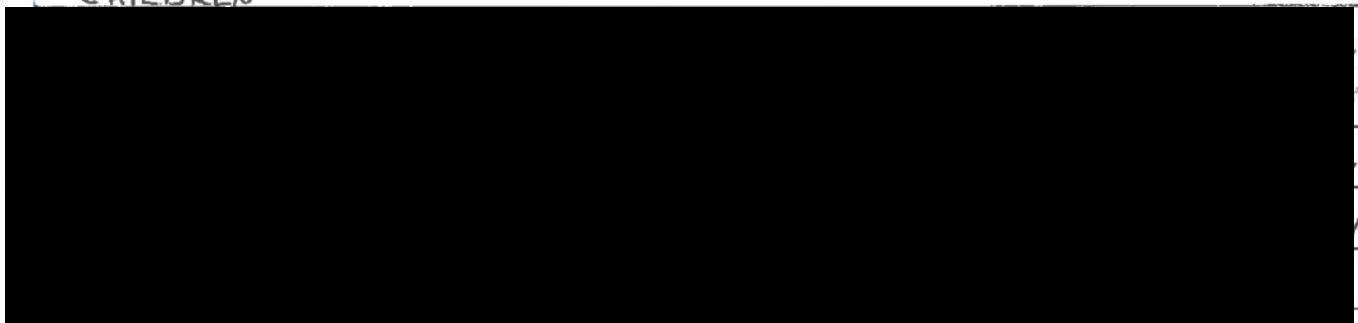

Married in a spin!

A WHIRLWIND wedding on September 9, 1939, has had its golden consequences at Tadley, where 160 guests at Tadley Community Centre drank the health of Arthur and Georgina Nash, of Swains Close, Tadley, on the anniversary day.

The wedding took place at Pamber Priory just 18 hours after Arthur was given a 48-hour pass by his officer while serving with the Royal Army Service Corps, before embarking for France.

Until his interview with the officer, he had no idea of an immediate wedding.

The pass was from 8am on the Saturday to 8am on the Monday. His corporal, however, did Arthur a favour by letting him leave his unit - stationed the other side of London - at 8pm on the Friday. He arrived home to tell Georgina that they were to be wed within a few hours.

At 9am he called on the Vicar, the Rev E. J. Bolus, who put the machinery in motion - a hurried visit to Basingstoke Register Office and a dash to Winchester on his motorcycle by Arthur to obtain the special licence. At 2.30pm they were married.

There was no time for a photograph, but this

was put right 50 years later, when the couple on the anniversary day to renew their vows.

Arthur took part in the fighting in France, managed to cross the Channel during the Retreat from Dunkirk and after being transferred to the Army Catering Corps, returned to France on D-Day.

Arthur is a Tadley man whose family have been involved in the besom broom industry for 200 years. Georgina was born at Pamber, moving to Tadley to live next door but one to Arthur at Mulfords Hill, Tadley. Their present

bungalow is only a few yards from where they grew up and where their friendship led to marriage.

After leaving school Georgina, like many other girls of her generation, went into domestic service. Arthur was a lorry driver before he joined the Army, but in later years he has been a self-employed forester. He took up forestry after leaving the Army.

Arthur and Georgina have four sons, Arthur, Raymond, Robert and Denis, and a daughter Christine. They also have 14 grandchildren and one great grand child.

OBITUARY

Arthur Nash

ARTHUR NASH, the head of one of Tadley's oldest families, was buried yesterday at the town's Old Meeting House.

He died at his home in Swains Close, Tadley, on Tuesday of last week, aged 74.

He leaves a widow, Georgina, daughter Christine and sons Arthur, Raymond, Robert and Dennis.

Parents William "Granfer" Nash and his wife Agnes brought Arthur up in the family home at Blakes Lane.

He attended what is now Tadley Primary School at The Green and when he left worked in forestry.

When it came to marriage only "the girl next door" would do for Arthur.

He married Georgina, who lived only one door away, in 1939.

He served in the Army during the whole of the Second World War, seeing combat in France and Belgium.

His love of France saw many returns to the battlefields. He took his family there annually to meet friends he had made in the war years.

In all, he made around 15 tours of the Normandy beaches, war graves and military museums.

The family fondly remember Arthur above all as a generous man who always had time for those less well off than himself.

Son Robert said from the family home last week: "Once he caught someone asleep in his car after having broken into it for the night.

"But he didn't call the police. Instead he gave him enough money to get himself a decent meal and let him go on his way.

"Once he even gave a down-and-out man the boots off his own feet.

"I'd be hard-pressed to name one enemy he's made in all the years he's lived in Tadley."

When not working, Arthur enjoyed family holidays either in France or closer to home in the Hampshire hop fields.

He continued to visit places like Bentley long after the hop-picking tradition, part of family life in the south for many years, began to fade.

His love of the country and knowledge of Tadley caused him to be sought out recently for a television programme about the area, expected to be shown by TVS in the autumn.



Arthur makes a clean sweep

BROOM maker Arthur Nash may not rate his brooms as a method of transport - but he's convinced there is nothing like them for sweeping up leaves.

Demand for his witches' brooms is as healthy as when his family first started raking them in Tadley over 200 years ago and production methods have hardly changed.

Mr Nash (48), of Mulfords Hill, Tadley, is working to complete an order for 400 dozen and says he often has to turn orders away.

His stout brooms, hand-made from hazel and birch twigs, are used to sweep up at such illustrious places as Buckingham Palace, Sandown racecourse and Wembley Stadium.

And London zoo have found them handy for another purpose - to clean out their animals' cages.

Most are sold in London, but a few have gone as far afield as Australia, Canada and the United States.

He says that in the sixties besom brooms lost out to man-made fibre substitutes, but in the last 20 years he says they have made a come-back.

But his ramshackle old yard, under threat by the march of progress, could close when he retires as he

has no one to take over the ancient craft.

"I've got a son just left school. It is a shame because he's a natural, but he's not really interested - he's more interested in computers."

In winter he and his brothers go round woods and copses in the area collecting the raw materials, which then are left to season for a year.

Part-time helpers, or birch-pickers as they are called, then process the

birch twigs, tying them into manageable piles.

Working at his ancient broom horse, Arthur bundles the twigs together, securing them with wire. Then last of all the hazel handle is rammed into the middle.

A well-known face at agricultural shows and summer fairs, Arthur says it is a rewarding job.

"You get a lot of satisfaction at the end of the day, you can see what you've done."

It's Arthur, making a clean sweep on TV

TV CAMERAS are set to focus on Tadley broom-maker Arthur Nash twice in the next four days.

Today BBC TV's Blue Peter presenters John Leslie, Diane-Louise Jordan and Anthea Turner are expected to turn their attentions to Arthur's besom broom-making activities at his home in Mulford's Hill.

The camera crew will also visit Englefield Estates where Arthur picks the birch twigs essential for the best Tadley brooms, which are even used to sweep the majestic lawns of Buckingham Palace.

The footage will be used to tie in with a Halloween feature the popular children's programme is making for next week.

But the BBC have been

pipped at the post for Arthur's story by TVS who commissioned Countrywide Films to make a film in Tadley.

The programme has already been made and will be screened on Monday.

Arthur, who is a member of one of Tadley's oldest families, will be seen telling stories and anecdotes about the

broom-making trade in the area.

He is joined by his old pals, Albert and Alf West, who live in street named after them, and is shown relaxing in the New Inn pub chatting with friends.

Arthur's brooms were once used in the iron and steel industry for brushing the scale from the molten metal as it was taken from the furnace.

Now he sells many of them at shows where they are often bought by foreign visitors who think they are cute, homespun and folksy but would not dream of actually using them to sweep things up.

"I go round shows and do demonstrations," says Arthur in the film.

"If there's any Americans they just love it. The youngsters think they're witches' broomsticks."

At the end of the programme Arthur recites a poem from the News Chronicle of February 1927.

Afterwards he says: "When I read that poem it chokes me up and I think 'What the hell's happened to our village?'"

Broom maker Arthur features in new book

Then five days later he popped up on the perennial children's favourite, *Blue Peter*, to give the programme an autumnal feel.

THE new owner and landlady of the Treacle Mine hotel, Tadley, whose late broom-maker father was one of the town's most popular figures, is building her new business with help from a supportive family.

Amanda Taylor, who took over the Treacle Mine Hotel on July 21 from landlady Denise West, is the daughter of the late Arthur Nash, who supplied besom brooms and pea sticks to The Queen.

His royal crest is still proudly displayed on the outer wall of the family home at Mulfords Hill.

Mrs Taylor, aged 39, who lives next door to her mother, Sue Nash, in Mulfords Hill, said that Mrs West, who ran the pub for 11 years, was a very hard act to follow.

However, she added that she was indebted to her own family, who were currently working all hours to help her paint and decorate the

pub, while also continuing her late father's broom-making tradition.

"I wanted a challenge, it stemmed from my father's death. You need an aim," said Mrs Taylor.

She added that she could not have done it without the help of her mother, sister Lisa Chocian, brother Bradley Nash and husband, Andy Taylor.

Locals and staff, she continued, had also been very supportive of her brave new venture, as she had had little experience in the trade.

"I was a housewife for 20 years, and didn't even go to pubs. I was at home with the kids," said Mrs Taylor, whose eldest child is 20, the youngest 10.

With the able hand of a new, live-in chef of 20 years' experience, Ivan Lilly, from Gosport, (he previously worked at the Queen Inn, Dummer), she aims to "step the restaurant up a notch", which will be made separate from the bar, although bar meals will still be available.

Mrs Taylor hopes to attract trade from everyone from dog walkers on Silchester Common to visitors to the rapidly-developing £1.5m football and sports pavilion, at Barlows Plantation, opposite the pub.

She said that her late father, who had been a chairman of Tadley Calvea Football Club, had initiated the plans for the Barlows Plantation sports facilities - a much-needed amenity in Tadley - and would have been immensely proud of her ambition to become a landlady.

"We know where his chair would be in the bar," said Mrs Taylor.

According to local legend, the Treacle Mine Hotel, which shares its name with the annual Treacle Fair in Tadley, is named after the glutinous black mud found in nearby Honeybottom Lane.

It exchanged hands, according to estate agents Christie & Co for a sum just below the asking price of £630,000. The hotel has seven letting rooms.

Previous owners include Adrian Thompson, a former British Airways Concorde pilot, who flew one of the supersonic aircraft's last transatlantic flights in 2003.

Mr Thompson owned a share of the pub with his twin brother Nigel and schoolpal Alan Dimmack.

Mr Dimmack also owned the Lowes Corner Hotel, Silchester Road, at the time

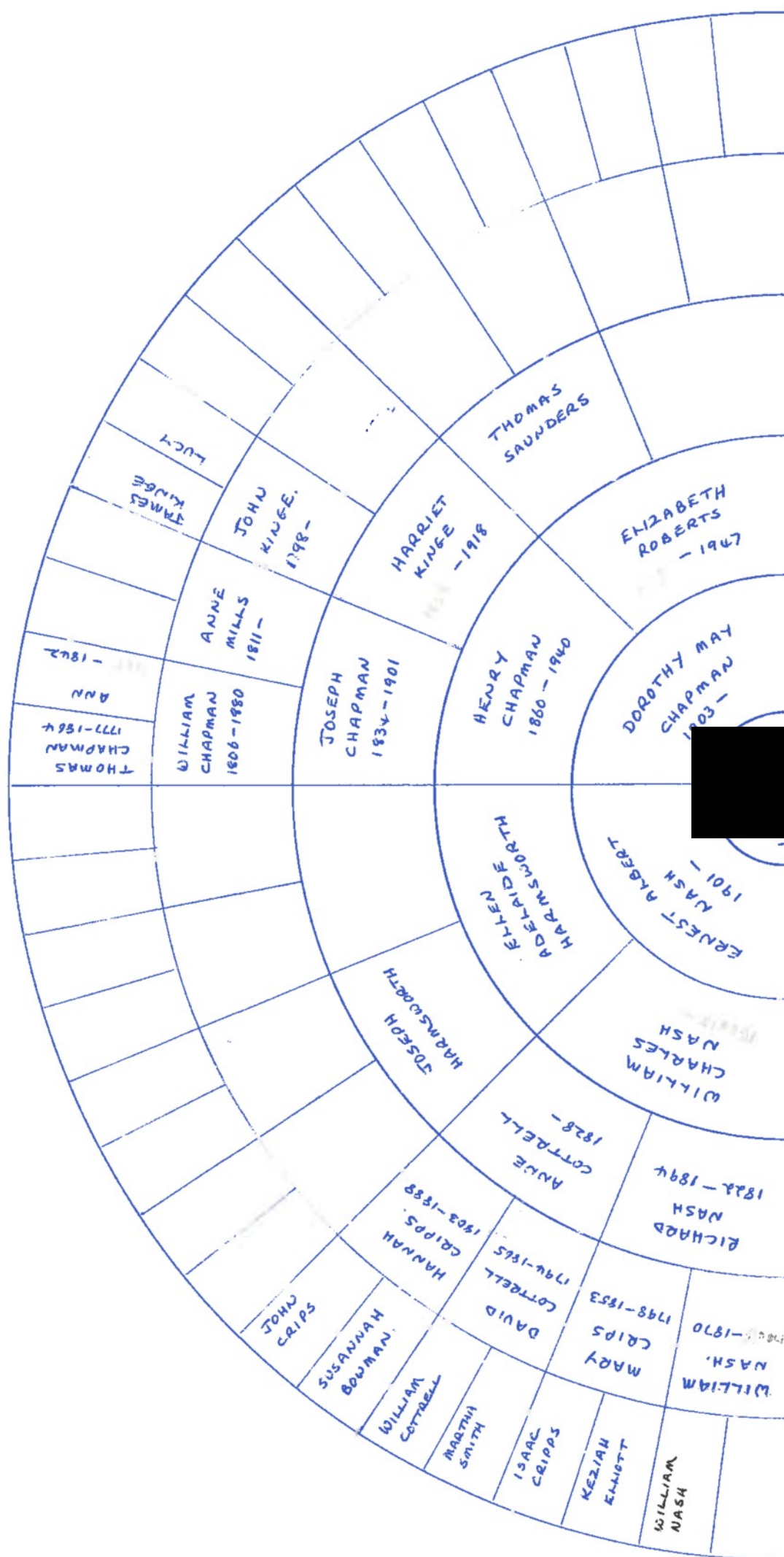

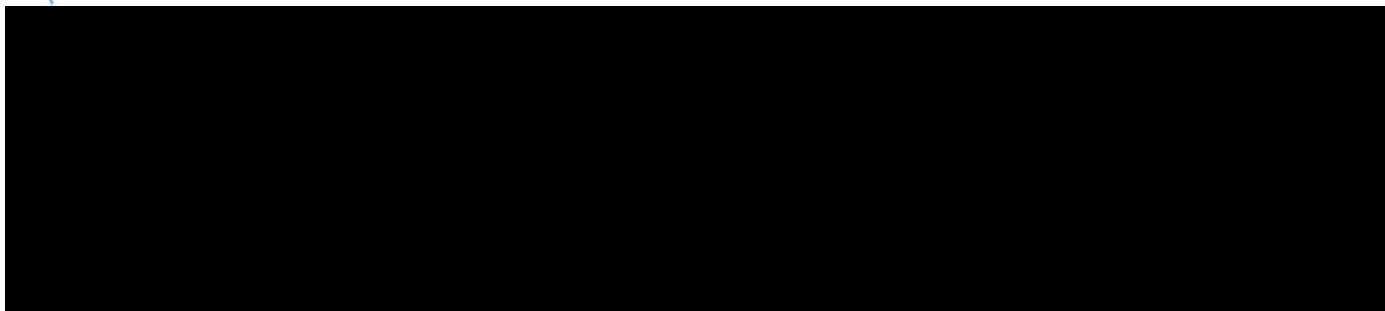

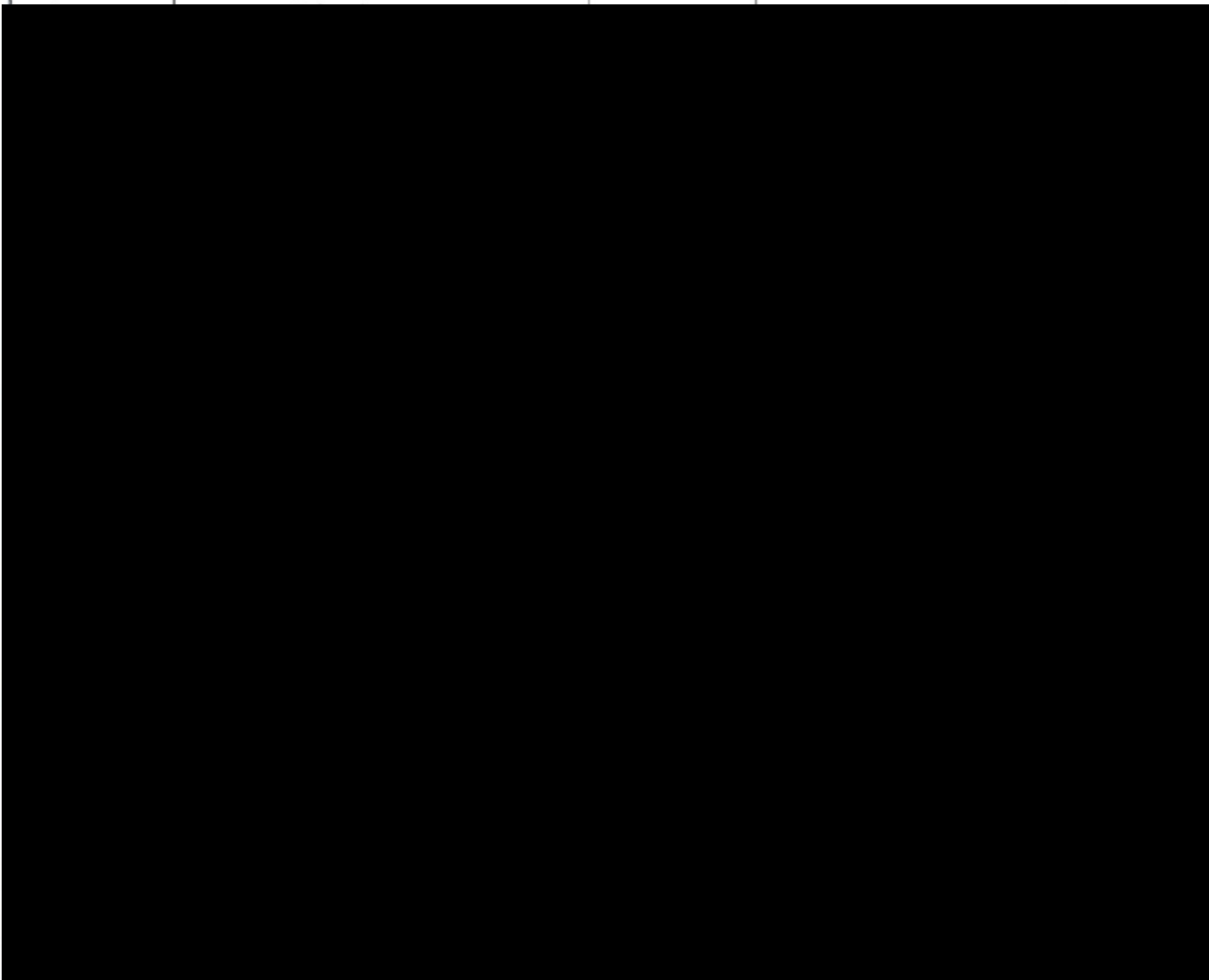

Ray's broom boom

ONE RURAL worker making a clean sweep in business is Raymond Nash (right), of Ashford Hill.

He makes the famous besom brooms from birch twigs in a workshop near his home.

Raymond said: "I learnt the skill from my father, Arthur. My brother also makes the brooms."

He spends the winter harvesting the birch and cutting it down to size.

Then it has to be bound at one end and the handles inserted.

He sells the brooms all over the country.

London Zoo is his biggest customer and he also sends it spare broom handles—the elephant keepers use them.

In training, the elephants have to step on the handles until they break to teach them to be sensitive to what is underfoot.

Other brooms find their way to the hallowed turf of Wembley Stadium.

They are reputed to be the ideal thing for all types of turf maintenance.

And the brooms come "government approved" with Epsom council issuing its workers with them.

"I think it's important to keep crafts like this alive," said Raymond.

"So often people around here are forced out of the area because of high house prices and the scarcity of affordable places to live.

"But this is a worthwhile skill and as long as people want my brooms I'm going to carry on making them."

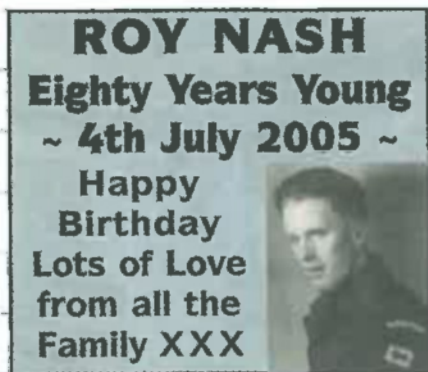

OBITUARY**The Rev William J R Nash**

William Nash was born in Portsmouth in 1903. He was brought up and educated there and on leaving school became a draughtsman.

As a young man he felt God's call to the ministry, so served a pre-collegiate year at Newton Abbot in 1925 before training at Richmond College. In the year of his ordination he married Rita. They were married for 45 years and had one son, Deryck.

After college Bill Nash served the Church in circuits in Bridport, Hastings, London (Woolwich), Macclesfield, Stoke-on-Trent, Truro, Perranporth, Falmouth, Andover and Silchester. Fourteen of those years were in Cornwall and nearly all his ministry was in the South of England. He retired to Emsworth in the Portsmouth circuit in 1969, where he lived for 20 years, very happily involved in the local church, until he moved to

Greenways MHA, Bognor Regis, for the closing chapter of his long life.

Rita lived seven years after they retired to Emsworth and Bill was a widower for four years: then he married Isobel in 1981, a late-flowering romance which gave him a daughter, Eileen.

Bill's longer ministries were in Silchester, his last full-time circuit — nine years — and as supernumerary at Emsworth — 20 years. He conducted services and preacher until a stroke in 1984 curtailed his active ministry. Throughout his life he was loved by children and young people and excelled in pastoral care.

We thank God for a good and faithful servant, his gracious care and concern for all people and his loyalty to our Lord. He died peacefully at Greenways in the 87th year of his age and the 62nd year of his ministry.
