# Golden years

**GOLDEN** greetings go out today to Frank and Marjorie Pearce at their bungalow in Raphael Close, Black Dam, Basingstoke, and many will come from Tadley, the area in which the couple have spent over 40 years of their happy married life together.

They were married on November 6, 1937 at the Oxford Hall Mission Chapel at Calne, Wiltshire, in the area where both were born.

They met when both worked at the local Co-op, but in order to get a house, Frank turned to farming and worked for a friend.

At the end of the Second World War the couple moved to Baughurst where Frank continued his farm work. He eventually left, to become a postman for 22 years at Tadley.

Frank and Marjorie lived at New Road, Tadley, on a site now occupied by Reading Warehouses. They left New Road to live at Pamber Green, where the couple had a bungalow built.

Five years ago they moved into Basingstoke to live at Black Dam. They still keep their close contact with Tadley through the Main Road Methodist Church where Marjorie is the organist.

Frank has been a local preacher on Methodist circuits for 50 years. For 15 years he was steward of the Silchester circuit and continued as steward for a further three

years when the Silchester circuit was merged with the one at Reading.

Marjorie was the organist at the chapel at which they were married and after moving to Baughurst became organist at Haughurst Hill Methodist Church, where, with her husband, she ran the Sunday School.

Frank took a very active part in local government at Tadley where he was a member of the parish council for many years, including periods as vice-chairman and chairman.

His particular interest was footpaths which he set out to walk twice every year. He was also clerk to the governors at both Tadley County Primary School and Bishopswood County Junior School, Tadley.

Both still run coffee mornings at Tadley Methodist Church and on Wednesday there will be a special service at the church, followed by lunch.

The couple have a son, Deryck, daughter-in-law, Pat, a daughter, Joy, and son-in-law Eric, and grandchildren Sharon, Keith and Russell. Celebrations are taking place this weekend but they are a closely-guarded secret.

Marjorie said: "To be happy in married life you have to be tolerant. Our church belief has helped us to be just that."

FIFTY YEARS of marriage has not dimmed Frank Pearce's ardour, as he gives his wife Marjorie a smacking good kiss at their golden wedding anniversary party.

All our thanks from Marjorie Pearce and famiy.



# Street party was road to romance

**A COUPLE who met at a street party to celebrate the end of the Second World War in Europe have celebrated their diamond wedding anniversary.**

Morry Pearce, 82, was serving as a Bevin Boy in the coal mines near Doncaster when he attended the same party in 1945 as his future wife Sylvia, now 80.

The event was held to mark the end of hostilities in Europe and took place in the Doncaster suburb of Balby.

The couple, who live in Sheridan Crescent, Tadley, got to know each other a bath full of apples that needed moving into the village hall, where the evening festivities were taking place.

Mr Pearce said: "I had seen Sylvia about, but hadn't met her properly, and I wanted to make sure I didn't mess it up when we first spoke. So, when I saw Sylvia had one handle of the bath, I ran over to make sure I was the one on the other end."

"During the trip to the village hall, I managed to convince her to take a stroll with me and it went from there."

After the party, Mr Pearce, who grew up in Monk Sherborne where his family ran a bakery, continued to work in the mines until he was released from duty in September 1947.

The couple were married on August 9, 1948, in St Peter's Church, in Balby, and had their honeymoon in Margate, Kent, where they stayed with a couple who got to know Mr Pearce's family when they came to Monk Sherborne to escape the bombing during the war.

Mr and Mrs Pearce then made their home in Monk Sherborne, later moving to Tadley. Mr Pearce took a job with the firm that had bought his parents' bakery, before getting a job in engineering with Lansing Bagnall, in Kingsclere Road, Basingstoke, where he worked for 39 years.

The couple have two children - daughter Beverley and son Howard - five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

The family joined Mr and Mrs Pearce for their diamond wedding anniversary celebrations, which included hiring a vintage Bedford coach and driv-



ing to Hayling Island for a picnic.

The couple are keen caravanners and often go on caravanning holidays.

Mr Pearce also regularly gives talks on his life as a Bevin Boy.

He said: "Marriage is about being tolerant and respecting each other. Like all couples, we have the occasional argument, but we never go to bed without making up."







I look forward to visiting you on Hayling and would love to see more of your tree then. Please let me know when you are there in September.


