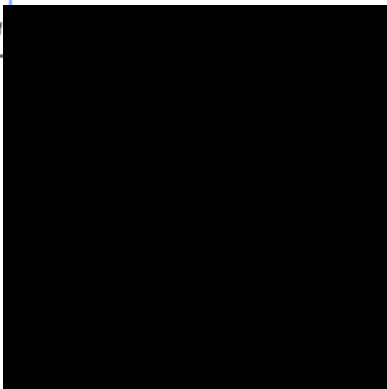

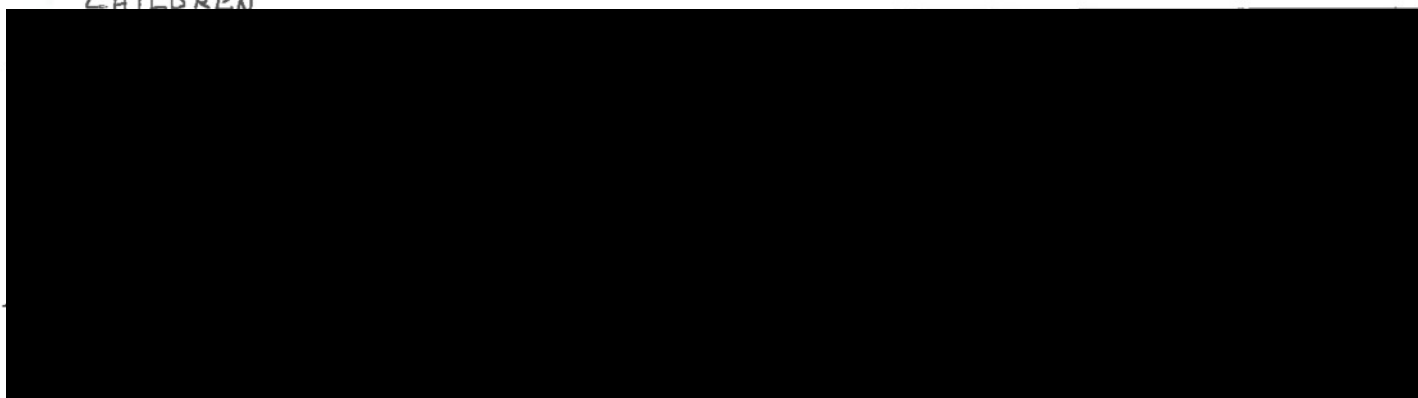

With regards to your info, i did find Normans grandparents on the Appleton side, i guess that he got his dark hair from his mothers side (grandmother). My father looks like a slimmer version of William James even more so than Norman! (He hasn't inherited the dark hair)

I also found a picture of you in The 'Pamber Heath History' book by R.West. I have to say that there is a resemblance between you as a child and Cissie and Violet Appleton. After looking at the books i have been left with the impression that there were two distinct James families, the Blacksmiths who were popular and outgoing (i.e) Stan played football etc, and then the James family i have descended from possibly wealthy but reserved??(unlike the family we are now!!) There are very few photos of the James' from my side.

These books have left questions: did Williams James' sisters have children (which would be Normans cousins)? They could still be around today-possibly worth talking to on my visit! Did William have a sister that died (Anne) as she was not pictured? she is in the 1901 census as his older sister?

I apologise if i am pestering you with questions, but i have known nothing of Norman and his family for most of my life, so i am intrigued by your information!

Pleased to hear from you, also pleased to hear that you are planning to visit Tadley. Should you have time you are welcome to call on us, but expect you will find more than enough to take up your time if you are only visiting for a day.

On page 4 of Around Tadley People and Places, there is a school photograph which mentions Violet Appleton and Cissie Appleton, who were sisters of your great-grandmother Agnes Rose and on page 93 a photograph of Albert and Kate Appleton who were their parents.

Details of this family are as follows—Albert George Appleton married Kate Hawkins 29/12/1900 at Tadley.

Albert George was baptised 12/11/1876 at Tadley, a son of Henry Appleton and Mary Ann,

25/03/2005

(nee Hedgecock)

Kate Hawkins was baptised 30/7/1871 at Tadley and was a daughter of Noah Hawkins and Sarah West.

Albert and Kate had four daughters, the eldest being Agnes Rose, who was known as Rose.

The second was Cecilia Amelia (Cissie) born 26/5/1903 and baptised 16/8/1903 at Baughurst. She was un-married and died 11/11/1987

The third was Violet Gwendoline, baptised 14/1/1906 at Baughurst and married 13/11/1924 at Tadley to Albert Arnold Hiscock. They had several children.

The fourth was Elizabeth Lilian, known as Lily, and baptised 2/5/1909 at Baughurst and also un-married. Cissie and Lily lived together.

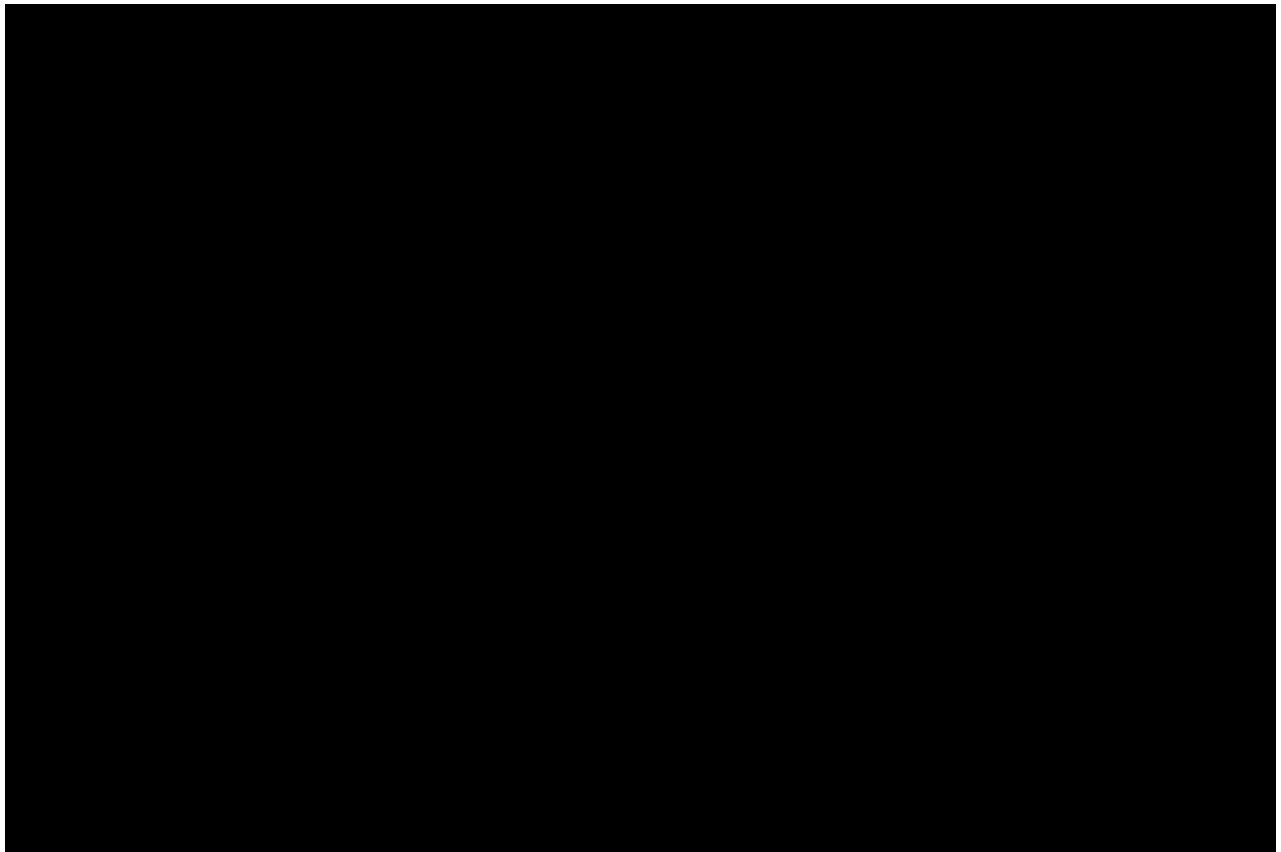
Albert Appleton died 2/5/1934, aged 57 and was of Bishopswood Farm, Tadley. He was buried 5/5/1934 at St Peters, Tadley

Kate Appleton died 9/10/1931, aged 60 and was of Bishopswood Farm, Tadley. She was buried 12/10/1931 at St Peters, Tadley. They have a tombstone.

Dont have photos of Rose or of Norman.

In Duties on Land Values of 1910, which gives details of owners and occupiers of all Tadley land and properties, George James was the occupier of buildings and land at Hawley Farm, which was of 46 acres 3 roods, but the owner was said to be the Executors of T Wells.

This seemed to be separate to Hawley House, which was of 6 acres 1 rood, owned by the same people, but no occupier given, but probably George James, as I didn't know that there were two buildings.

Also listed was a plot of land at Mount Pleasant of 1 acre 1 rood owned by George James.

A fond farewell to Fred

HUNDREDS of people turned out in Tadley to pay their respects to "a typical countryman".

Fred James, 68, from Pamber Heath, died on May 4 from heart failure.

His funeral at St Paul's Church in Tadley was so well attended that mourners had to stand outside.

Paying tribute to his friend, Mark Vincent, from Goddards Green, told *The Gazette* that Tadley had lost "a real character".

He said: "He was unique. There will never be another Fred James because they don't make them like that any more."

"He was an old-school person - a typical countryman."

Mr James was known as "Fred the log" because of his logging business in Pamber Heath, a job he had done all his working life.

Mr Vincent said: "He had a

cheeky way about him. When meeting customers, he had a knack of picking up their whole life story - he was interested in people."

The Pelican Pub, in Silchester Road, Pamber Heath, knew Mr James as one of its most devoted regulars, and he was honoured with a stool bearing his name.

Landlady Elizabeth Saunders said he was an integral part of the pub. She added: "He was a seven-day-a-week man and very much a character of the pub. He also knew people from all over the place and would always try to help."

Mr James was born on December 14, 1941 at Broadhalfpenny Lane, Tadley, to parents Albert and Rosina James, who were Romany people.

To respect his heritage, the family had a funeral cortege with lorries bearing flowers (*main picture*).

And the day before there were also the traditions of paying respects to him and sitting by a fire to remember his life.

Mr James leaves behind his wife Diana and their children Tracy, Mark, Rachel, and Fredrick.

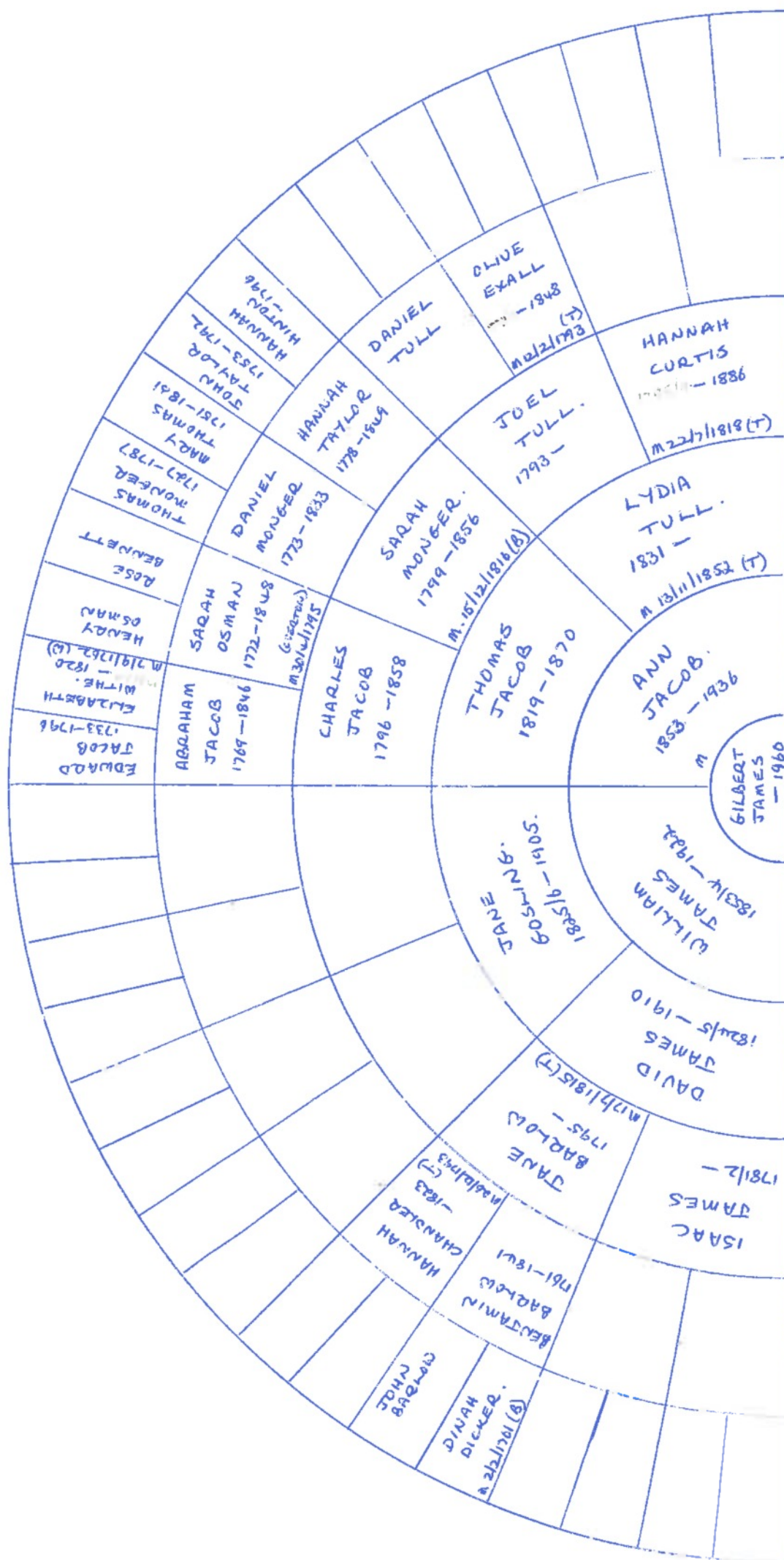

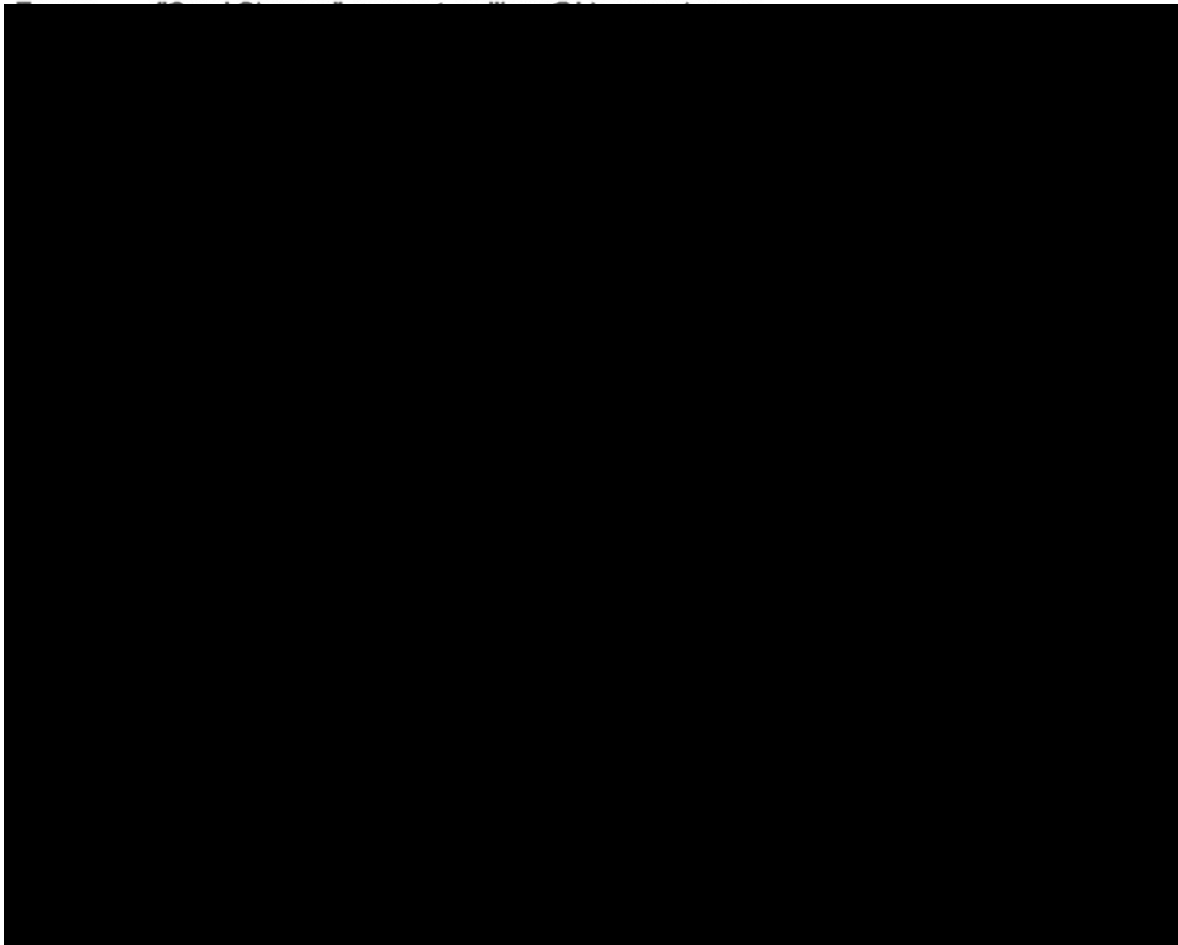

One of Tadley's oldest residents, Mr John James, aged 92 of The Forge Tadley, died recently. He earned his weekly florin a week 1874 as an apprentice to Mr Foster who was the blacksmith at Bramley and walked to and from Bramley night and morning. Mr James married at the Baughurst Tabernacle in 1878 and is survived by his wife aged 93.

Following his apprenticeship, Mr James set up business in Tadley, continuing for many years and latterly being assisted by his sons.

I am presently researching my family tree. At the moment I am trying to find out as much information as I can about a John James (my Great Great Grandfather) who lived in Tadley.

Here is the information I have so far:

- 1) Birth is approx 1857/1858. John is the son of David James & Jane James Formerly Gosling. All records suggest he was born in Tadley
- 2) John married Drucilla Lock, 15 March 1878.
- 3) John was one of six children
- 4) It is believed John James became the first blacksmith in Tadley
- 5) John died 16th Jan 1948, and I believe he may be buried at The United Reform Church, although I have been unable to contact them to confirm this.

As you can see I do already have quite a bit of information. However the one key fact I am missing is his date of birth. I have checked research site such as Free BMD, and ancestry. But cannot find a birth record, although I understand this may be quiet common. I have also asked the couple of family members still alive who remember him, and even visited the Hampshire records office in Winchester.

I have tried several different searches on Google, and have found several links back to your web site with reference to John James, but still no details on his birth, and so hence the email.

Thank you for the information you have sent through. This does help, as it confirms certain information I already have.

I understand from my Nan (John & Drusilla were her Grand Parents) that yes they are buried at the Old Meeting Church. I did visit out there and walked around but could not find there grave/headstone. Not sure if it has been moved or just over the years the inscript has become unreadable.

I have tried to contact the church both via phone and email, as I was hoping there may be some record of Johns DOB with his death/burial record, as it seems to be common for people to list the DOB on the headstone. But to be honest I have had no success in contacting the church.

I think you may be right, and this will just be one of those to which we never find the answer. John's DOB is one of those little things that stick with you in a bid to find the answer. I will keep looking as I understand the James family were quiet well known in Tadley. Maybe in one of the historical books, they may be reference to a birthday or something like this that will lead me to the answer. Having said this whilst I still try to remain hopeful, every turn presently leads to a dead end.

Tadley History Society have passed your request for information regarding your Gt Gt Grandfather to me, as i usually do research for them. I have copies of the Parish Registers for Tadley, also for the Old Meeting (URC) and have been researching Tadley families for years.

I was born in Tadley and my father's family have lived here for generations.

Am sending you family group sheets for your family, but doubt if they will tell you anything you don't already know.

There is no record of John's baptism in the Parish Register, but think he was probably baptised at the Old Meeting but no baptisms were recorded there between 1837 and

1886 we will probably never know.

As you will see four children were baptised there after 1886, so think the others could have been as well.

Have pencilled in who i think Isaac's parents could have been, but have no proof of this.

John and Drusilla have a tombstone at Tadley old meeting, or did when the stones were recorded in 1978

My grandparents were also married at the Baughurst Tabernacle on June 26th 1888. They were Methodists, but the Methodist Chapel at Baughurst was not registered for marriages at that time, but the Methodist minister married them, with the Registrar also present.

Hope this may be of some use to you.

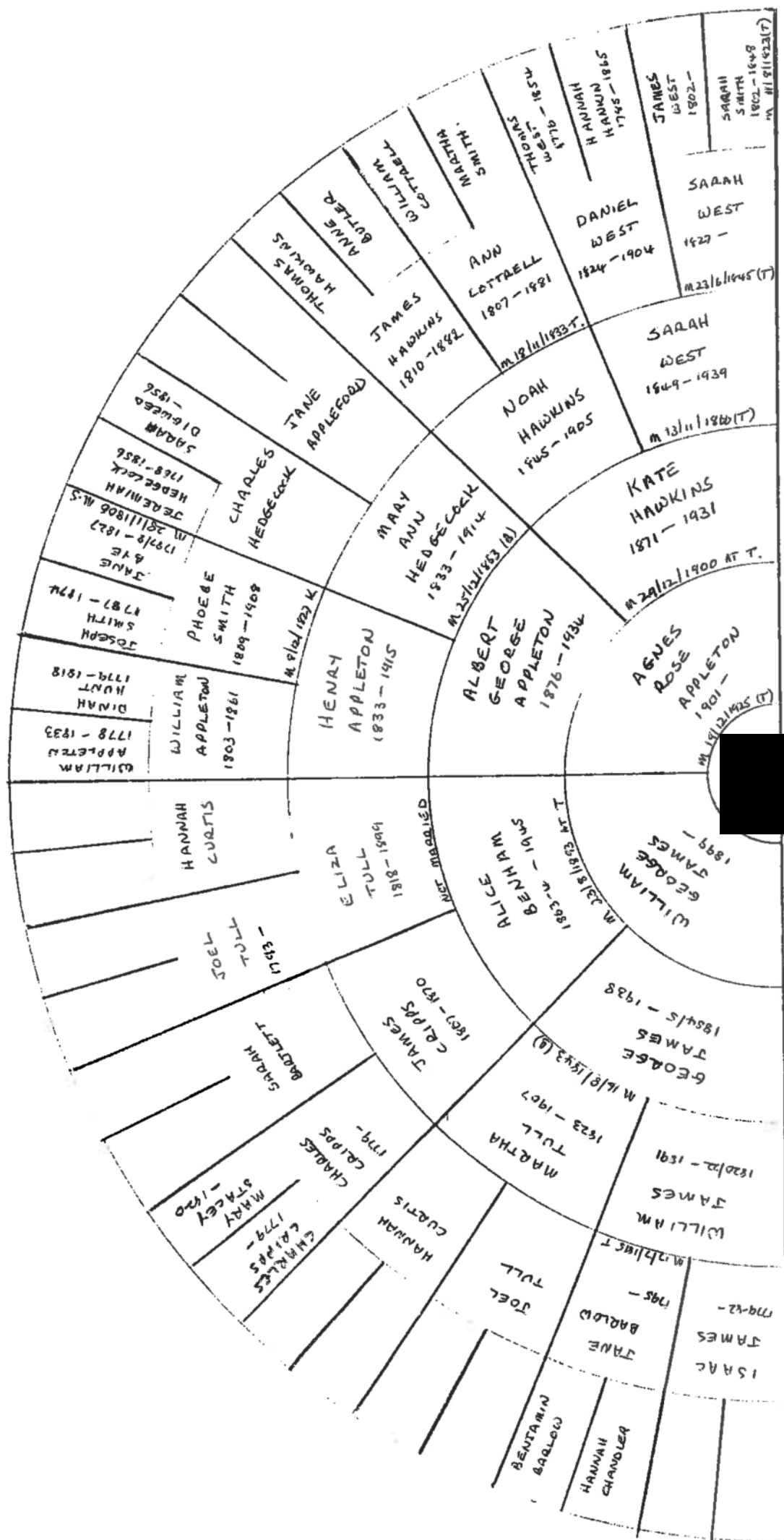


TADLEY OLD MEETING REGISTER OF BAPTISMS 1886-1931

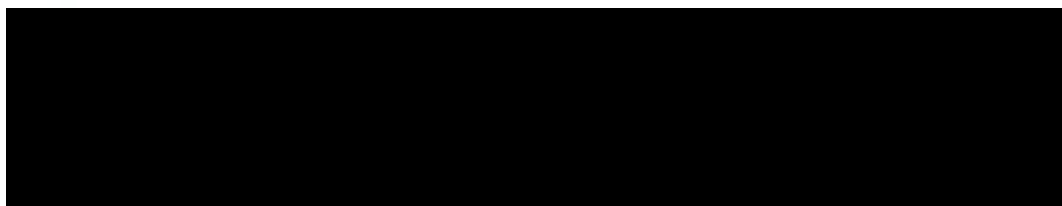


Sorry not to have made this clear, but they were the children of William and Mary James and all Baptised at Pamber.
