat passenger, driven by Nigel Dermott Langford of Bath Road, Newbury, came into collision with a Ford Sierra Estate driven by Mr Timothy Payne, of Priory Road, Newbury, when negotiating a right-hand bend in the Oxford Road close to the junction with Grove Road.

Mr Payne said at the inquest: "On the night of the accident, my wife and I were coming back from work heading south along the Oxford Road. I recall a car coming in the opposite direction and it cut across us, it was a blur.

"The car came across our side of the road, its back end seemed to be coming towards us and there was a collision."

The emergency services were called and Matthew was rushed to hospital but died in the ambulance.

PC Brian Cooper interviewed Mr Langford after the accident. Mr Langford told him he remembered coming home that evening after work and eating a pomegranate and afterwards in the hospital, but he remembered nothing of the accident itself.

Langford told the police officer that the first time he heard of his best friend's death was when he read it in the papers. As a result of the accident, Mr Langford had suffered a degree of brain damage which resulted in a loss of memory.

Witness Andrew Paul Stennett of Northwood Drive, Newbury, said on the night of the accident he and three passengers were driving along the Oxford Road in his Datsun car behind the Metro.

Mr Stennett described the conditions on the night as wet as it had been raining but the road was well-lit.

He said: "I was breaking the speed limit at the time. The limit was 30, and I was doing about 45. There was an Escort on our side and we both overtook it.

"I wasn't going mad just driving and as we reached the bend he just lost control. The back of the car slid. He was travelling too fast for the conditions as it was a greasy surface."

Giving his verdict Mr Hoile said: "The driver of the Sierra was travelling reasonably at the time and did not have the opportunity to take any avoiding action.

"The probable cause of the collision was excess speeding, braking or steering or one or more of these."




