Paddy Nixon - an appreciation

ON OCTOBER 17 at St. Stephen's Church, Baughurst, relations, colleagues and friends joined in a service of remembrance for the life of Miss Margaret Patricia Nixon, known to all as Paddy, after her unexpected death.

Paddy was one of four sisters, daughters of a veterinary surgeon, and grew up in East Anglia, near Newmarket, where her father worked. The family moved to the Tadley area in the early 1950s and Paddy joined the medical practice in Silchester Road as a pharmacist, having trained with a practice in Aldermaston. Initially she was also a receptionist. She was the soul of confidentiality and a true professional and a very supportive colleague.

Paddy was 19 at the beginning of World War II and somewhat against her parents' wishes she joined that elite corps, the F.A.N.Ys (First Aid and Nursing Yeomanry). They were the only women's corps at that time who were allowed to carry and use firearms. Many of the corps joined the S.O.E. (Special Operations Executive) and were sent to France but Paddy stayed in England and rose to the rank of Sergeant. She drove all manner of military vehicles and ambulances and could still remember

how to double declutch if she could reach the pedals. There is a great photograph of her leading 36 girls at the salute.

Paddy never married. She had a boyfriend who was killed in the war. But she filled her life with many interests and activities and had innumerable friends. She only gave up driving for the Hospital Car Service in recent years, and was driving and cycling regularly up to the end.

She was a keen Scottish dancer, always ready to volunteer for exhibitions at summer fetes and at that or ordinary dancing she was quite indefatigable. She loved music and went regularly to concerts locally and in London. She was a member of the RSPB and enjoyed walking, and playing golf, and going to horse racing at Newbury or Cheltenham.

She was a hardworking committee member at the Heath End Hall and willingly and enthusiastically painted the newly plastered walls in the new hall and never missed working parties. Her sisters, nephew and family, many friends and doctors from Holmwood and Morland health centres joined to celebrate her life and realise how sorely she will be missed.

Paddy died October 6th 1995. She was very well

known by everyone and will be sadly missed.

Her home was at 3 Morningside Close, Baughurst.

She lived alone.

Overnight extension for youngsters! home from home

A GRANT of £14,000 means a Basingstoke couple can now offer children in need a weekend stay at their home - giving the youngsters' families a well-earned break.

Diann and Alan North have been carers since 1990 with social services' Family Link scheme.

Over the years they have welcomed hundreds of children of all ages to spend the day at their Campsie Close home.

A grant from Hampshire county council has now paid for a bedroom and shower extension to the North family's home and means that youngsters can stay over at weekends and holiday periods.

The new ground floor rooms have wheelchair access so that children with severe physical disabilities can also enjoy a weekend stay.

One of the first visitors was five-year-old Bobby Corbett who lives with his parents Zena and Paul, at Oakley.

Bobby, who helped cut the tape to mark the completion of the extension, is looking forward to an overnight stay with the Norths. He suffers from cerebral palsy.

His mum said: "This is something that's needed. Diann is very caring and Bobby feels like one of the family. A lot of families in our position don't have relatives to rely on."

Zena said she and her husband occasionally found it difficult to devote time to their younger son Wesley, who is three.

If Bobby could stay with the Norths every six weeks, it allowed the family a break and also allowed Wesley to do the usual things for his age group.

"There's no doubt, there are places where disabled children are not welcome or

it's very difficult for them if you go out," said Zena.

Voluntary groups, local firms and pupils from Richfield and Aldworth community school all helped to raise extra funds for the project. Basingstoke Lions added the final touch - a garden shed which can be used as a toy and equipment store and which doubles as a playhouse for younger children.

Christine Fisher, Family Link coordinator, said the scheme has been running since 1989, but added this was only the second facility for overnight stays in Basingstoke.

"This is quite special and the way forward, being family-based," she said.

Diann and Alan North invited children, parents and social workers to their home to celebrate the new extension and meet their four teenage children, who all help with caring for the youngsters who stay with them.

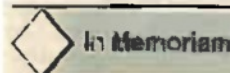
