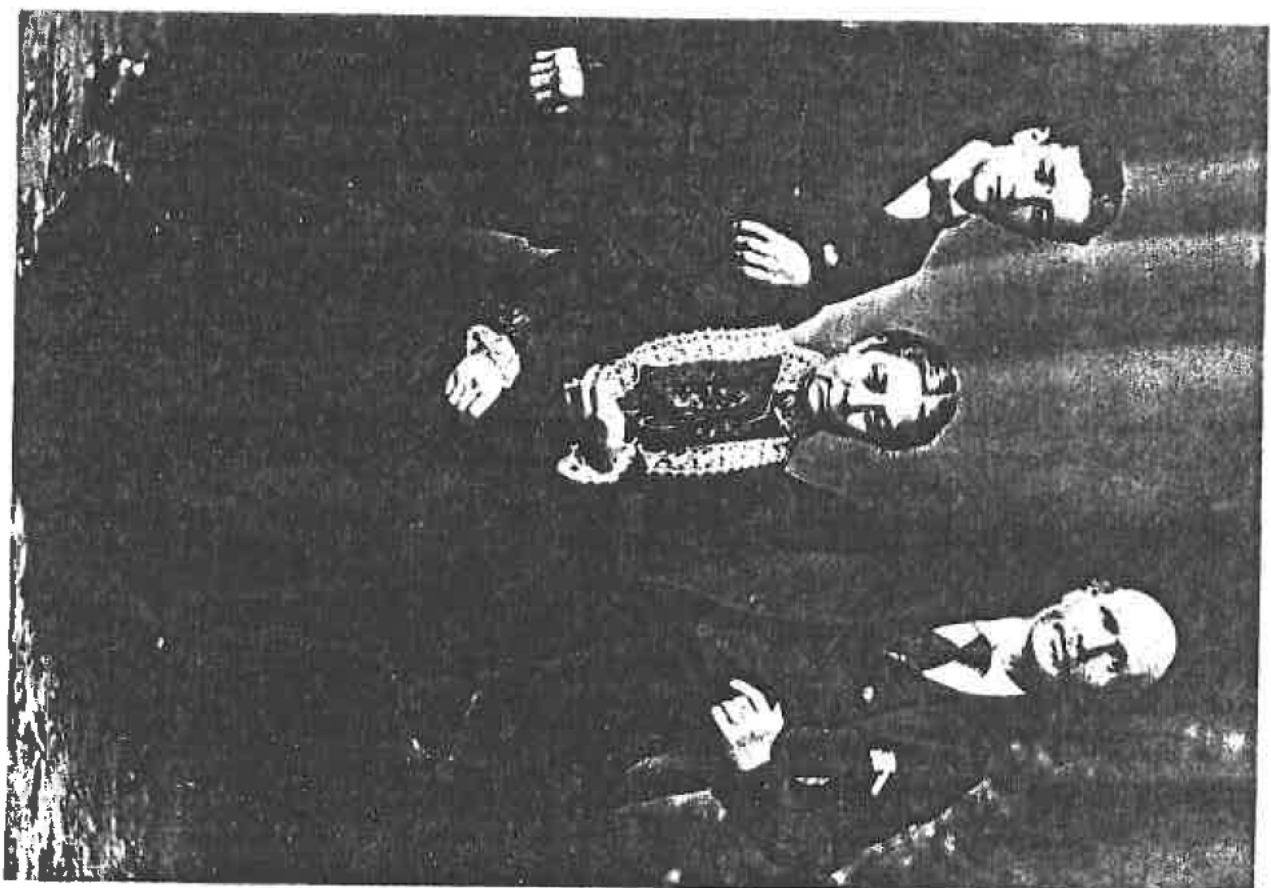

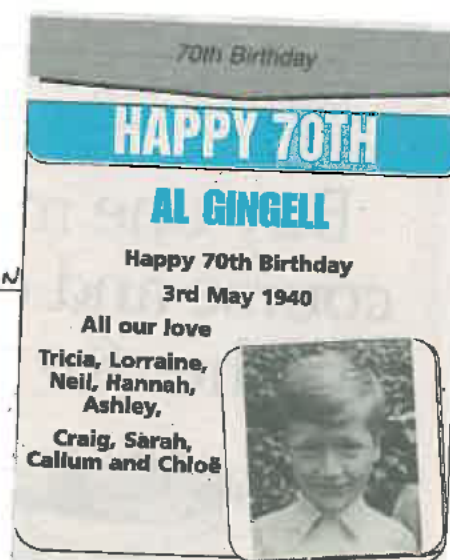

BIBLE BITS

August 2002 Amen

With the removal van just around the corner (we hope!), having visited one of our favourite local spots for the last time - the footpath along the Thames from Pangbourne with the added attraction of a pot of tea at Mapledurham lock - and being well into our farewells, the temptation of what to choose as the subject for 'Bible Bits' this month proved overwhelming.

Fulfilling what I believe was God's will has, inevitably, meant treading on a few toes and upsetting a few folk. However, to read the Gospels is to become aware that Jesus himself wasn't immune from this and without doubt this has been at some cost to Marian and myself. One of my guiding principles for many years came about as a result of reading the memoirs of an Army surgeon stationed on the remote North West Frontier long before the days of easy transport, who, faced with an agonising dilemma concerning the treatment of incurable cancer in the wife of a friend and colleague, wrote "to do what one honestly believes to be right at the time is to leave no room for regrets". Following closely in the footsteps of Jesus, Paul often felt impelled to state some seemingly harsh, yet honestly held truths as he encouraged people to move on in their Christian faith. Frequently however, he chose to finish his letter with an 'amen', which, from Old Testament usage e.g. Numbers 5:22 and Deuteronomy 27:15 can have the meaning 'so be it'. This is almost as if Paul is saying "like it or lump it folks, that is where I honestly stand".

Although 1 Corinthians 14:16 is an exception, Paul virtually always chooses to use 'amen' in conjunction with some other statement. The letter to the Romans would probably have been controversial amongst many Christians of Jewish background, but after ending it with a declaration of God's glory, he adds the 'amen', which clearly has the meaning of affirming what has gone before with its meaning of 'truly'.

The same is implied when, after writing words which are as familiar to us as the Grace, he adds an 'amen' e.g. 1 Corinthians 16:24.

They would seem to be appropriate words for Marian and I to use as we take our leave of you:

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you.
Our love to you all in Christ Jesus. Amen.

Now, where *is* that removal van?

You will remember my mother Iris Monger and her son Gerald, born at Ivy Cottage, Heath End in 1931; you will also know that we both became Goddards a little later!! We lived for a while in the cottage opposite the Pond and Cartsheds at Heath End. I believe you lived quite close by because the name of Iris Appleton was quite familiar to my young ears.

All that was long ago, but so much of my youth sticks in the mind in spite of the fact that I disappeared from the local scene in 1947 when I went to the RAF Apprentice school near Aylesbury. After that only once did I actually live in Hampshire, (or indeed in England) and that was during the first years of my first marriage in 1959, at Kings Somborne near Romsey. The rest of my time was spent in Wales, long periods in various parts of what we used to call the Empire, and finally the Channel Islands. It was in Guernsey that I married Wendy in 1987. since when we have lived in south west France and here in Corsica since 1996. So one could safely say that I'm a Hampshire exile, though I have never forgotten how lucky I was to be born there and to enjoy such a privileged childhood.

It was as a direct result of a recent visit to Tadley that I became so interested in my family trees. The catalyst was, of course, my cousin Beryl and this has resulted in a much more frequent contact with her than hitherto; this is as it should be, for she is my favourite person within our large family (this secret is safe with you, I'm sure!). 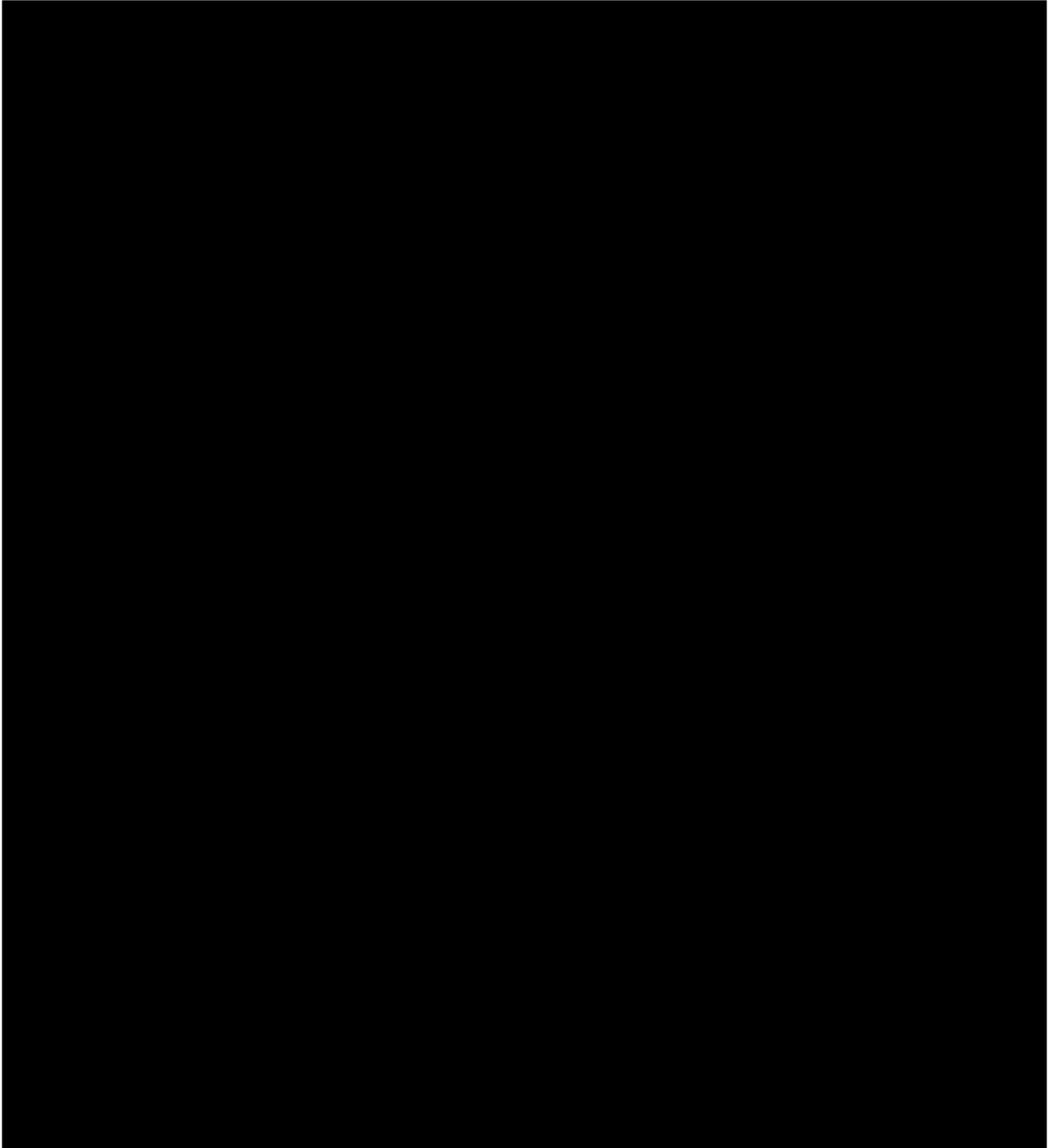

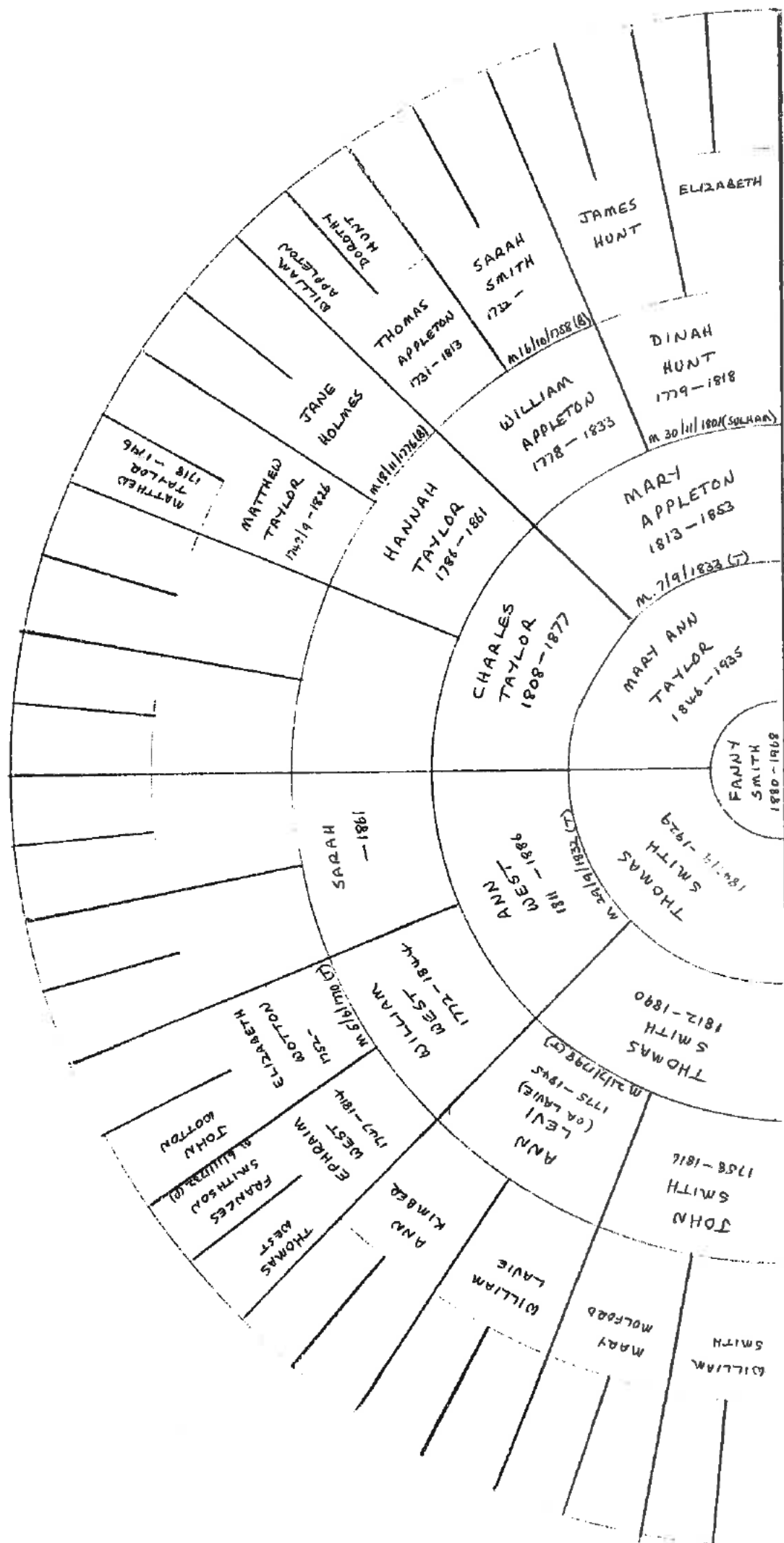

Around the circuit

ALTHOUGH this series is entitled *People in the Pulpit*, it is also about those people within a church who is not ordained, who are lay preachers or who contribute significantly to the life of the church.

As circuit administrator, Richard is responsible for a large amount of organisation and, in addition, is also the preachers' secretary.

Richard was born in Winchester in October 1951, but has spent all his life in Old Basing. He went to the village school before going to the Charles Chute Secondary Modern School, now known as the Vyne School.

Doctor is targeted in air rifle assault

A PHYSICIST has called for a shake-up in the law covering airguns after a drive-by shooting put him in hospital.

Dr Lionel Goodfellow, who works at the AWE weapons base, had to undergo surgery under general anaesthetic after he was shot in the front garden of his home in Ramptons Meadow, Tadley, on Saturday.

Dr Goodfellow said: "I had been working on my garden that afternoon, and my wife and I were just packing up when I heard a bang and felt a sharp pain in my left thigh.

"I looked down and saw a hole in my jeans, and blood everywhere. I saw a white van pulling away."

The police were called, and 55-year-old Dr Goodfellow went to Basingstoke hospital for X-rays.

The bullet had lodged in his thigh muscle, and an operation under general anaesthetic was carried out to remove it on Sunday before he was finally allowed home on Monday afternoon.

"They had to widen the hole in my thigh to get the bullet out," said Dr Goodfellow. "It's still painful, and it's hard for me to sit comfortably without putting pressure on my injured leg."

A move to criminalise the ownership of airguns has recently been proposed in a Private Member's Bill by Jonathan Shaw, Labour MP for Chatham, and it's a move that Dr Goodfellow supports.

"I would have supported tighter restrictions on this type of gun even before I was shot," he said.

"It is all very well using one for target practice at a gun club, but we simply cannot have people wandering around the streets shooting people."
