**Obituary**

"Bob" Hodges, after a long illness, died in Basingstoke hospital surrounded by his family and was buried at St. Stephen's Baughurst on 1st October. # GP retires after 32 years

**A TADLEY** doctor is preparing to prescribe his last pill after looking after the health of local residents for more than 30 years.

Doctor John Hollingshead moved to the area in 1970 for a year of training at the Wessex House surgery in Silchester Road, which later moved to Franklin Avenue and was renamed Holmwood Health Centre. He was made a partner at the practice a year

later and has been senior partner for the last 10 years.

Now, after 32 years, Dr Hollingshead is ready for a change, although he has no intention of leading a quiet life.

"I have all sorts of plans," he said. "I want to do an Open University degree course in meteorology."

"And I want to learn to use computers properly. My patients will think that is very funny - I

haven't got a clue when it comes to computers.

"My sons are always booking flights on the internet and I get very cross that I can't."

Dr Hollingshead - who celebrated his 60th birthday on Wednesday - will officially leave the surgery on September 1, when his replacement, Doctor Harriet Walford, will take over his patients.

"I shall feel very lost, I'm sure," he said.

"I will miss the staff and my

patients and I don't mind them knowing that. That is why I have been here all this time. But I think 32 years is long enough to have done one job.

"It gets more difficult to keep up to date as the years go by. Both medicine and the health service are changing dramatically and I find some of the changes difficult to adjust to."

"The changes will come very fast in the next few years and it is probably time for someone else to take over."

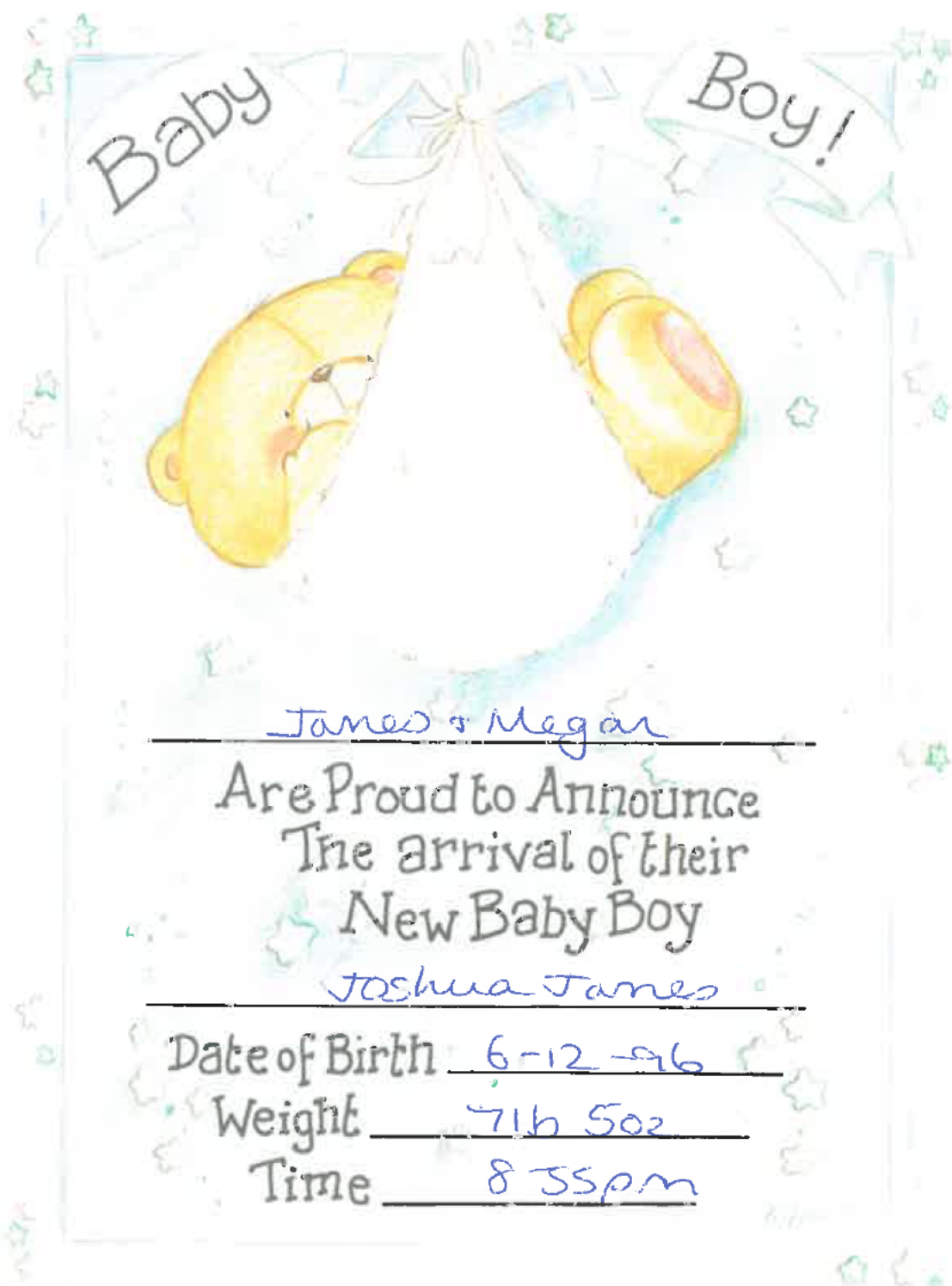

# John Alleby Hopkins

THE cremation takes place today at Reading of Mr John Alleby Hopkins, 77, of Tadley, who volunteered as a glider-pilot in the Second World War and who was seconded to a daring mission that was cancelled, to land troops in the centre of Paris at the Champs Elysees.

Mr Hopkins subsequently took part in the Arnhem operation, where he was wounded and taken prisoner.

He joined the Royal Army Service Corps at the start of the war and went to France, eventually being caught up in the retreat of Dunkirk, where he was left stranded on the beaches.

Making his way along the coast, he was taken off from a small coastal village.

Born at Seaford, he trained as an engineer and worked on the Cross-Channel ferries at Newhaven.

In 1953 he joined the Atomic Weapons' Research Establishment at Aldermaston, making his home at Huntsmoor Road, Tadley.

For many years, with his wife Ivy, he ran a private dancing school at Tadley.

In addition to his widow, he leaves a son and daughter, Tony and Anne, four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

# Dr Henry Hulme

THE death has occurred at the age of 82 of Dr Henry Hulme, former chief of research at the Atomic Weapons Research Establishment at Aldermaston.

A gifted mathematician and physicist, he played a leading role in the development of the British nuclear deterrent.

He went to New Zealand as Rector of Canterbury University College, Christchurch, returning to England in 1954 to join the research team at Aldermaston.

He contributed greatly as a top-class theoretical physicist and gave much advice in solving the problems connected with the development of a fusion weapon and the nuclear processes entailed.

This proceeded with

much haste, leading up to Britain exploding her first thermonuclear bomb in the Christmas Islands in 1957.

In 1959 he was promoted chief of nuclear research and remained in the post until 1973, living locally at Baughurst.

This job involved much administration but he continued to be involved in theoretical nuclear research.

One of the problems occupying his attention was of detecting underground nuclear explosions during the period when test-bans had been declared by Britain, America and the Soviet Union.

Born at Stockport and educated at Manchester Grammar School, Gon-

ville and Caius College, Cambridge, he stayed on at the university as a research student, taking his doctorate in 1932 and in the following year being elected a Fellow of the college.

After a period of study at Leipzig University he became chief assistant at the Royal Observatory, Greenwich, a post he retained until 1945 although his service was broken through the Second World War in which he served as director of operational research for the Royal Navy.

When the war ended he remained a senior Government scientist and he was appointed scientific adviser to the Air Ministry.

# Alice in one hundred land

A NICE cup of tea and plenty of fresh air - that's what Silchester centenarian Alice Hunt believes is the secret to a long life.

However, when family, friends and neighbours joined her to celebrate her 100th birthday on Wednesday, champagne was the only tippie in her glass.

It was a memorable occasion for young-at-heart Alice who was presented with a sackful of cards, flowers and presents.

Most pleasing for the great-grandmother was her telegram from the Queen, which she claims was her main aim for reaching the milestone.

Widow Alice is still very active and spends her days knitting, completing crosswords and regularly walking in the garden.

But after reaching the milestone birthday, she has vowed she will "sit back and take things easy now".

Alice, who calls herself a "Hampshire Hog", believes she has led a happy life.

One of five children, she was

born at Bunkers Farm, Rotherwick.

As a youngster she attended Odham Grammar School and trained as a teacher, but had to put this on hold after her father's death.

At the age of 25, Alice married husband Alec and later had two children, John and Kathleen.

She moved to Silchester during the Second World War in 1942. From there, she began her teaching career at Burnham Cope Infant School.

Alice moved to a house in Hydes Platt with her brother James after she was widowed in 1960.

She remained in Silchester until the summer of this year when she moved in with her daughter Kathleen and son-in-law Arthur in Wootton St Lawrence.

THE Hurst Community College in Baughurst celebrates its 50th anniversary this year and the school is inviting former staff and pupils back for a grand reunion.

It opened as a secondary modern school in September 1957 in response to expansion at the nearby Atomic Weapons Establishment (AWE).

With many new staff arriving at AWE from all over the country, existing educational facilities were unable to cope with the influx of new families to the area.

The original 200 pupils who turned up for lessons on the opening day were promptly sent home as desks and chairs had failed to arrive. But within a week, the school was up and running.

In the early 1970s, in common with many schools at the time, The Hurst became a comprehensive, at the same time achieving its highest-ever number of pupils - around 1,500.

By the late 1970s, Baughurst's main seat of learning had been designated a community school, making its facilities available to the wider community.

Now The Hurst is home to a wide range of activ-

ities, with adult education classes in everything from Spanish to golf, judo and karate teaching and a 500-member gym, as well as numerous after-school clubs. The school also hosts Miss Polly's creche and 65-place nursery.

The Hurst's valuable facilities are now utilised not just during school hours but also from 6pm to 11pm, seven days a week.

The 50th anniversary celebrations will be held on Saturday, July 7.

Being a specialist science college, The Hurst will hold a Science Fair during the day, to which the whole community is welcome to get involved with some hands-on science activities.

From 7pm to midnight, there will be a grand reception, to which former staff and pupils are invited. It will feature a version of the school's first-ever drama production, *Twelfth Night*, introduced by former pupil Terry Hoyles, who starred in the original 1958 production and is now a school governor.
