Lorna plans to put herself to the test

LUCKY Lorna Haines was thrilled to win a high-powered sports bike in a competition – despite not having a licence to ride it.

Miss Haines, 25, won the brand-new Suzuki GSX-R600, worth more than £6,500, at round one of the British Superbike Championships at Brands Hatch, Kent, earlier this month.

The keen biker went along to the event with her boyfriend Julian Raisey, 37 – also a fan who owns two bikes – and entered a competition to estimate how many £1 coins were inside a large jar. She correctly guessed there were 947.

She said: "The tickets were £5 each and I bought two because I really wanted to win.

"We left early to miss the crowds and when I got home there was a message on the answer-

phone saying I had won. I went mad for about half-an-hour."

Miss Haines, who is licensed to drive a car but not a motorbike, has been a fan since she was a child and has followed the British Superbike rounds for four years.

She also travels to watch the World Superbike Championship at the Holland meeting as well.

"Now I've got the bike I'm definitely going to get a licence," she said. "I was going to get one anyway but it's a huge incentive now."

"I have been a fan of bikes since I was younger and remember going to watch my dad on his bike. He got some little off-road bikes for my sister and me and we'd follow him around. I love the thrill of them."

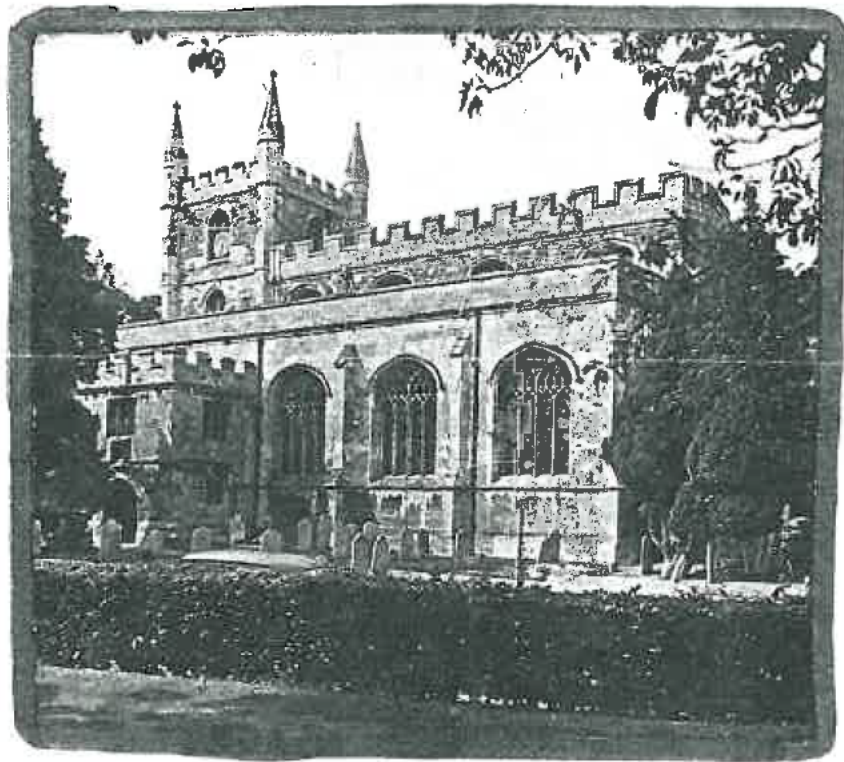

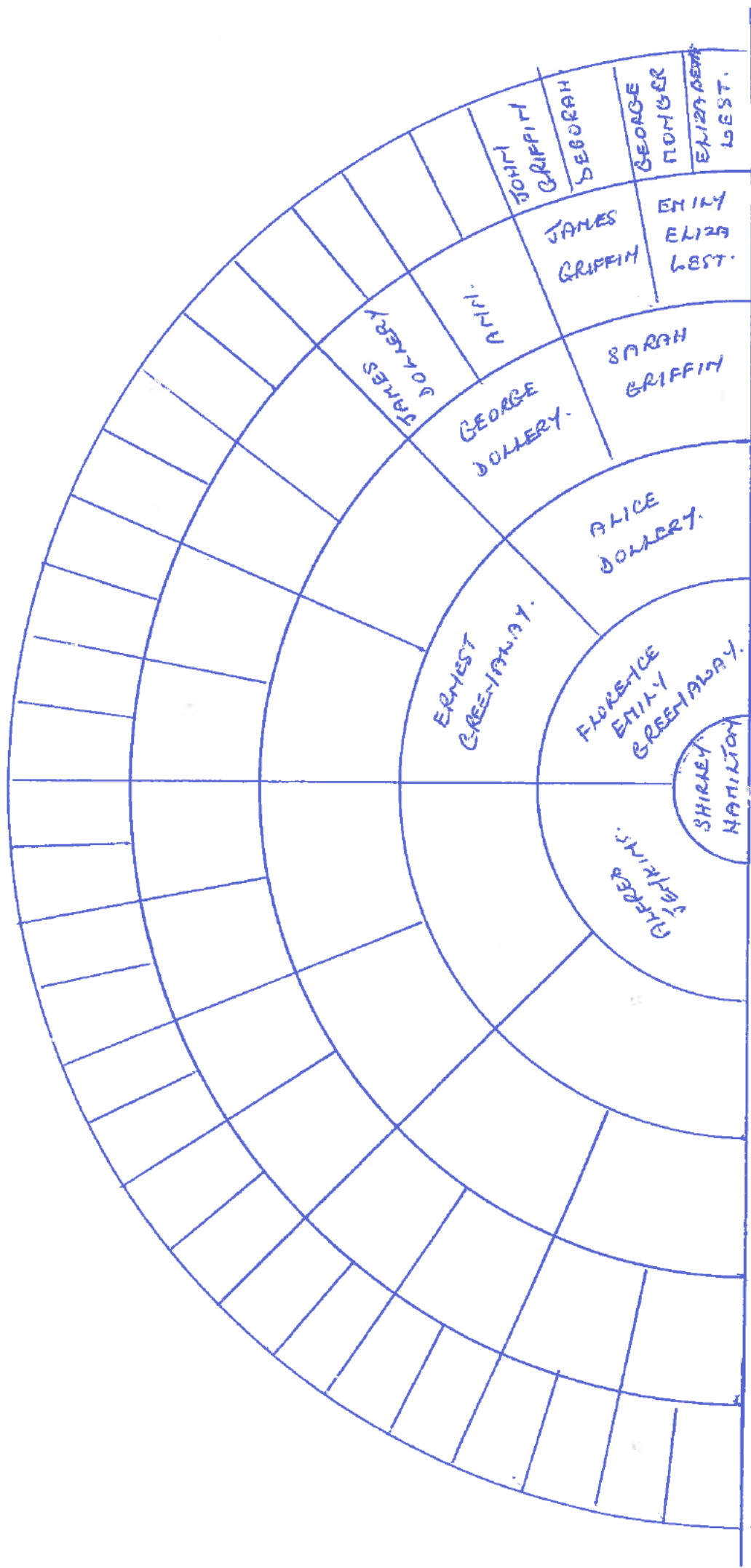

Stubbington. Hammond's Bridge is named after Col. Hammond, who arrested Charles I at Place House, Titch- field, and conveyed him across the Selent to the Isle of Wight to imprisonment in Carisbrooke Castle.

Steventon. The birthplace of Jane Austen, the novelist, 1775, second daughter of the Rev. George Austen, Rector of Deane and Steventon. No part of the old Rectory is left, except the pump that was in the yard. The terrace belonging to the garden may still be seen. The Glebe Barn was used by the Austens for theatricals, and up to 1930 was still in use for concerts and entertainments.

Stratton. History here centres round the figure of Lady Rachel Russell, who inherited the estate on the death of her father, the fourth and last Earl of Southampton. She was married in 1667 to Lord William Russell, son of the Duke of Bedford. Her husband was accused of a share in the Rye House Plot, tried in 1683 and condemned to death. Lady Rachel, with great courage, acted as her husband's secretary during his trial. An avenue in the park is still known as Lady Rachel's walk. She lived to be 86, and was known as "the sweet saint"—and as a woman "with a will of her own, and a rich fund of common sense."

Tadley. Hawley House was given by its owner, Sir Joseph Hawley, to Jockey Wells. The portrait of Wells on the Derby winner, Blue Gown, hung in the dining room.

About 1870 most of the cottages in Tadley were owned by gipsies, led by the Hicks, under Reuben Hicks; this is one of the very few cases where gipsies have given up their normal course of life and become owners of property on any considerable scale.

The Tadley Roll is a remarkable relic, consisting of a roll of paper about 3 in. high, containing caricatures of every man, woman and child who was in Tadley during the years 1872-1876. There are about 600 figures, though a few of the smaller ones are lost. The drawing is primitive, but full of life, and portraits are recognisable. It shows all the old village crafts and trades: a party of Royal Engineers who carried out an Ordnance Survey, poachers, gipsies, and the various families, Webbs, Saunders, Giles, Hicks, Harap- tons, etc.

Tadley Place is believed to have been one of King John's hunting lodges. The present house was built by the Ludlow family in the 15th century, on the site of a much earlier building.

Tichborne. The Tichborne Dole is already mentioned in Chapter II. It had its origin in the story of Lady Mabella Tichborne, who lived about 1360. The legend also states that Lady Mabella laid a curse on the place, that the house should be destroyed by fire, and that the family should lack an heir. The celebrated Tichborne Trial in 1879 proved that the "Claimant," who posed as the rightful heir, was an imposter named Arthur Orton.

South Tidworth was purely an agricultural district, previous to the purchase of the estate by the War Department. The first Squire, of whom anything is recorded, was Assheton Smith. His property elsewhere included slate mines in Cornwall, and evidence of this can be seen in the slate slabs used for fencing in various parts of the village.

It was in his day that the country people tried to break up the machines, increasingly being used, fearing the draw-back to manual labour. The monument on the hill, known as "The Tower," was erected and equipped with a barrel of tar at the top, to be kindled if information of the approach of a mob was received. Mr. Assheton Smith also ferried a squadron of yeomanry, not unlike the Hussars of to-day, fitting them out at his own expense. They were received on one occasion by the Iron Duke, who remarked that in case of war they were fit to take the field at any time. This same Squire planted Assheton Copse, now known as Ash-down Copse.

Tinsbury. In 1086 it is recorded that "the Abbot of Winchester holds Tinsbury and always held it and there is a mill worth 12/6" (a year). Small as this sum seems, it was higher than for any mill in Romney. Many years ago the ruins of a mill were standing, but now nothing is left. A reservoir and dam seem to have been made for the purpose of driving the mill, and providing lake for the Abbey of Winchester. Tinsbury Bridge used to be called Stan-brugge--Stonebridge.

Another hamlet bordering Tinsbury is Gadebrugge, formerly Gade Brugge, where there has been an old corn mill from Saxon times. The present building is brick.

Mourners say farewell to 'a real pillar of the community'

FAMILY and friends packed St Paul's Church to say farewell to one of Tadley's most well-known figures.

Peter Hampton, known to many as the boss of the town's biggest taxi firm, Tadley Taxis, died on May 19, aged 65, after losing his battle against cancer.

Peter, a keen gardener, lived with his wife, June, in Raynards Close.

Together they ran the Silchester Road-based taxi company for over 20 years, which is now in the hands of his two sons, Gavin and Vaughan.

Peter was best known for his care for people, particularly the elderly, and his willingness to provide a service, always putting the business second.

One of his drivers said: "Pete was a real pillar in the community - a true gentleman.

"He ran a very fair and business-like taxi company and was ever so considerate towards people.

"Christmas Day was the only day he wouldn't work but if he knew of any customers who couldn't get around he would pick them up and take them for free.

"He was also known to pick up elderly people going to the airport and would talk through everything with them first to make sure they had everything such as passport and tickets.

"He also used to carry in their shopping and make them a cup of tea."


Peter's youngest son, Gavin, said: "Everyone referred to him as a true traditional country gentleman.

"He had a very old-fashioned and suave way about him and a wicked sense of humour. He always enjoyed a good laugh and was happiest with a cup of tea and a cigarette.

"He loved to meet people and will be greatly missed by so many."

The funeral service took place at St Paul's Church, The Green, on June 1. It was followed by a burial service at St Peter's Church in Church Road, Tadley.

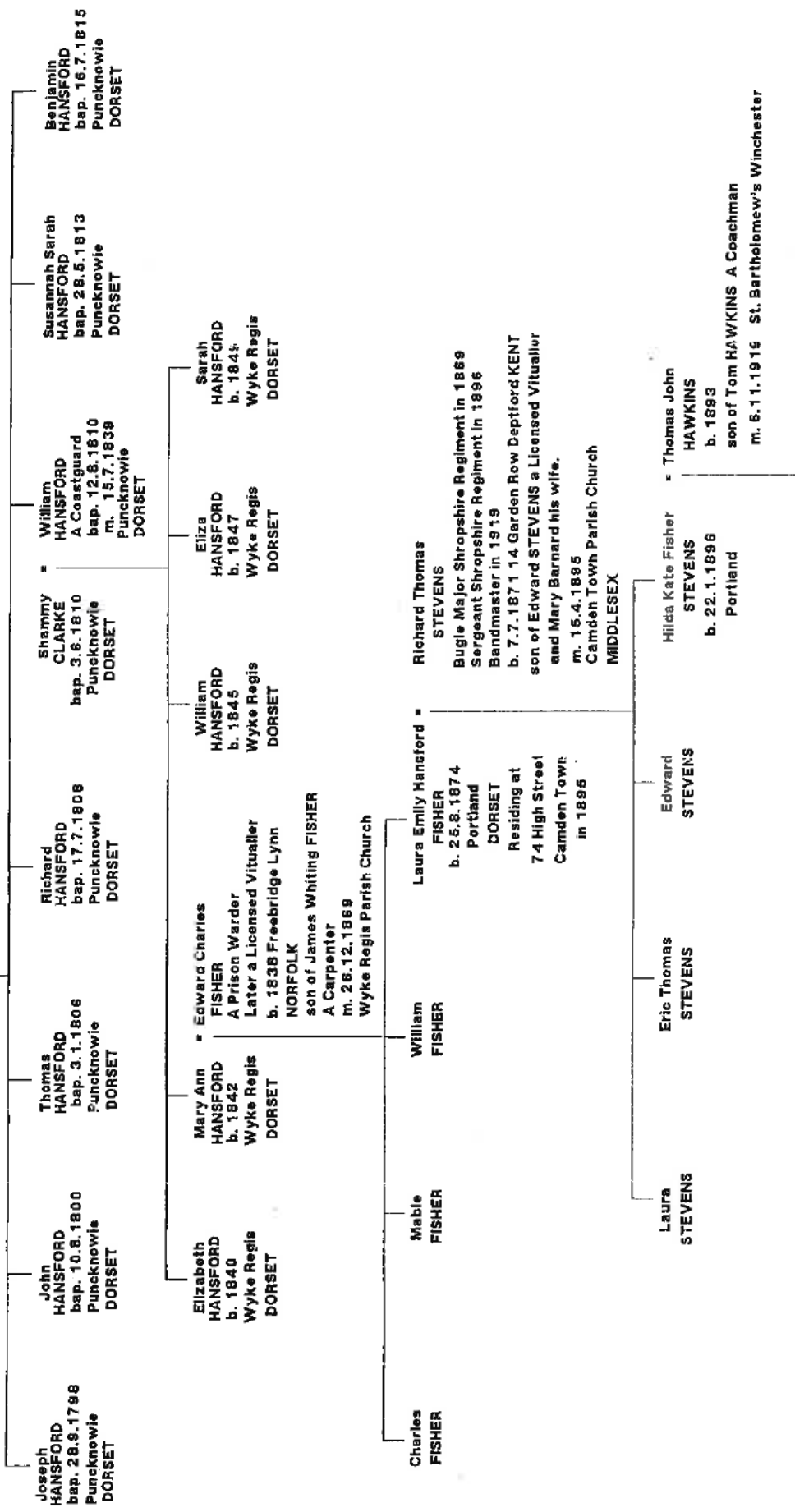

In the course of family history research I wrote to Mrs. Diana Pether of Surrey B.C., asking whether she could give me any information about my husband's family, the Harmsworths. Mrs. Pether could not provide the answers to my questions, but was kind enough to refer me to you.

I am trying to find out more about George Harmsworth, born 25 March 1868, place unknown but possibly Basingstoke, and his wife, Frances Beatrice Tubb, born 2 July 1871, Chapel St., Basingstoke. They were married 25 May 1892, at the Primitive Methodist Chapel, Hazfield Rd., Basingstoke. George Harmsworth's father was Benjamin Harmsworth, and Frances Tubb's parents were Charles Tubb and his wife Ann, nee Clayton.

I should be most grateful for any help, and will gladly reimburse you for any expense if you will kindly advise.

Dear Mrs. Stanley,

Thank you for your reply to my letter asking for information about Benjamin Harnsworth. I had also written to Hampshire Record Office and received a reply about ten days ago. Mrs. East, Archives Assistant, has sent me a good deal of information and I am enclosing a photo-copy of her letter in case it is of interest to anyone else.

I did check the 1871 census for Basingstoke and found Benjamin and Amelia living there with their daughters, Fanny 17, Harriet 12, and sons, James 5, and George 3. It is this George who was my husband's grandfather. I am now curious to learn more about Benjamin's parents, James and Charlotte, and his grandparents, William Eversly and Jane Harnsworth. A Jane Harnsworth married Joseph Munday at Winklade in October 1804, and a William Eversly married Sarah Winkworth 13 October 1811 at Alverstoke, but I have yet to link them with James Eversly or Harnsworth, although I have sent to Salt Lake City for a micro-film copy of the relevant Winklade parish register which may shed some light.

I was sorry to learn that Diana is so seriously

ill. I have only written to her this year, just to enquire about Harnsworths, and then to thank her for her reply. She must be a thoughtful and courageous lady to write to a stranger when she is having such a wretched time. I was touched by her selflessness when she mentioned the cancer, and hope and pray with the rest of her friends for her recovery. Perhaps if you have occasion to write to me you would let me know how things are going for her?

I am enclosing a S.A.E. in case you find anything, but if not, please feel free to use it for other correspondence.

Thank you so much for your offer to look around at Winchester. If you care to send me your family interests I will gladly send you anything I encounter. It's so encouraging to receive a friendly response to an enquiry, and I do appreciate yours. Thanks again!

A James and Charlotte Harmsworth had two sons baptised at Winslade in 1826 and 1828: James baptised 29 Oct 1826; George baptised 22 August 1828. There were no more children of James and Charlotte baptised with this surname until 1841:

Rose daughter of James and Charlotte Eversley alias Harmsworth baptised 28 March 1841

Sarah daughter of James and Charlotte Harmsworth baptised 15 September 1844

William son of James and Charlotte Harmsworth baptised 24 January 1847.

There was no baptism entry for Benjamin Harmsworth, but my attention was attracted to the baptism entry of Rose; on rechecking the baptism registers I noted there were several baptism entries for the children of James and Charlotte Eversley for the intervening years:-

Benjamin baptised 19 December 1830

Frances baptised 13 October 1833

Dinah baptised 17 January 1836

Matilda Lucy baptised 24 June 1838

A Matilda Lucy Harmsworth witnessed the marriage of Amelia and Benjamin. I also located other Harmsworth marriages witnessed by Benjamin: 12 February 1853 at Winslade Frances Harmsworth aged 20 spinster daughter of James Harmsworth, married John Porter of Basingstoke. The marriage was witnessed by Benjamin Harmsworth and Matilda Lucy Harmsworth

Also on the 23 September 1854 Matilda Lucy Harmsworth aged 17, daughter of James Harmsworth married Henry Porter of Tunworth at Winslade. The marriage was witnessed by Benjamin Harmsworth and Dinah Harmsworth.

Therefore, the evidence seems to indicate that Benjamin Harmsworth and Benjamin Eversley are the same person, but why would his father change his surname for about 10 years? James Harmsworth married Charlotte Butcher by Banns at Winslade 10 September 1825. The marriage was witnessed by Thomas Harmsworth and Elizabeth Harmsworth. This still did not give any clues as to why he used the surname Eversley. I then quickly checked the earlier baptism register for Winslade, where I located the entry for James son of William Eversley and Jane Harmsworth baptised 15 April 1804. Why James used his father's surname and then reverted to using his mother's surname is not given, but further research on your behalf may be able to ascertain this.

We can provide print-outs of the entries I have listed above and I am enclosing order forms for your use. It is not necessary to pay in advance as we will invoice you for the amount owing on completion. Please note that we can only accept payment in STERLING.

We have traced our direct lineage back as far as John HARMSWORTH Born in 1737 in England – not sure where his birth was.

He married an Elizabeth GILES (I think this may be MILES instead of Giles - not sure).

They had a child (one that I know of) John HARMSWORTH born abt 1771 in Baughurst, Hampshire, England (d:1855 Wolverton Common, Kingsclere Woodlands, Hampshire, England).

Who married on the 2 Oct 1799 in Tadley, a Mary APPLETON (b: abt 1789 in Kingsclere, Hampshire, England; d: Feb 1812 in Tadley, Hampshire, England).

Not sure how many children they had, but one was yet another John HARMSWORTH (b:1800 Tadley; d: 23 Jun 1835 Tadley) -married on 28 Feb 1829 to a Mary BENHAM (b:15 Feb 1807 Tadley; d: Jul 1848 Tadley) and they had three children Leah, Henry (in direct lineage) and Rachel. DEATH OF MRS. HARMSWORTH.—By the death of Mrs. Elizabeth Harmsworth, widow of the late Mr. John Harmsworth, which occurred on the 16th inst. Wolverton Common has lost its oldest and a well-known inhabitant. She had been in failing health for some time past. She was a member of the Baptist Tabernacle, Batfurst, and had attended there practically all her long life of 85 years. Born at Ham Lane, Baughurst, she had lived without a break all her life in the district, ending the last 60 years in her own house at Wolverton Common. Those who knew her will remember her as one whose disposition was kind and bright and ever ready to live at peace with all and everyone. For upwards of 40 years she had made daily visits to Wolverton Park to fulfil duties for which she was employed by Mr. W. J. Walker and the late Miss Walker. Nurse Beevors (Wolverton nurse) gave kind and sympathetic attention, for which the family are much indebted. The interment took place last Friday at 2.30 p.m. at Wolverton Parish Church. There were also present a large number of parishioners and friends and many members from the Baptist Tabernacle to show respect to one who has lived amongst them for so long. Cooper and family; Mr. and Mrs. Wilfred Cooper; Amy; Mrs. G. MUM Sarah Hartshorn's day out at the beach turned into a life-changing experience when she realised she had scooped £2.3million on the Lotto.

The Tadley resident was left stunned when she checked her numbers while on a family day out on Sunday and realised she had matched all six from Saturday night's draw.

Despite having a few days to get over the shock, Mrs Hartshorn,

who works as a Gazette News-papers agent organising delivery of the Monday and Friday Gazettes in the Tadley area, still cannot believe her luck.

"It still hasn't sunk in," she said. "I feel like I've won a tenner, but I just can't sleep at night."

Mrs Hartshorn's win - thanks to the numbers 3, 5, 10, 25, 43 and 47 - was revealed at a press conference at The Old Mill in Aldermaston yesterday morning where she and members of her family were the centre of media attention.

Mr and Mrs Hartshorn, who have an 11-month-old son Liam, they are going to spend their fortune.

Top of the list is a second home near the sea, followed by a luxury yacht, a holiday to the Maldives and a BMW convertible.

The couple are also planning to start new business ventures with the Lotto win.

Mrs Hartshorn, 30, said she has always dreamed of running a bridalwear shop. The money will also help Mr Hartshorn, who works with his father at the firm The Book Company and wants to set up his own joinery business. The couple also plan to give Liam the best start in life.

Mrs Hartshorn added: "For Liam, it is going to mean a nice life, but we don't want to spoil him."

"I have always dreamt that when I have children, I might take them to Lapland and places like that - but it has always been a dream. Now we will be able to enjoy dreams like that as a family."

Mrs Hartshorn, who bought the winning ticket in the post office at Sherfield-on-Loddon, near Basingstoke, has played the Lotto with the same numbers every week since it started 10 years ago.

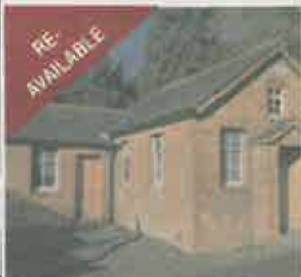

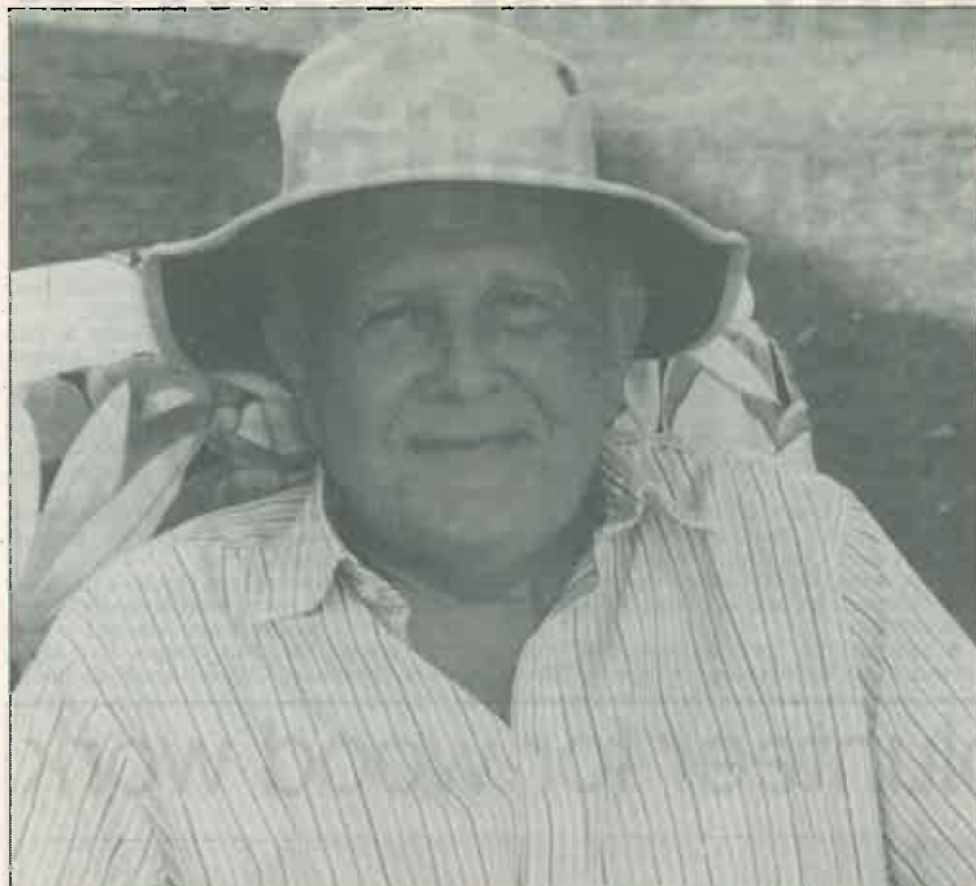
Trevor Wiltshire, the community centre manager, said: "Ken left an executive committee meeting at the community centre last Thursday and got in his car.

Tribute to 'kind' doctor

THE wife of a doctor who served the community of Tadley for more than 30 years has paid tribute to her "gentle and kindly" husband.

Dr Michael Hawken, from Wheathold House, Ashford Hill, died earlier this month. He worked in Tadley from 1960 until his retirement in 1993, and for much of his career was a partner in the Holmwood Health Centre in Franklin Avenue.

"Work came first for him, but he also had a lot of hobbies," said his widow, Elizabeth Hawken. "He enjoyed playing Real Tennis, sailing, wood-turning and bee keeping."

One of her fondest memories of her husband's career was the time, in the 1960s, that he was called to an accident during a hunt.

"A lady had been injured and someone gave him a horse so he could head off to help," said Mrs Hawken. "He had never been on a horse before, but did it nonetheless, and eventually brought the injured person out using a fence as a stretcher."

Dr Hawken was also a devoted father to their three children - Caroline, who lives in the US, Archie, who is a surgeon working in Plymouth, and Edwina. Dr Hawken was overjoyed at the birth of his first grandson, Thomas, in March 2001.

Mrs Hawken said she has received many warm letters from her husband's former patients, paying tribute to him.

A former colleague and long-time friend also spoke of Dr Hawken's dedication to the Tadley community. Dr Keith Hudson trained alongside Dr Hawken at St Mary's Hospital in London. They went on to work together for many years at Holmwood Health Centre.

He said: "He was a very dear friend, and an excellent doctor who was very kind and conscientious. We worked happily together for a very long time."

Dr Hawken's funeral was held at Douai Abbey, near Reading.

Dr Hawken was very kind to my mother when he called to visit her, instead of Dr. Motland. He was also very kind to me on the one occasion that I consulted him in the absence of Dr Speight.
