



Do you have anything interesting on this SMITH family. Was this the same Smith family that ran the garages and buses etc in baughurst. Is there anything in people and Places or fact and fable or even Florence Davidson.



If I can briefly explain my reason for contacting the Tadley and District History Society.

I am now in my late sixties and live in Halifax near Leeds. I have been doing some research into my family background. Unfortunately my mother died when I was young and was not herself able to pass on any detailed information regarding my grandparents. Her own parents had in turn died when she was very young. She lost her father, my grandfather, it is believed, as a result of injuries received in the First World War.


I recently obtained my mother's birth certificate and learned that my grandfather's name was Daniel Smith, that he had married Mary Eliza A'Court and at the time of my mother's birth he was working at the GWR in Swindon and living on Suffolk Street which still exists today.


I asked the Steam Museum at Swindon if they held any records that I could research that might give any information about people working for the GWR in the period from 1904 to 1918. I was also trying to find if there was any record of men from Swindon who left service with the GWR to enlist for the war.

I realised that with the name Daniel Smith it might be difficult to find any accurate details. They were not able directly to help me but gave me invaluable information that has let me trace my grandfather's family to Tadley. My great grandfather was Solomon Smith, born 1842, and in 1881 was living at 28 Heath End in Tadley together with his wife, Sarah and his children Solomon, Clara, Martha, Ruth and Frank.

I am interested in buying any of your books that have photographic records of the period 1880 to 1920 and would also like to know if you have a venue where I might research through any records that you have that might yield any information regarding the Smith family

Historical Information: On 1 July 1916, supported by a French attack to the south, thirteen divisions of Commonwealth forces launched an offensive on a line from north of Gommecourt to Maricourt. Despite a preliminary bombardment lasting seven days, the German defences were barely touched and the attack met unexpectedly fierce resistance. Losses were catastrophic and with only minimal advances on the southern flank, the initial attack was a failure. In the following weeks, huge resources of manpower and equipment were deployed in an attempt to exploit the modest successes of the first day. However, the German Army resisted tenaciously and repeated attacks and counter attacks meant a major battle for every village, copse and farmhouse gained. At the end of September, Thiepval was finally captured. The village had been an original objective of 1 July. Attacks north and east continued throughout October and into November in increasingly difficult weather conditions. The Battle of the Somme finally ended on 18 November with the onset of winter. In the spring of 1917, the German forces fell back to their newly prepared defences, the Hindenburg Line, and there were no further significant engagements in the Somme sector until the Germans mounted their major offensive in March 1918. The Thiepval Memorial, the Memorial to the Missing of the Somme, bears the names of more than 72,000 officers and men of the United Kingdom and South African forces who died in the Somme sector before 20 March 1918 and have no known grave. Over 90% of those commemorated died between July and November 1916. The memorial also serves as an Anglo-French Battle Memorial in recognition of the joint nature of the 1916 offensive and a

small cemetery containing equal numbers of Commonwealth and French graves lies at the foot of the memorial. The memorial, designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens, was built between 1928 and 1932 and unveiled by the Prince of Wales, in the presence of the President of France, on 31 July 1932. The dead of other Commonwealth countries who died on the Somme and have no known graves are commemorated on national memorials elsewhere.


