# Brothers present a place of peace and quiet

**BROTHERS** Guy and Gordon Elliott, 74 and 72 years of age respectively, have made a gift of a wooden seat to the village of Little London to celebrate their family living in the village since 1865.

Their great-grandparents first lived at College Farm while their grandfather ran the Rifleman public house opposite.

The family then lived at Stacey's Farm—now known as Martingale Farm—and Pamber Farm before moving in 1922 to Frog Lane Farm where they still live.

The seat has been put at the Frog Lane entrance to Pamber Forest, by kind permission of the Benyon Estate.

At the presentation, Mr Guy Elliott said in his speech to friends and members of Pamber Parish Council that he hoped the villagers of Little London would find this a peaceful place to rest after a long walk or somewhere to just sit and admire the view.

Frank Mitchell, chairman of Pamber Parish Council, thanked the brothers for their generosity.





# Tea room's future is looking rosy

CUSTOMERS in need of a pick-me-up at a Tadley garden centre now have somewhere to go for a caffeine fix.

Little Roses, a tea room at Elm Park Garden Centre, Pamber End, opened last month and offers tea and freshly-ground coffee, baguettes, panninis, soup, homemade cakes and other snacks.

There is also a small gift section.

Liz Harris, who runs the business with her husband Chris, said: "It's going really well. In the summer we're hoping to open up more outside so people can sit at the back, near the fields."

The couple gave up their jobs in Brighton to set up the cafe and Mrs Harris is sure they did the right thing.

"We both think it was the right decision to come back," she said.

"It's great being back in the countryside and

it's so peaceful and calm."

The cafe is called Little Roses because Mrs Harris' grandfather, Jack Philp, named a rose he created after her. The Elizabeth Philp rose is still sold in the garden centre, which is owned by Mrs Harris' family.

As the only members of staff, Mr and Mrs Harris are currently putting in seven-day weeks to get the tea room established.

However, Mr Harris believes they are heading in the right direction.

"We are starting to build up a regular customer base and word is beginning to get around," he said.

"We are running a loyalty card offer whereby people have a card which they get stamped each time they buy a cup of tea or coffee. When they have collected six stamps they get the seventh cup free."




Derek was very much involved with his church and worked hard for it and will be greatly missed by the church and his many friends. The sympathy of

Derek was for many years a member of our Church Family at Tadley Common and although in poor health played an active part in the life of the Church. He will be sadly missed by us all.

Dear Friends

I write to thank you for all the support you have given me over the past few weeks since Derek's death. The cards, flowers, prayers and acts of kindness have been endless and have helped me tremendously. I would like to say a big thank you to all those who helped Brenda with the refreshments on the day of Derek's funeral/thanksgiving service. The whole family appreciated everything that was done for us on that day. All of this support just showed a measure of the high regard which you all felt for Derek.

He truly was remarkable and all your cards and letters, over 180 in all, mention his courage, bravery and positive spirit which he always maintained how ever bad things became. Who else would have gone out to buy a camper van 2 days before going to the Royal Brompton Hospital in London for investigative surgery for possible lung cancer? The tests were to prove negative and Derek enjoyed a further 9 months of life. In the last 6 months he began to feel better after the poor health suffered in 1998. We enjoyed many short breaks and days out in our camper van. I can honestly say that Derek lived until he died. His death was as he would have wanted it to be. He went out on a 'high'. His poor heart just stopped beating and he died peacefully on the same day he had been tinkering with his camper van.

I felt the time was right for him and certainly I felt God was right there. I can draw strength and comfort from this. Let me share with you several things which happened prior to Derek's death, some of them quite out of the ordinary and which I cannot put down to coincidence.

Derek's brother had spent the day with him very recently, this was an 'out of the blue' visit and I know they both enjoyed their day together.

Derek spoke at great length to his Mother on the Monday of the week he died. She remarked how perky he sounded.

The night previous to his death he spoke to Michael, our eldest son, at length on the phone.

On the day he died, Alison, Ido and family, our daughter and son-in-law, had been on holiday and circumstances brought them to our house on the way home. They spent a pleasant hour or two in the garden just chatting and enjoying the time together before Derek's dialysis treatment later in the afternoon.

Neil, our youngest son, rang from Northern Ireland, just as Derek was by the phone and so they were able to speak to each other.

Kevin, of course, pops in and out all the time to help with computer problems and generally keeping an eye on us.

Derek's sister Moira had been away on holiday and we hadn't seen her for over a month. When the doorbell rang on the morning Derek died, I was amazed to see Moira on the doorstep. In 30 years of living in Tadley, Moira has never had occasion to visit during the daytime. She had a small task to do locally from work and so called for a coffee and spent time in the garden with Derek.

I know that Derek would have struggled to get through another winter and so I was trying to prepare myself for this awful moment. My prayer was that when Derek's time came, it would be while he was well and not after a long period in hospital. My prayer was answered.

Derek had requested that there was to be no black, no tears, no long faces or morbidity at his funeral. He felt he had had a good and happy life and his funeral service was to reflect this and be a celebration. I'm afraid to say there were tears, but there was laughter too, but best of all there was hope. When I am feeling low, I remember the words which our dear minister, Clive, said at the close of the service and I leave them with you now:-

"Derek is more alive today than he ever has been. Our loss is his infinite gain."



# The circle of life

LOOKING forward to celebrating their golden wedding anniversary tomorrow are a couple from Pamber Heath who have been reflecting on the way life goes round in circles.

*Excluded from School:* Stephen Englefield, smallholder, appeared to answer an information alleging that his daughter Alice, aged 12, had not attended school.

The evidence of Miss M. Ford, school attendance officer, and, of Miss M. Simpson, school nurse, showed that Alice was excluded from school on September 25th and again on October 7th.

Between October 7th and December 8th, her attendances were 50 out of 87.

Miss Simpson said that on October 7th she took the child home and showed her mother the state of the child's hair and left instructions for treatment.

On November 18th the school doctor again excluded Alice. On December 16th, she was clean.

The defendant said his eyesight and that of others who had looked at the child's head was not good enough to discern anything but scurf.

The School Nurse's evidence, however, was that the mother admitted that there were nits in her hair.

The magistrates inflicted a fine of 10s.

Dr Maples stated that he visited the premises on the 22nd of June. The pig-sty was in a horrid condition and close to the houses. There was also a dairy close by. The place was in a filthy state and was a nuisance and injurious to health. It was in the same condition last Monday.

Fined £1 including costs, and ordered to comply with the order within ten days.


