I have a Sarah West baptised September 1818, birth August 1818, with father William, mother Sarah from the I.G.I. at the Independant church, Tadley . She has siblings Hannah July 1814, David August 1816, William November 1821 and Joshua December 1823. "My" Sarah dies in Tadley in September 1906 age 87, which fits, but I'd like to confirm those baptisms if possible. Or if you have access to Sarah's burial record which gives me any further clues.

Sarah has six children as a single mother - Charles 1842 (my husbands great grandfather), George 1844, Matilda 1846, William 1849, Thomas 1850 and Hannah 1852. I've found all the baptisms or births except for Charles! He says he was born in Tadley.

The 1851 census shows Sarah and her children living with George Englefield in Pamber. Her occupation is clearly stated "not wife"! Then for some reason George and Sarah marry in March 1856 - father of Sarah shown as William West. George and Sarah go on to have three children Mary 1856, Elizabeth 1857 and Sarah Ann 1860. I suspect that some of the other children may be George's, but why the sudden decision to marry??!

If you confirm any of the early information I have that would be wonderful - or anything else on the elder William and Sarah.

>Sarah, the wife of William West was born at either Langford or Hungerford, Berkshire

Do you have a marriage for William and Sarah anywhere? I would presume they got married in Berkshire - I could probably try and find out where. Perhaps she was a Tull before marriage?

>Burials are 1879 to 1980. There was an earlier Burial Register of which half of one page >remains and covers the years 1793 to 1798 and on the other side 1806 to 1813. This half page >was detailed, giving ages, abodes, dates of both death and burial, so a great pity the rest >seems to have disappeared.

Now that is sad, especially with all that detail it contains. However it is still amazing to me that any of them survived!

>Do you have marriages for your Sarahs children? There are three, which I will send if you >need them.

Do you mean Sarah born 1818?

I do have the details of Charles marriage to Mary Ann Dicker and know that George married Harriet ? and Thomas a Mary ?, but that's all. I only know the last two from what I think are the correct census details - they both moved away from the area. So if you can give me anymore that'd be great.

>Also have all the census details 1841 to 1901 and will be pleased to any that you would like.

I do have all the census details for Sarah and George Englefield from 1851- 1901.


>As a matter of interest, in the 1891 census for Pamber your Charles Englefield was living >next door to my Georges grandparents William and Jane Stanley, at Pamber End.

Now that one I would be extremely pleased to have the details on - I searched high and low for them in 1891! Is he shown as Charles Englefield, not West?! When I was looking I didn't know about the Englefield connection, so would probably have passed



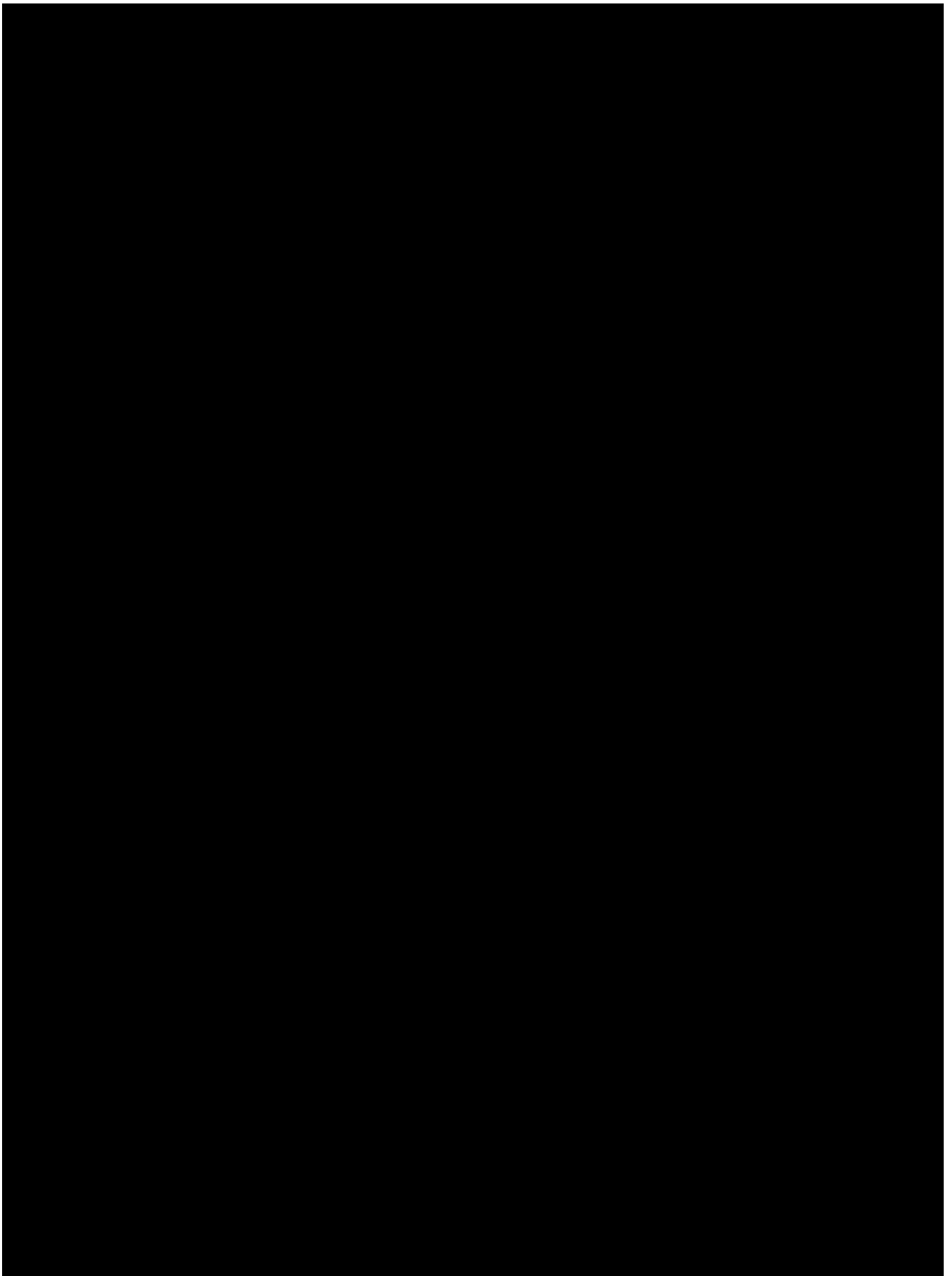

Any idea where Tadley Lane was? I was born in Tadley, but don't remember it so well anymore - we've been here 30 years. Also the Almshouses? Am I right in thinking Almhouse Lane is somewhere near where Reading Warehouses are?

>The relatives mentioned in the 1851 census, Thomas and Joseph Ball, living with George and >Sarah, were half brothers to George, the two youngest of five sons of his mother Mary and her >second husband Richard Ball.

## Results:

Checking under WEST, William, I found:

WEST, William - Rachel Borridge, 13 Aug. 1810, Exeter St. Sidwell.

I found no record of the baptism of an Elizabeth, daughter of this couple.

Next, I checked under BORRIDGE, Rachel, but the only entry was her marriage to William West. As Colyton christenings are indexed to 1837, I would have expected an entry to show up if she had been baptized in this parish.

The next step is to check the C.F.I. date against the original parish register:
