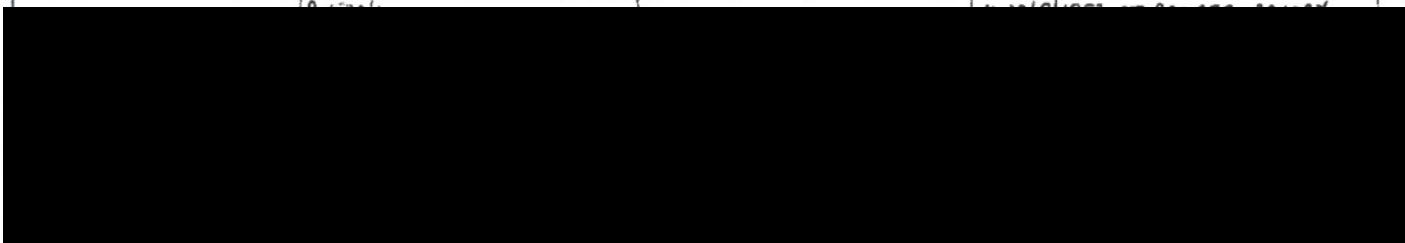

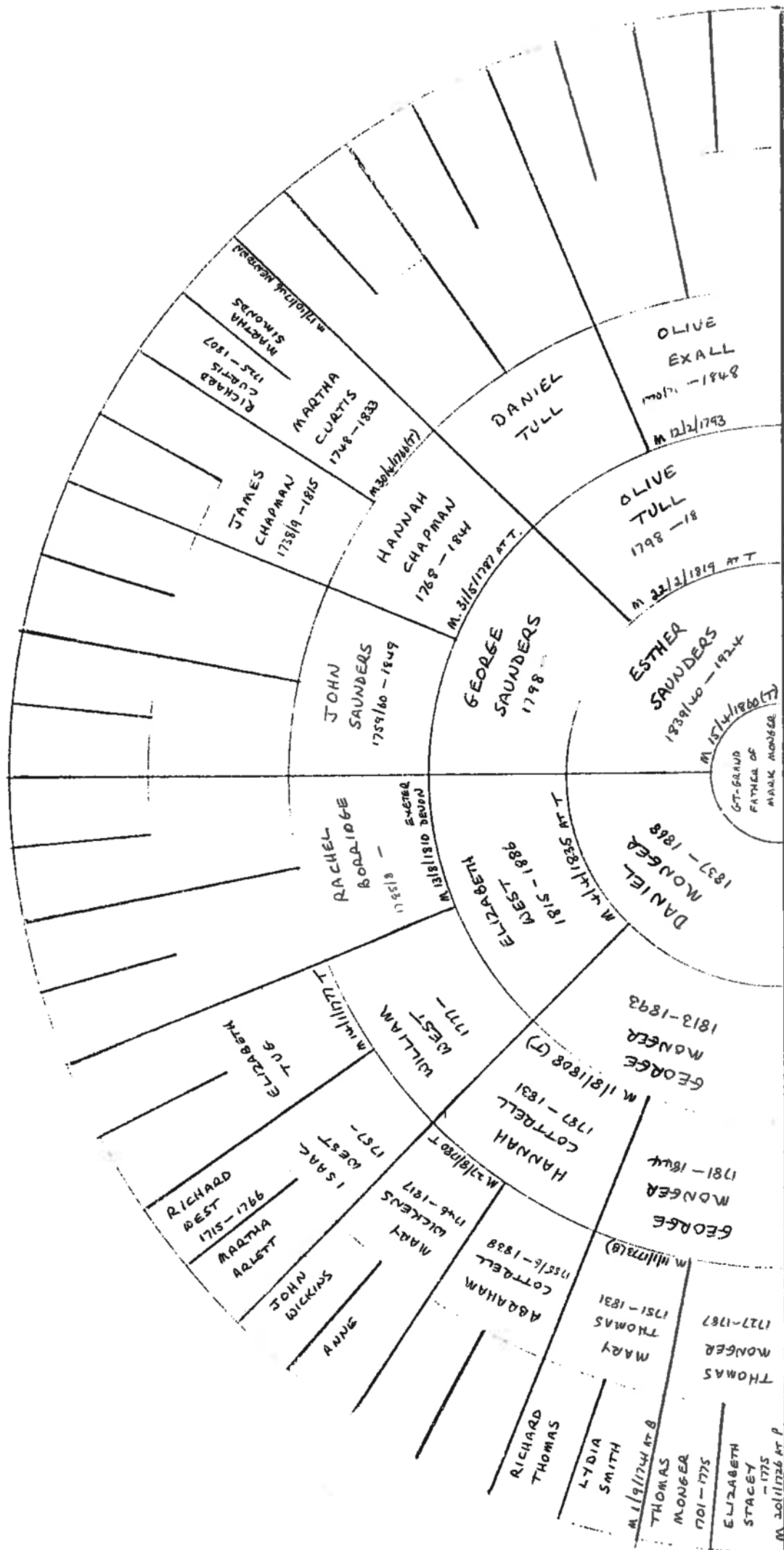

I have been given your name by Derek West regarding Tadley Family History as a possible source of information. I have been researching my Tree for the past year and I believe my tree originates from Tadley before 1860. I am looking for some help and I wondered if you could point me in the right direction. I have gained my information so far from either the 1881 census or the Tadley parish records held on microfiche in Winchester.

This what I know

Thomas Monger (parents unknown) Born 1727 in Tadley had two wives

Wife 1 Avis west had two children Martha and Issacs all born in Tadley.

Wife 2 Mary Thomas had four children Daniel, Elizabeth, Sarah and **George** all born in Tadley.

George Born 1781 Tadley
Married
Hannah Cotttrell in 1808 Tadley

They had 7 Children **George**, Thomas, Mary, William, Sarah, John, Elizabeth All born in Tadley.

George born 1813 Tadley
Married
Elizabeth West / Weston not sure ? in 1835 in Tadley

They Had 9 Children

Henry, **Daniel**, Francis, Charles, Noah, George, David, Alice, Sarah all born in Tadley.

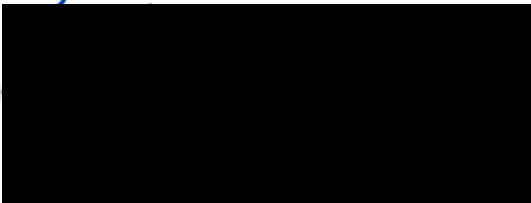
Daniel is my Great Great Grandfather which I can confirm through Birth Certificates. Every thing before this is a process of elimination so there may be some errors. Daniel married Esther Saunders in 1860 (I have the marriage certificate) in Tadley. They then moved to Pamber before Daniels premature death some 10 years later.

I know from another source that Mongers were living in Tadley in 1669 when John was born to George (born 1634 ?) & Mary. I do not whether these are relations.

I have many other records for family members living in Tadley during this period but I thought it worth just concentrating on my direct family.

I would be grateful for any pointers you can give me

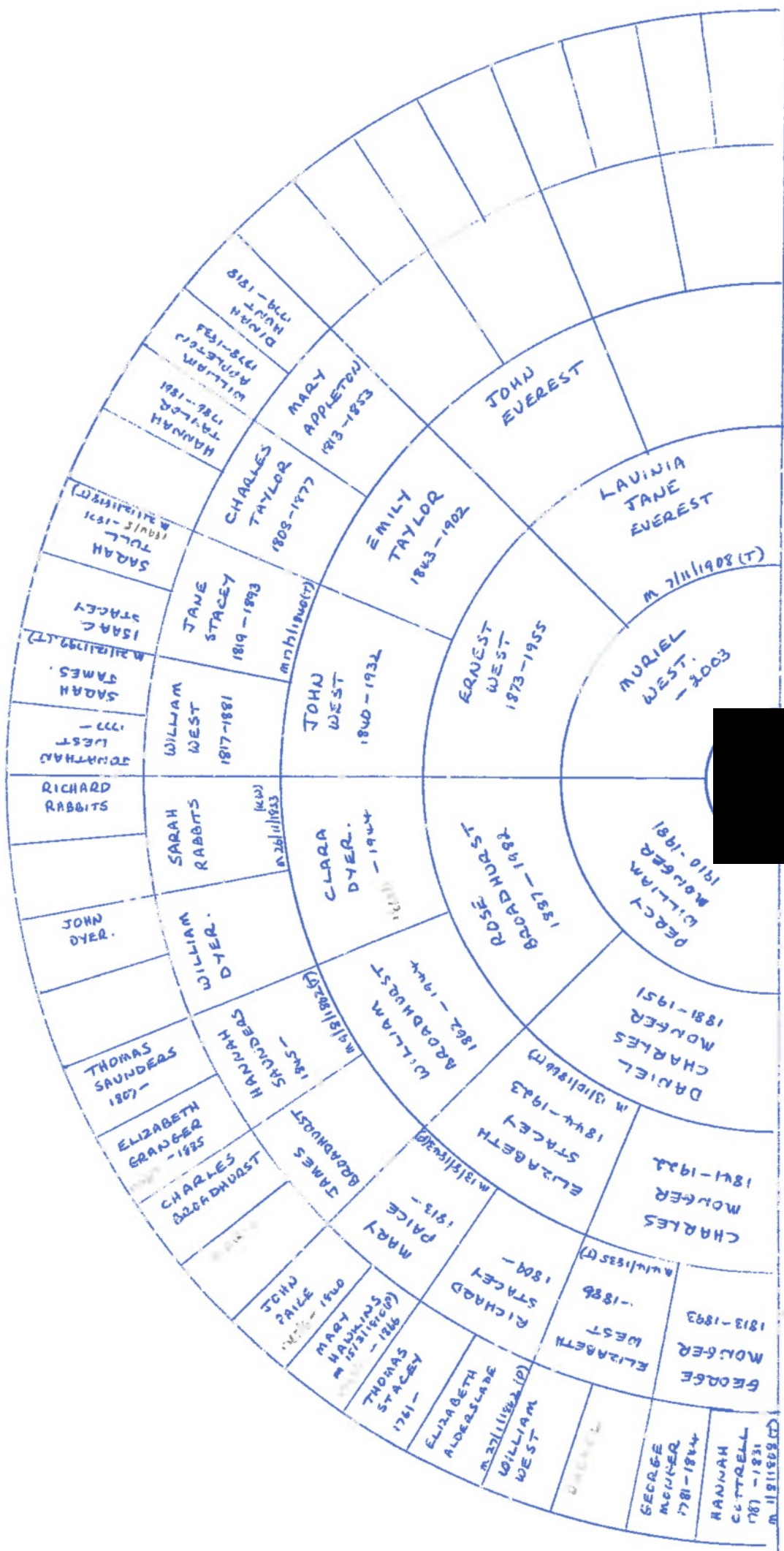
