Do you have anything interesting on this SMITH family. Was this the same Smith family that ran the garages and buses etc in baughurst. Is there anything in people and Places or fact and fable or even Florence Davidson.

If I can briefly explain my reason for contacting the Tadley and District History Society.

I am now in my late sixties and live in Halifax near Leeds. I have been doing some research into my family background. Unfortunately my mother died when I was young and was not herself able to pass on any detailed information regarding my grandparents. Her own parents had in turn died when she was very young. She lost her father, my grandfather, it is believed, as a result of injuries received in the First World War.

I recently obtained my mother's birth certificate and learned that my grandfather's name was Daniel Smith, that he had married Mary Eliza A'Court and at the time of my mother's birth he was working at the GWR in Swindon and living on Suffolk Street which still exists today.

I asked the Steam Museum at Swindon if they held any records that I could research that might give any information about people working for the GWR in the period from 1904 to 1918. I was also trying to find if there was any record of men from Swindon who left service with the GWR to enlist for the war.

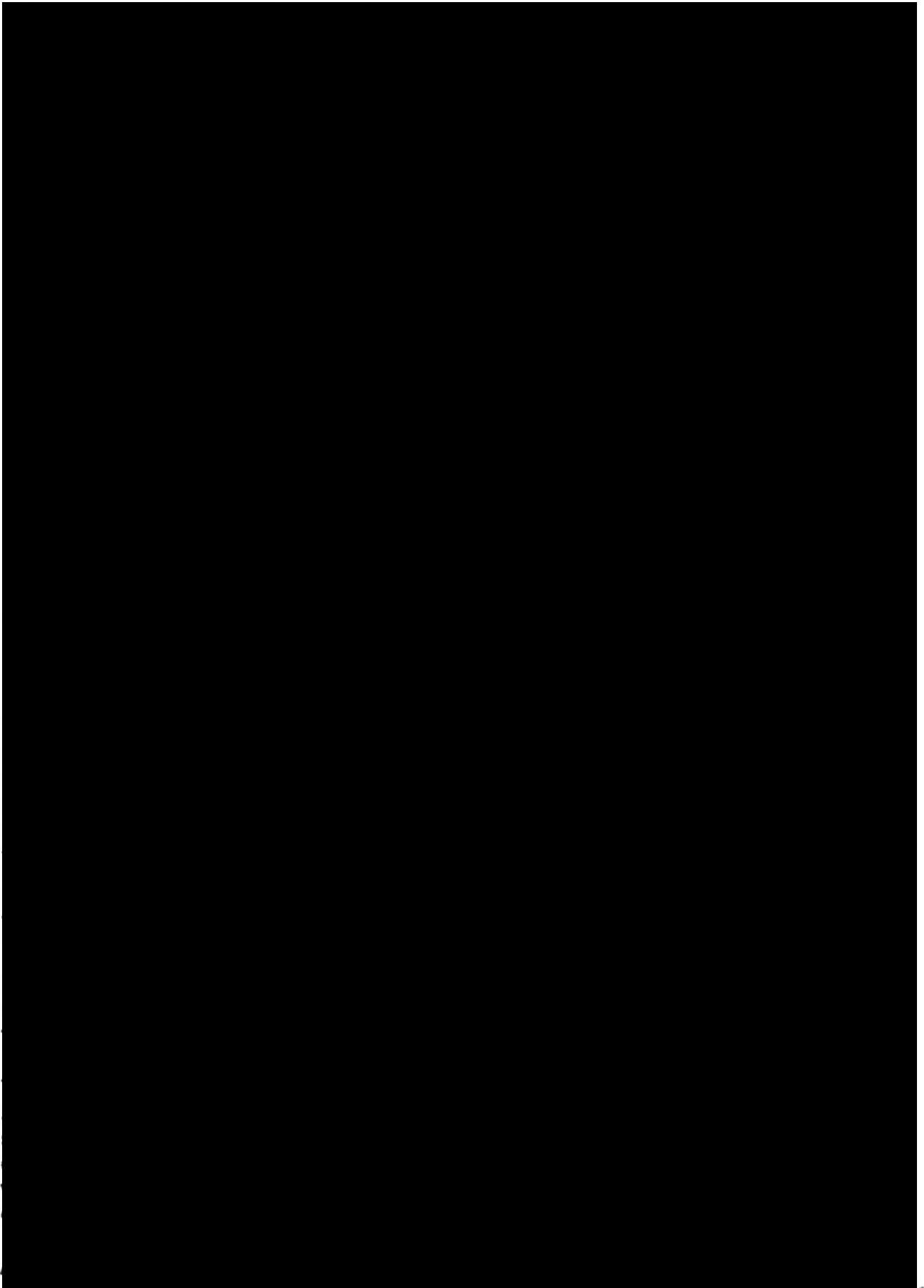
I realised that with the name Daniel Smith it might be difficult to find any accurate details. They were not able directly to help me but gave me invaluable information that has let me trace my grandfather's family to Tadley. My great grandfather was Solomon Smith, born 1842, and in 1881 was living at 28 Heath End in Tadley together with his wife, Sarah and his children Solomon, Clara, Martha, Ruth and Frank.

Location: The Thiepval Memorial will be found on the D73, off the main Bapaume to Albert road (D929). Each year a major ceremony is held at the memorial on 1 July.

Visiting Information: The Panel Numbers quoted at the end of each entry relate to the panels dedicated to the Regiment served with. In some instances where a casualty is recorded as attached to another Regiment, his name may alternatively appear within their Regimental Panels. Please refer to the on-site Memorial Register Introduction to determine the alternative panel numbers if you do not find the name within the quoted Panels.

Historical Information: On 1 July 1916, supported by a French attack to the south, thirteen divisions of Commonwealth forces launched an offensive on a line from north of Gommecourt to Maricourt. Despite a preliminary bombardment lasting seven days, the German defences were barely touched and the attack met unexpectedly fierce resistance. Losses were catastrophic and with only minimal advances on the southern flank, the initial attack was a failure. In the following weeks, huge resources of manpower and equipment were deployed in an attempt to exploit the modest successes of the first day. However, the German Army resisted tenaciously and repeated attacks and counter attacks meant a major battle for every village, copse and farmhouse gained. At the end of September, Thiepval was finally captured. The village had been an original objective of 1 July. Attacks north and east continued throughout October and into November in increasingly difficult weather conditions. The Battle of the Somme finally ended on 18 November with the onset of winter. In the spring of 1917, the German forces fell back to their newly prepared defences, the Hindenburg Line, and there were no further significant engagements in the Somme sector until the Germans mounted their major offensive in March 1918. The Thiepval Memorial, the Memorial to the Missing of the Somme, bears the names of more than 72,000 officers and men of the United Kingdom and South African forces who died in the Somme sector before 20 March 1918 and have no known grave. Over 90% of those commemorated died between July and November 1916. The memorial also serves as an Anglo-French Battle Memorial in recognition of the joint nature of the 1916 offensive and a

small cemetery containing equal numbers of Commonwealth and French graves lies at the foot of the memorial. The memorial, designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens, was built between 1928 and 1932 and unveiled by the Prince of Wales, in the presence of the President of France, on 31 July 1932. The dead of other Commonwealth countries who died on the Somme and have no known graves are commemorated on national memorials elsewhere.

End of the road for village dealership

A FAMILY-RUN car dealership has gone into voluntary liquidation after 66 years of business in Baughurst.

Paul Smith, 57, who owns Smith of Baughurst, filed for voluntary receivership and ceased trading on Friday, March 19. He described it as possibly the worst day of his life.

He said: "No-one saw it coming. This is so devastating for me. There is no emotion I haven't gone through - I really am heartbroken."

He told how having to tell his 15-strong loyal workforce - some of whom had worked for the firm for 50 years - that they no longer had a job was the most distressing thing he's ever done.

"Everyone wept," he said. "It was, quite possibly, the worst day of my life."

The father-of-two said a number of recent circumstances had led to the demise of the business, primarily growing competition in the area. He said: "We are completely surrounded by three big towns, Basingstoke, Reading and Southampton - all of which have major, modern dealerships."

Mr Smith said that there were other factors, but he refused to discuss them as he said he may be taking legal action in the future.

He said the business had been operating under a Ford dealership for the best part of 40 years.

Service manager Alan Ludlow had worked at Smith's for 21 years. He said: "I am very sad that this has happened. The day we were all told was horrendous for us all. The local village is losing a very personal service. We had an excellent pool of loyal customers."

Smith of Baughurst has been servicing the local community for 66 years. Back in 1938, Paul's grandfather, H. C. Smith, turned the family land into a small business that repaired bicycles. Paul's dad later joined the firm after gaining experience at Stradings, in Newbury, and history repeated itself when Mr Smith joined his father as an apprentice.

The garage has received a number of letters from local villagers and staff were touched by the support shown.
