Historical Information: In 1914, Baghdad was the headquarters of the Turkish Army in Mesopotamia. It was the ultimate objective of the Indian Expeditionary Force 'D' and the goal of the force besieged and captured at Kut in 1916. The city finally fell in March 1917, but the position was not fully consolidated until the end of April. Nevertheless, it had by that time become the Expeditionary Force's advanced base, with two stationary hospitals and three casualty clearing stations. The North Gate Cemetery was begun in April 1917 and has been greatly enlarged since the end of the First World War by graves brought in from other burial grounds in Baghdad and northern Iraq, and from battlefields and cemeteries in Anatolia where Commonwealth prisoners of war were buried by the Turks. At present, 4,142 Commonwealth casualties of the First World War are commemorated by name in the cemetery, many of them on special memorials. Unidentified burials from this period number 2,729. The cemetery also contains the grave of Lieutenant General Sir Stanley Maude, Commander-in-Chief of the Mesopotamian Expeditionary Force, who died at Baghdad in November 1917 and the memorial to the 13th Division which he commanded. A memorial to the 6th Battalion Loyal (North Lancashire) Regiment was brought into the cemetery from the banks of the Diyala River in 1947. During the Second World War, Baghdad was again an objective of Commonwealth forces. The 20th Indian Infantry Brigade reached the city from

Shaiba by the Euphrates route on 12 June 1941 and the 21st Indian Infantry Brigade, part of the 13th Duke of Connaught's Own Lancers, together with the 157th Field Regiment, Royal Artillery, arrived on 19 June via the Tigris. An advanced base was established later near the city and remained in use until 1946. Most of the 296 Commonwealth servicemen of the Second World War buried in the cemetery died of illness or by accident when serving with PAIFORCE. Again, a number of the graves were brought in from other burial grounds. Within the cemetery is the Baghdad (North Gate) (Khanagin) Memorial, commemorating 104 Commonwealth and 439 Polish servicemen of the Second World War buried in Khanagin War Cemetery which, owing to difficulty of access, could not be properly maintained. A memorial has also been erected at Khanagin. The North Gate Cemetery also contains 127 war graves of other nationalities from both wars, 100 of them Turkish, and 41 non-war graves.

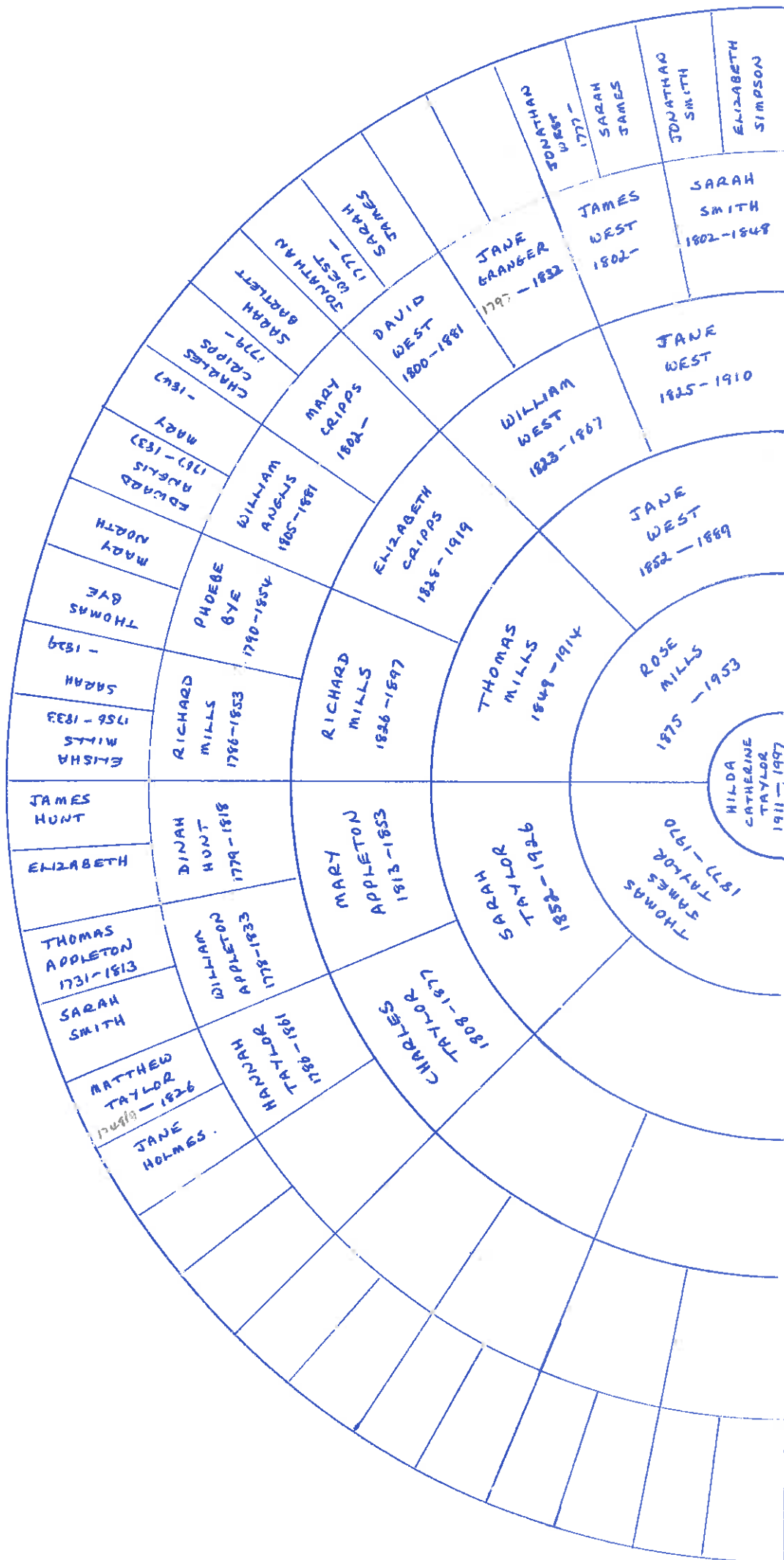

I have obtained your name from the Hampshire family history readers interests and see you are researching the TAYLOR name at Baughurst.



After their marriage, they moved to 34, Shirley Grove, Edmonton, London where their first child Edna Margaret was born at the North Middlesex hospital.

The 1939/45 war was threatening, so they moved back to live with Edward's parents at Wallingford. and eventually managed to get a Council house in Panters Rd, Cholsey where they lived until 1959 when they moved to 23, Tavistock Avenue, Didcot, and then to (Pinjaur), Reading Rd, Rowstock, and finally to Edwin Rd, Didcot.

Alice had Osteomyelitis in her leg as a child of about 7 yrs, and spent much of her school years in & out of hospital. She wore irons on her leg and spent some time in a wheelchair. She also had some more operations on her leg in her later years and still wore a shield on it until she died. She also suffered with Diabetes in her later years. But through all this she was always very cheerful and happy, and cared very deeply for all her family.

Alice worked at Westfield Nurseries from leaving school until her marriage, and was presented with a chiming clock from her workmates at the nurseries.

Alice and Edward saw their Golden Wedding in August 1989 and attended a party given by her daughter and grandchildren. DEATH AND FUNERAL OF MR. W. G. TAYLOR

Great Loss to Cholsey Brass Band

It is with deep regret that we record the death on August 7th at the age of 73, of Mr. William George Taylor, Station Road, Cholsey. Well-known in the district Mr. Taylor has always been associated with brass band music. Born in 1876 he played with the Baughurst Gospel Temperance Band at the age of 16 and when in 1894 he moved to Staines he joined the Staines Salvation Army Band and the Staines Wesleyan Band.

In 1903 Mr. Taylor married and returned to Baughurst where with other members of the band he trudged many miles in all weathers collecting for King's, "Absent-minded" Beggar's Fund for those in the South African War.

Coming to Cholsey in 1900, Mr. Taylor met Mr. Fred Baldwin and the two were instrumental in the reforming of Cholsey Brass Band. During the first world war he played regularly with the Wallingford Volunteer Training Corps Band under the conductorship of Mr. B. Gower. Mr. Taylor was also bandmaster of the Goring and Stratford British Legion Band.

Until 1914 when the band ceased to function owing to the war, Mr. Taylor was a regular member of the Cholsey Band and he never missed a practice. At one time 5 of his sons were members of the band.

Although he was not able to take part in the reforming of the band after the last war Mr. Taylor was always a keen follower of its progress and three sons and one grandson aged 11 are at present playing in the band for which he did so much.

His services to brass band music were recently acknowledged and he was made an honorary life member of the National Brass Band Club. He was too ill to attend the official presentation, but Mr. E. Griggs, the Club's area representative, attended at his bedside and gave Mr. Taylor his badge and a certificate commencing his 30 years service as a "bandman".

Mr. Taylor celebrated his golden wedding in 1948 and is survived by his wife and four sons and two daughters.

The funeral service, owing to church repairs, was held at the house and interment followed at St. Mary's Church. The service was conducted by the Rev. H. V. Saragun.

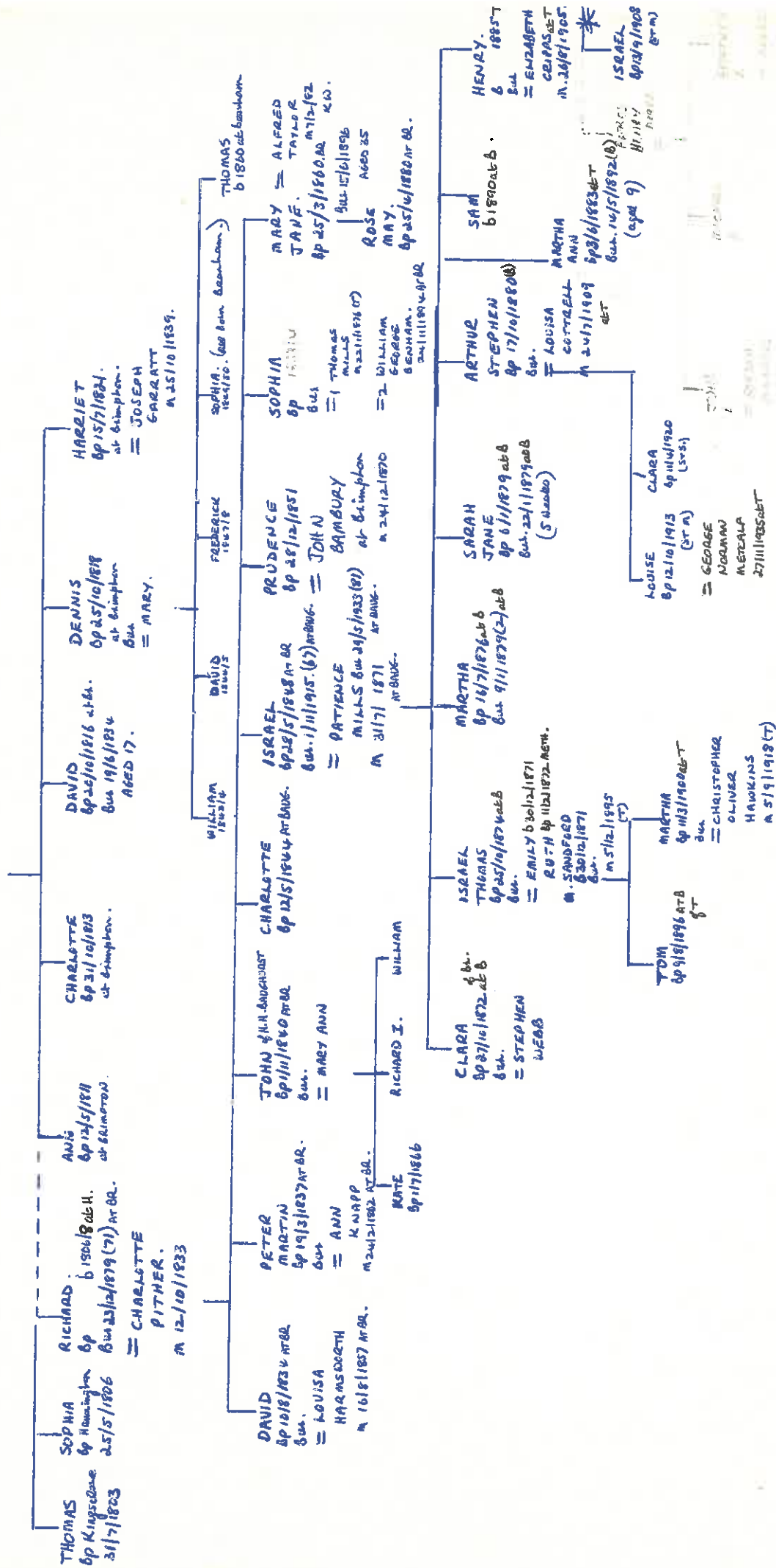
