Thank you for your letter concerning your ancestors at Kingsclere; I have made some investigations among the records we have here, and the results are as follows.

The Wolverton Estate (which was quite extensive, taking in several parishes), was purchased by the Duke of Wellington's Trustees from Sir Peter Pole in 1832 (it was sold in 1943); at that time there appears to be no mention of the Hawkins family in the rentals, and Plantation Farm was leased to William Bunce. The first reference in the ledgers is to John Hawkins, who took over the tenancy of Ewhurst Farm, Ewhurst at Michaelmas (29 September) 1837 at a rent of £440p.a. (it was one of the largest farms on the estate, with 433 acres); I cannot be certain that this was your great-great-grandfather, as I cannot identify Roadside, Baughurst, but it seems fairly likely to have been him, or a close relation. He held this farm until Michaelmas 1845, when he moved to Tadley Farm nearby (a much smaller holding of 74 acres, at an annual rent of £50). He left Tadley in 1853, when his name disappears from the ledgers.

Henry John Hawkins took over Plantation Farm from Charles Hesleden at Lady Day (25 March) 1849, at a rent of £306p.a.; he held it until Michaelmas 1857, when it was leased to William Spackman. He is mentioned in a report made by the Estate Agent to the Duke of Wellington

in 1851, with a recommendation for a reduction in rent, as follows :

"This is a respectable young man managing the farm with spirit and although he has it for a term of 14 years I recommend your Grace to make the allowance." (MS 1641/1466/3)

This shows that his lease was originally for 14 years, so he obviously left the farm before his full term expired. (He is listed in this report and in the rental ledgers under the various names of H.J., W.J. and William Hawkins, but I assume that this is a mistake and that H.J. is always meant).

X I have noticed several references to both John and Henry John Hawkins in the Estate ledgers for the 1840's and 50's for work done on the farms as well as rent paid; John Hawkins seems to have received regular subscriptions from the Duke of Wellington on behalf of the Baughurst Clothing Fund. I also found that there was a William Hawkins who rented a cottage and garden at Wolverton (for £3 p.a.) during the period 1836-64 (and possibly longer); I do not know whether or not this was another relation, but I imagine you will be interested to know of his existence.

I must point out that the cataloguing of the Wellington Estate Collection (which is very large) has only recently been begun, and it is possible that there is further material relating to your family (perhaps a rental agreement or lease) which has yet to be fully unearthed. I hope however that you will find the information which I have been able to give of interest and use, and I might add that you would be welcome to come and see the material here at the University Library, next time you visit this country.
