

## Police officers wed

FOURTH generation Hayling Islander, Miranda Cleeve, daughter of Mr and Mrs Richard Cleeve from Rook Farm, and Guernseyman Richard Mallett from Chertsey, were married at St. Mary's Church on September 7 in a ceremony conducted by the Rev. George Royle when the lesson was read by the bridegroom's brother, Mark, who was best man.

Miranda was given away by her father, Dick Cleeve of Rook Farm. She wore a pale ivory dress with a dark ivory lace train and carried a bouquet of gold and cream roses and freesias.

Her sister, Mrs Penelope Smith, her cousin Charlotte Winterton, and her friend's daughter Sarah McGrath, were bridesmaids and wore jade green dresses with ivory bows, and carried cream and yellow flowers. Ushers were Mark Hall, Brian Smith and Michael Povey.

A reception for 132 guests was held at the bride's parents' home. Guests included several friends and relations of the bridegroom from Guernsey, where he was born. The honeymoon was spent in St. Kitts in the Caribbean.

Miranda served in the Army for four years, followed by two years as a security officer, and has now been a Police Officer with the Surrey Police, stationed at Camberley, for five years, where she met her husband Richard, who is also a serving Police Officer with the same Force.

The Cleeve family are well known on Hayling. Miranda's great-grandfather Henry, came to the island with his family in 1917, and after the First World War, bought farmland at Higworth, Manor Road. Later, holiday tents were pitched on part of the land, and the Cleeve ladies set up a small "farm shop" selling the produce from the fields. Later, the

# Hayling woman drowns despite brave rescue effort

A HAYLING woman drowned in the sea last month, despite courageous rescue attempts by the emergency services and members of the public.

Police are still investigating the death of Mrs Valerie Smith, of Manor Road, Hayling Island, who was seen walking fully clothed into the surf late on the evening of Saturday, February 9 - a stormy night, with gale force winds and powerful waves.

Her reasons for walking into the water remain a mystery.

PC Mick Breary said that Mrs Smith had been seen that evening, first at Hayling Royal British Legion and later at the Lifeboat pub on Hayling seafront.

He said: "She was seen leaving the Lifeboat Inn by a group of men who became concerned for her welfare and followed her

"They saw her walk across the beach and straight into the sea. They called out but she did not respond."

Some of the men waded into the water in an attempt to save Mrs Smith but they could not reach her because the sea was too rough.

Meanwhile, the emergency services had been alerted.

At sea, lifeboats from Hayling and Portsmouth raced to the scene, backed up in the air by the Coastguard helicopter and a police spotter plane.

On land, two volunteer First Responders were among the first to arrive, followed by police officers (with night vision binoculars), coastguards, a doctor and an ambulance.

The Lifeboat Inn responded to the emergency by reopening its doors to shelter some of the would-be rescuers, who were soaked and chilled after wading into the sea.

At 12.27am on the

Sunday morning (February 10), the crew aboard the B Class Atlantic 75 lifeboat from Hayling spotted Mrs Smith's body in the sea, only about 100 metres from the point where she had plunged into the water.

On board the lifeboat were senior helmsman Bob Briggs, helmsman Graham Raines and crewman John Robertson.

The casualty was pulled into the lifeboat and then winched into the helicopter.

She was airlifted to Haslar RN Hospital at Gosport but was found to be dead on arrival.

This came as no surprise to the lifeboat crew, who were well aware that there was little chance of survival in such cold and stormy conditions. Records show that at midnight on February 9, the air temperature off Hayling was 9.5C and the water temperature was just under 8C.

Despite the sad ending,

many people were impressed by the skill and bravery of everyone involved in this co-ordinated rescue mission.

Nigel Roper, Hayling Lifeboat Operations Manager, said: "The weather conditions were at the outer limits of the lifeboat's capability, so it really was a test of skill for all concerned. To actually locate someone in those conditions was a remarkable achievement."

"The crew showed tremendous courage and determination."

First Responders Shirley and Peter Hart felt moved to write to the Hayling Islander about the incident and their letter is published in full on page 15. They said: "We were the first voluntary emergency service at the scene and we were very impressed at the speed, variety and response of the emergency teams that attended the incident."

"The local police arriving so quickly with their night vision binoculars,

the rapid response paramedics and ambulance, the community basics doctor, the coastguards and the RNLI, the police spotter plane and coastguard helicopter (India Juliet) and lots of other people, all doing their best to locate the lady."

"We were most impressed by the skill and bravery of the RNLI and the pilot of the helicopter, who both managed to control their craft to allow the winchman to perform his duties in the appalling conditions - a force nine gale, with a 44 knot wind."

An inquest was opened on February 12 and was adjourned. An adjournment date has not yet been announced.

## EMRHYS HARRIS

**CORPORAL EMRHYS HARRIS** was in the South Wales Borderers, the regiment which inspired the famous film "Zulu". Less than 100 men defended themselves against 4,000 Zulu warriors. The Zulu chiefs broke off the attack out of respect for the tenacious Welshmen, 11 of whom were awarded the Victoria Cross. Mr Harris moved to Tadley in 1949, and is now retired after a career as an officer for the Amalgamated Engineering Union.

"WE LANDED on Gold Beach in the second wave, up to our necks in water. Even the cigarettes in my tin hat were soaked.

We were supposed to have met up with the Americans, but did not see the Yanks until Thursday because they had been held down on Utah Beach.

### **Monks hid German officers**

The commanding officer instructed me to take two men on patrol in Bayeux. We were fired on by snipers but not wounded. We advanced the next day and captured a chateau in which there were some religious monks. They assured us there were no "Bosche" there, but there were, and we captured 11 German officers who were being hidden by the monks.

After four weeks

under fire, our company was pulled back for a change of clothes and a bath, we had not been able to take our boots or clothes off for four weeks. I suggested to two of my platoon to find something to drink. They brought back two bottles of Cognac and two buckets of Calvados. This was on a Tuesday, we went to sleep and woke up on Thursday.

### **Shrapnel wound**

On Friday night 1,000 British bombers bombed Caen and we advanced in the morning, but unfortunately a stick bomb was thrown at us and I caught shrapnel in my right leg. I was brought back to England and the shrapnel was removed in hospital."

Cpl. Harris recovered from his wound and was sent back to the front. He found himself in the



thick of battle at Arnhem.

"My platoon was ordered to a forward position on the Arnhem Railway Line. I posted my sentries and as I passed the door of a barn, I heard a noise. I went in but could only see a white rabbit and assumed that this was what caused the noise.

I went through the barn door and as I did so I was fired on by a machine gunner who fixed his Schmeisser and caught me with a bullet in the left knee.

The end of my story is that the bullet was removed from my knee at Odstock Hospital in Salisbury, 13 years later."

## War nightmare led to veteran's death

A TADLEY pensioner died just days after falling out of bed while he was having a nightmare about the war, an inquest heard.

James Hedges, 80, of Wigmore Road, had regular dreams about torpedoes which would make him shake, his son Ian told the Basingstoke inquest.

He fell out of bed after one of the nightmares in May this year,

hitting his head.

Three days later, the pensioner was admitted to hospital where he died on May 27 from a blood clot on the brain and heart disease.

Coroner Andrew Bradley, recording a verdict of accidental death, said it was likely that the fall was a "contributory factor" to Mr Hedges' death.

# Fifty years a local preacher

THERE were two unusual things about Newbury Methodism's harvest festival celebrations last weekend.

The second unusual thing happened during the evening service. Mr Norman Herbert, of Rectory

Close, Newbury, has completed 50 years as a Methodist local preacher. A letter of congratulation from the Methodist division of ministries was read to the congregation by Mr Hawkes and presented to Mr Herbert.

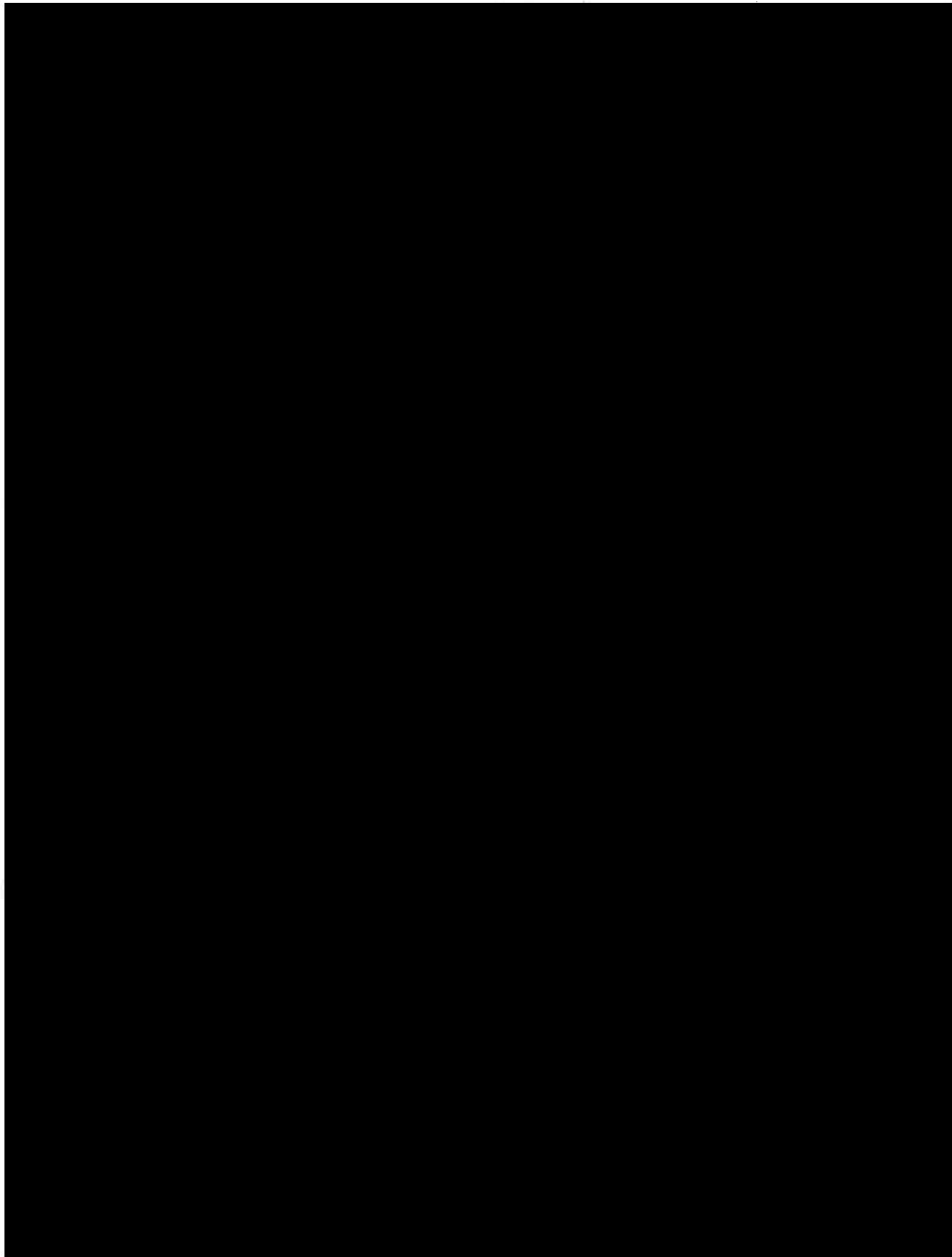

# Rich widow's grand gesture

A WIDOW thought to be penniless has left more than £500,000 to charity in her million pound will.

Ada Hicks, 93, of Blakes Lane, Tadley, died on April 1 this year with her estate valued at almost £1.3 million.

She split the bulk of her estate four equal ways between the League of Friends of Basingstoke Hospital, St Peter's Church, Tadley, the Cripps family and her nephew Ronald Chapman.

The Rev Martin Nockels, of St Peter's, said: "We are delighted to have been left something like this. It will mean in future there will be income for such things as repairs." The medieval building in Church Lane,

Mrs Hicks is buried in the churchyard alongside late husband Reuben.

In her will she asks for the money to the hospital's League of Friends to be used to alleviate suffering for patients with cancer or heart disease.

Nobody from the League was available for comment yesterday.

Other bequests include a collection of toby jugs and brasses to the Willis Museum at Basingstoke, £20,000 to Mrs Hicks's niece Olive Hammond, and £1,000 each to Albert West and Peter Saunders.

Neighbours who knew Mrs Hicks said they were surprised by the size of the will.

Queenie Stacey, of Blakes Lane, said: "If you saw her you would not

think she had sixpence.

"But you could not wish for a better neighbour, she was always pleased to see you.

"I don't recall her going to church at all but the rector used to visit her and her husband. I'm glad that she left some money for charity."

Mrs Stacey's husband Ted, added: "Ada and Reuben were life-long Reading Football Club supporters - they used to cycle to the matches."

Ann Middleton, also of Blakes Lane, said: "She was a wonderful lady, very private but with a terrific character, sense of humour and very lively. She worked hard for her money and it is nice she left something to the charities."

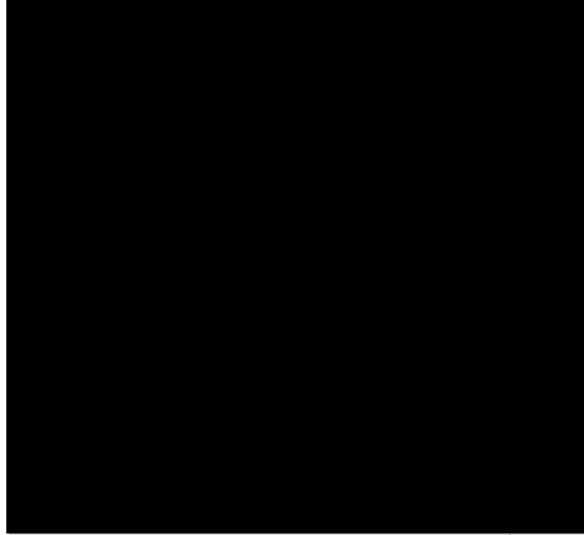

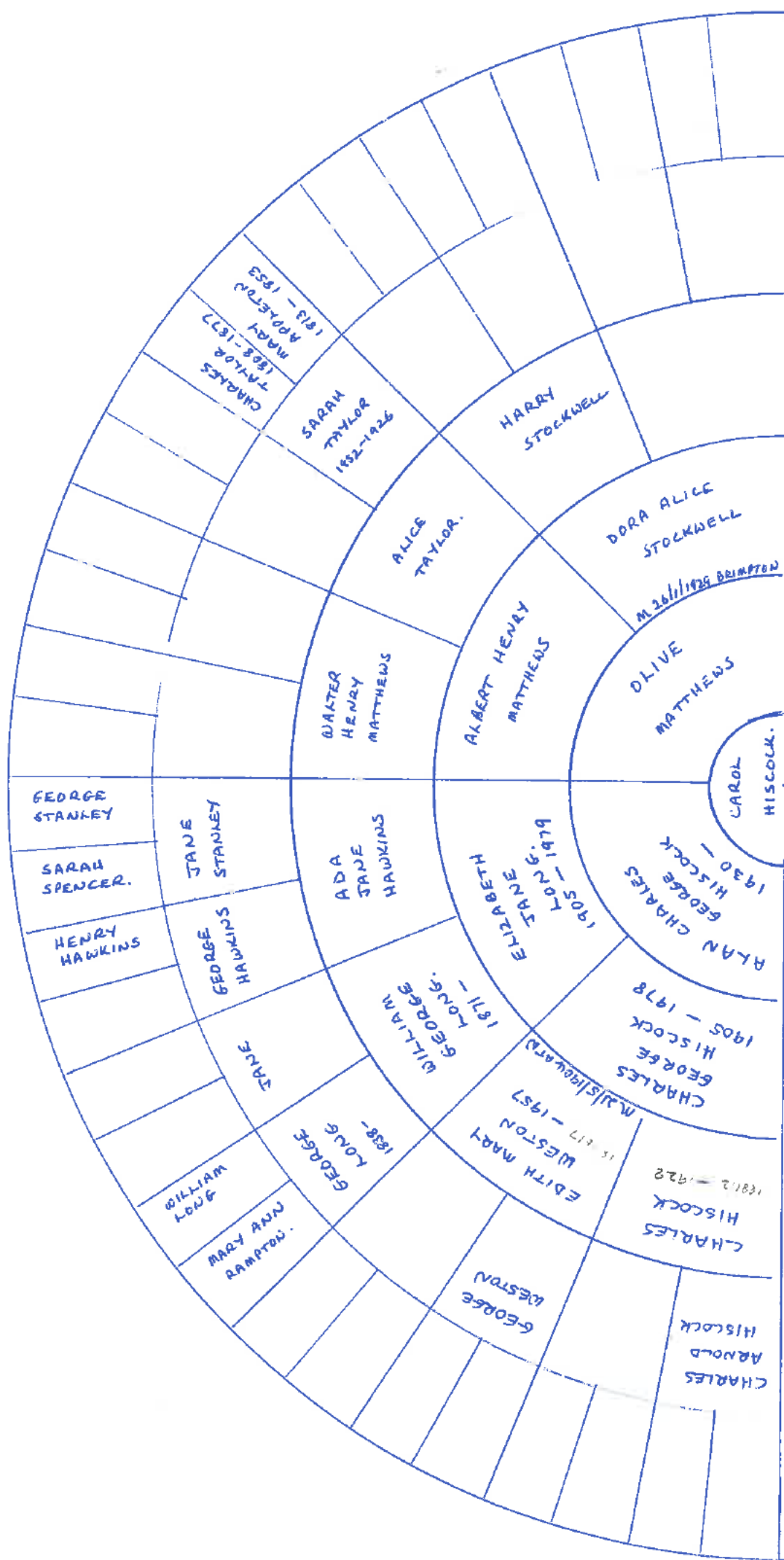
