Albert was born at West Street, Tadley and lived all his life in the small cottage where his parents brought up their family of ten children. He had a twin sister Annie who died of consumption at the age of 22 and who was buried at St Peter's Church Tadley April 26<sup>th</sup> 1933.

Albert didn't marry and after the death of his parents, Job and Lily, lived at the family cottage with his older brother Alf, who died on Feb. 26<sup>th</sup> 1996, after which Albert continued to live at home in the daytime but slept at the home of his niece Doris Rawlings or his nephew Tom Perry.

Albert lived a simple life and had a strong religious faith, often quoting passages from the Bible which he had great knowledge of. He was an admirer of the Royal family and would travel to Ascot each summer for the Royal meeting but not to study the horses, but to see the Royal family. He would journey to any place locally where Royalty would be. He also admired Margaret Thatcher and was photographed with her.

Hop picking was part of Albert's life and he was taken to the hop gardens when only a few weeks old and continued to go there until he was about 80 years old, never missing a single year. For several years, at the time of the second world war Albert was a Tadley Postman, but broom making was his occupation apart from this. He would cut the birch in the winter months and make the brooms during the summer. He would obtain some of the birch from Wasing Woods by arrangement with Sir William Mount and enjoyed the peace and quiet found there, riding his moped, and after giving this up in his mid eighties due to a change in the licencing laws, his small cycle, from West Street to Wasing. Unfortunately, after being approached by youths who demanded money from him when he was

alone in Wasing Woods he could no longer go there alone, thus having to give up something which he so enjoyed.

At the age of 90 Albert still cultivates his quite large garden, growing his own vegetables, which he sometimes cooks outdoors on an open fire.

He is small of stature, but at 90 years old has the looks and energy of someone much younger.

His knowledge of Tadley and Tadley people is second to none and his memory is fantastic. He never misses a funeral, some of which he describes as 'lovely', as he has a great Faith in God.

When dressed in his 'best' he looks very smart and he wears a number of gold rings when going anywhere important.

all in all a very remarkable man. A Tadley man and a man of Tadley - knowing all the local people and known of them. A true 'Tad'.

# BLOOMIN' MEDALS

HEATH END GARDENERS DO THEMSELVES PROUD

## A Brush with the Past

Heath End Gardening Club has been in existence for only four years, yet at the Chelsea Flower show this year they were awarded a Silver Medal for their courtyard garden! This is a first-hand account of how it was achieved.

When the RHS invited us to send in a design we were delighted. When they accepted Carole's design we were even more so. Carole had based her idea on the Tadley poem with broom-maker Albert West's tiny cottage providing the backdrop. (Albert is now 91 years old and still cycles to collect wood for a few brooms.) Carole wanted it to look as if Albert had left his tools and gone in for tea and she heard a member of the public say exactly that as she stood looking over the fence at our display so she must have got it just right!

The committee drew up lists of plants and other items needed and members agreed to provide what they could. As the date of the show approached, the plants were collected together. During the show, Carole and her husband got up at 4.00am each day to drive to the show. Four members also went to work, handing out leaflets containing plant lists with medicinal uses and a brief history of broom making.

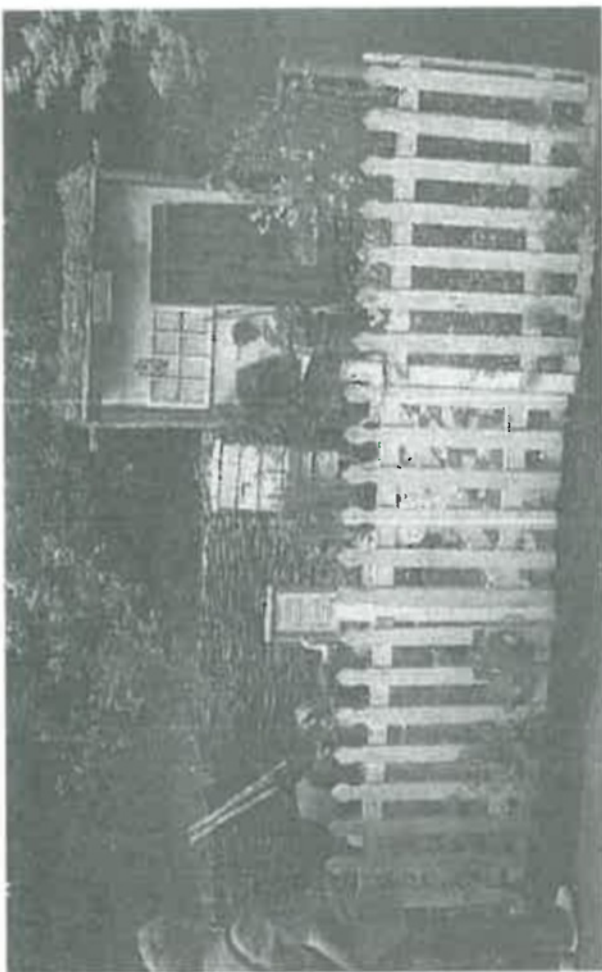
The six-day run-up to the show went like this:

Tues: On arrival, the ground was cleared of breeze blocks and levelled.

Wed: The main construction day of the cottage front, erection of posts and picket fence. It poured all day long! Michael and Malcolm (known as Bob the Builders) worked in terrible conditions.

Thurs: The raised beds were laid, the apple trees planted; also sweet peas and geraniums.

Fri: The brick path was begun but it sank due to water-



logging. They restarted laying down boards and scaffolding beneath the bricks. Sat: The remaining flowers, the vegetable patch and herb garden were planted - with great difficulty as the holes kept filling with water!

Sun: Lettuces were planted and the garden tweaked and trimmed to perfection. The camera crews visited all week, also many celebrities including Charlie and Alan.

And then Monday: Press Day! Judgement Day! And the Royal Visit! Members of the royal family are each given different routes and Prince Edward's covered the courtyard gardens. He was most interested in ours.

Tues: The results were put out at 6.00am and there on the path was the Silver Medal award, greeted of course with absolute delight. This was RHS Members' Day.

Wed/Thurs: Open to the general public who all showed great interest in our garden.

Fri: Time for sales and clearing up. At 4.30pm Charlie rang the bell to allow plant selling to begin. Although our plants were of the cottage garden varieties, such as violets, forget-me-nots and aquilegia, the public queued to buy, even wanting the buckets, tools and lamps - but these had to be returned to their rightful owners. The vans were unable to enter the showground until 10.00pm due to sheer volume of traffic so clearing up was done in the dark illuminated only by the vans' headlights. The team eventually arrived home, totally exhausted but very, very happy. As Carole said: "It was a dream come true."

Look out for us next year - we'll be there!

# It's time to impose tougher sentences

Sir—I write regarding the article in last week's Tadley Gazette about the theft suffered by one of Tadley's oldest born-and-bred residents, Albert West, of West Street.

Albert is well-respected in the local community. I have never heard a bad word ever spoken about him and I understand he has never spoken a bad word, either.

Until we make the punishment fit the crime, we will continue to experience this kind of crime. The police often say they have their hands tied over paperwork and that they have to treat thieves with kid gloves in case they get it wrong.

The courts then have to keep within guidelines because if any of the proceedings – from arrest to sentence – are not conducted correctly, the “crook” could then appeal and, no doubt, end up getting thousands of pounds worth of taxpayers' money in compensation.

If the householder had come home and found that his house was being broken into, and then took the law into his/her own hands – which I don't recommend, by the way – it could well be the householder who ends up in court, as many of us will have seen in national papers.

In the meantime, Mr West has lost not only monetary possessions but also items he has had all, or a good part of, his life.

I hope the thieves have a jolly rotten

Christmas and I can't think of words that are printable to wish them in the New Year.

## A BRAWL AT TADLEY.

William Rawlings and Noah Rawlings, both of Tadley, were summoned by Alfred West, also of Tadley, for assault on the 25th December. They pleaded not guilty.

Complainant stated that he was walking down the road towards his home at Mulford's Hill on the 25th December at 10.15 p.m., when William Rawlings (who was walking with his wife) crossed the road and struck him a heavy blow in the head on the left side of his mouth. It took him quite unawares. He had no idea why he did this. The blow knocked witness down. Witness's brother picked him up, and whilst he was supporting him Noah (the other defendant), who was a couple of yards down the road, walked back, pulled his jacket off, and struck witness a heavy blow on the right side of his mouth, never saying a word. Afterwards Noah wanted witness to shake hands, but he refused, and said he should summon them. Noah used further threats towards him. In answer to questions, complainant said he could not remember being on the Common in May last. He did not chase Rawlings on the 18th May, as suggested. He remembered coming out of the New Inn on the 21st December with a man named Hawkins but did not see defendants outside; they were inside the public-house when he left.

Albert West, of Tadley, brother of complainant, corroborated, as did also two other witnesses—William George West (cousin), of West Street, Tadley, and George Horn, of New Road, Tadley.

The defendant William Rawlings, giving evidence on oath, said he lived at Mulford's Hill, Tadley. On the 17th May he was in his father's garden and heard a gang coming along. He recognised the voice of Alfred West. A stone was thrown, which went through a window, the glass falling on his brother's bed. He did not know who threw the stone. On the following night Alfred West came up with a gang of 16 or 17 and offered to fight. Witness started to fetch the police, but the gang overtook him before he could get to P.O. Oliver's house, so he went into another house and phoned for the police. The gang were still waiting when P.O. Oliver came. On the 21st December he was outside the New Inn with his brother, when Alfred West came out and said, "Who's afraid of them?" Witness and his brother said nothing, and walked on home. On Christmas night they were all coming down the road about 10.15 going towards home. Witness was walking with his wife. His brother Noah with his wife and another brother were also present. Witness went up to Alfred West and asked him if he was in the same mind as he was when he had his gang with him. West answered "Yes." Witness's brother Noah came back and said he would fight a second one, and took his coat off. He didn't hit anyone.

Noah Rawlings, the other defendant, said he was in bed on the 17th May, when a stone came through the window and fell on his bed. He agreed with what happened on Christmas night, except that he struck no blow and did not offer to fight.

P.O. Oliver said that on the 18th May, in consequence of a telephone message, he saw a group, which included Alfred West, wanting to fight Rawlings, and heard that the trouble was about a stone that had broken a window. Rawlings was also supposed to have taken some cabbage from a garden. The Rawlings family went away fruit-picking and hop-picking next day, as was usual during the summer.

Mrs. William Rawlings and George Rawlings gave corroborative evidence.

The magistrates decided to fine William Rawlings £1 as the chief aggressor, and Noah 5/-. The Chairman said the defendants had not behaved in the manner that would be expected of them. The neighbourhood must not be disturbed by these unseemly brawls. The magistrates hoped all concerned would go back and live together in peace and quietness.

# Everything's rosy for the first rosette business on the Internet

A SMALL business tucked away in a former post office sorting office in Sherborne St John has been attracting a lot of interest lately.

For the rosette-making concern of Frank West and his wife Anne has been the subject of a local TV news item as well as a feature in Country Life magazine.

West Rosettes are known world-wide too with orders received for an agricultural show in South Africa and a cat show in Holland.

They are the first rosette manufacturers to be accessed on the Internet through which the Wests have just received an inquiry for 1,500 rosettes for a budgerigar show.

Not bad for a couple who started making rosettes 13 years ago in a spare bedroom at their rented house in Sherborne St John.

At the beginning orders were mainly for equestrian events but they now produce rosettes, sashes, greeting cards and anything gold-blocked for just about any event or occasion—with the help of out-workers who live in the village.

Frank said: "We do everything from pleating the ribbon to printing the tails and circles.

"I can't put a number on how many we make a year but it must be thousands and thousands.

"I know we use roughly 120,000 metres of ribbon a year."

From The PO Workshop in Dark Lane, they have made rosettes for football clubs, dog, cat, horticultural and agricultural shows and for diverse events such as for sand-camel racing and a beetle drive in the local village hall.

Frank, born at Pamber End, was a manager for a stationery and printing company in Yorkshire before returning to Hampshire.

In a varied career he has owned a fish and chip shop, run a dairy and operated a haulage business.

Until three years ago the Wests also ran the post office at Sherborne St John but sold it after Anne became ill. They now live in Bramley.

Frank said "This time of year is our quiet time and we usually go on holiday.

"We are well established now but we are always looking for more work, especially equestrian work in the area.

And as a reflection of West Rosettes highly commended reputation he added: "Practically all our orders are from recommendation."
