Location Information:

Caudry is a town 10 kilometres east of Cambrai on the south side of the main road to Le Cateau. From the Cambrai-Le Cateau road (the N 43) take the dual carriageway into Caudry town. Follow this road for 1100 metres to a traffic light controlled junction. Turn left and follow this road for approximately 225 metres to a small road on the right (the first CWGC sign is at this junction). The cemetery lies on the left side of the road after travelling 100 metres.

Historical Information:

Caudry town was the scene of part of the Battle of Le Cateau on the 26th August 1914, and from that date it remained in German hands until the 10th October 1918, when it was captured by the 37th Division. It had been a German centre for medical units, and during October 1918 and the following five months the 21st, 3rd, 19th and 49th Casualty Clearing Stations passed through it. The British Cemetery (originally called the German Cemetery Extension) was begun in October 1918 by the New Zealand Division and carried on by the Casualty Clearing Stations. It was completed after the Armistice by the concentration of graves from the German Cemetery and from Audencourt British Cemetery. At the same time the bodies of two French soldiers and one Italian were removed to other burial grounds. There are now over 700, 1914-18 war casualties commemorated in this site. Of these, over 50 are unidentified and special memorials are erected to four soldiers and one airman from the United Kingdom known to be buried among them. Another special memorial records the name of a soldier from the United Kingdom, buried in Fontaine-au-Pire Communal Cemetery, whose grave could not be found. The cemetery covers an area of 2,770 square metres and is enclosed partly by a rubble wall.

He leaves five sons, four daughters and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren. His wife, Lucy, died in April.

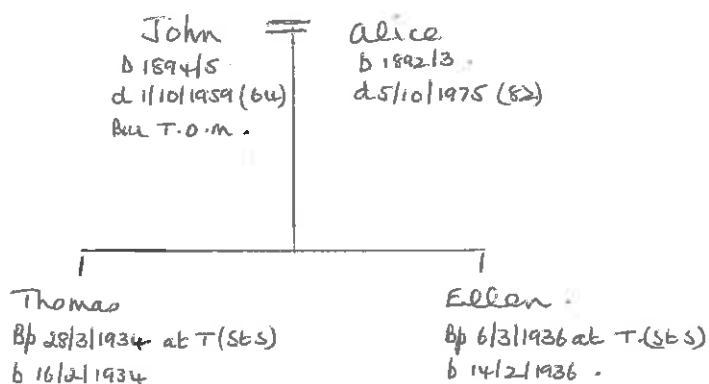
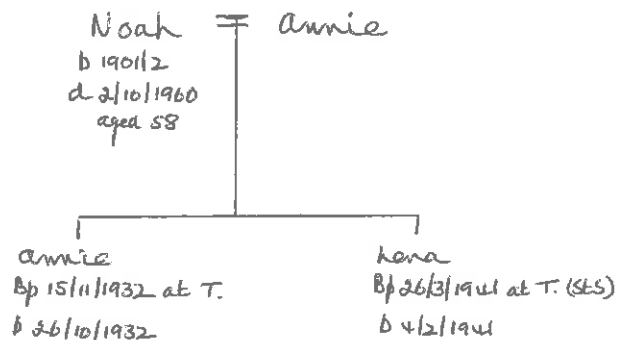
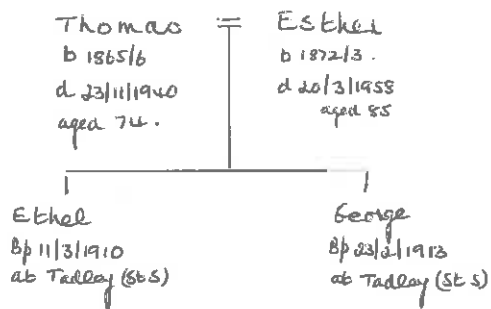
From the family's home in West Street, Tadley, eldest son Tommy Rawlings said: "He was a much-loved local character in Tadley and will be greatly missed."

Brian's goodbye to all creatures great and small

IT PROMISES to be anything but a dog's life for a vet as he looks forward to his retirement.

Brian Ray, 67, has finally hung up his stethoscope after more than 30 years' service to animals in Tadley and Basingstoke.

Mr Ray, who lives next door to his former surgery in West Street, Tadley, has already been semi-retired for a couple of years.

But a Christmas break in Spain with wife Monique convinced him that it was time to leave his younger colleagues to carry on the practice without him.

"I'm just enjoying not having to get up in the morning and not having to

think about what I'm going to do during the day."

After working in Salisbury for eight years, Mr Ray became a partner in a practice in Worting Road, Basingstoke, in 1958.

After operating part-time from a church hall in Tadley, the practice expanded and built a permanent surgery in West Street in 1961.

Although initially concentrating on large animals, the decline in farming and the expanding population of Tadley saw the practice focusing more and more on family pets.

Mr Ray narrowly missed out on a place in the Guinness Book of Records after delivering 17 mastiff pups

by Caesarian section.

Sadly one of the pups died, meaning that they only equalled the world record and denied Mr Ray his place in posterity.

"It was a very mucky operation," recalled Mr Ray.

"I was working with two nurses—I was hooking them pups out and sidling them across."

"You needed your rubber boots!"

Another favourite memory concerned a dog which became a frequent visitor to the Tadley surgery.

The animal loved scavenging for food in rubbish bins but kept getting its tongue trapped in tins by the lid.

In future, however, the only dogs he will be worried about are his own pets, labrador cross breed bitchies, Athena and Bou-Bou.

Though he will miss the animals and owners he has come to know well over the years, Mr Ray has no doubts that he is making the right decision.

"I've been terribly lucky. I've done everything I wanted and enjoyed every moment but I'm enjoying the chance to relax."

AA's star faced sex letter ordeal

Victim keen to work on after 'chilling' experience

REBECCA Rees, the friendly face of the Automobile Association on television, has vowed to carry on working after her life was turned upside down by a sex pest.

The brave Public Relations executive was sent a series of 'alarming and disturbing' letters by the obsessed fan, who saw her on TV.

She is known to thousands of people locally from her many TV and media appearances as the organisation's regional spokesperson, a Basingstoke-based post she has held for over three years.

But speaking yesterday (Wednesday), after the 42-year-old Popley culprit had been convicted, she told the Observer that it was precisely because of this role that she had suffered the ordeal, which she described as 'an unfortunate by-product of my job.'

Ms Rees, who was not in court for this week's hearing, also made it very clear that she had no intention of letting the traumatic experience drive her from her job, saying that media exposure would 'continue to play a major part' in her role at the AA.

At yesterday's hearing at

Basingstoke magistrates court, John David Hall, of Shelley Close, pleaded guilty to harassing Ms Rees between May 7-12 of this year.

The court heard that Hall sent two letters on May 10 and another letter on May 11 to Ms Rees' place of work in Priestley Road after seeing her on television. All the letters were of a sexual nature.

Gail Toulon, prosecuting, said the victim had found the letters 'chilling and disturbing'.

She added: "He kept newspaper clippings of females and chat up lines and blue jokes in his home."

Nigel Bourne, defending, said it was a 'very public harassment'.

He added: "This doesn't involve harassment of somebody known to my client but someone he saw on the television. The individual doesn't know who my client is."

He said that Hall, who is receiving treatment at Parklands Hospital, had difficulty communicating and had no intention of pursuing the harassment of his

victim any further.

The case was adjourned for sentencing until July 12 for psychiatric reports but the magistrates told the court that a jail sentence had not been ruled out.

Hall was granted bail on condition that he did not contact Ms Rees in any way.

After the hearing, the AA's security manager Andy Seaward, said: "The AA would take any other incident like this very seriously and would always report it to the police, as we did in this case. Safety of our staff is paramount and harassment won't be tolerated."

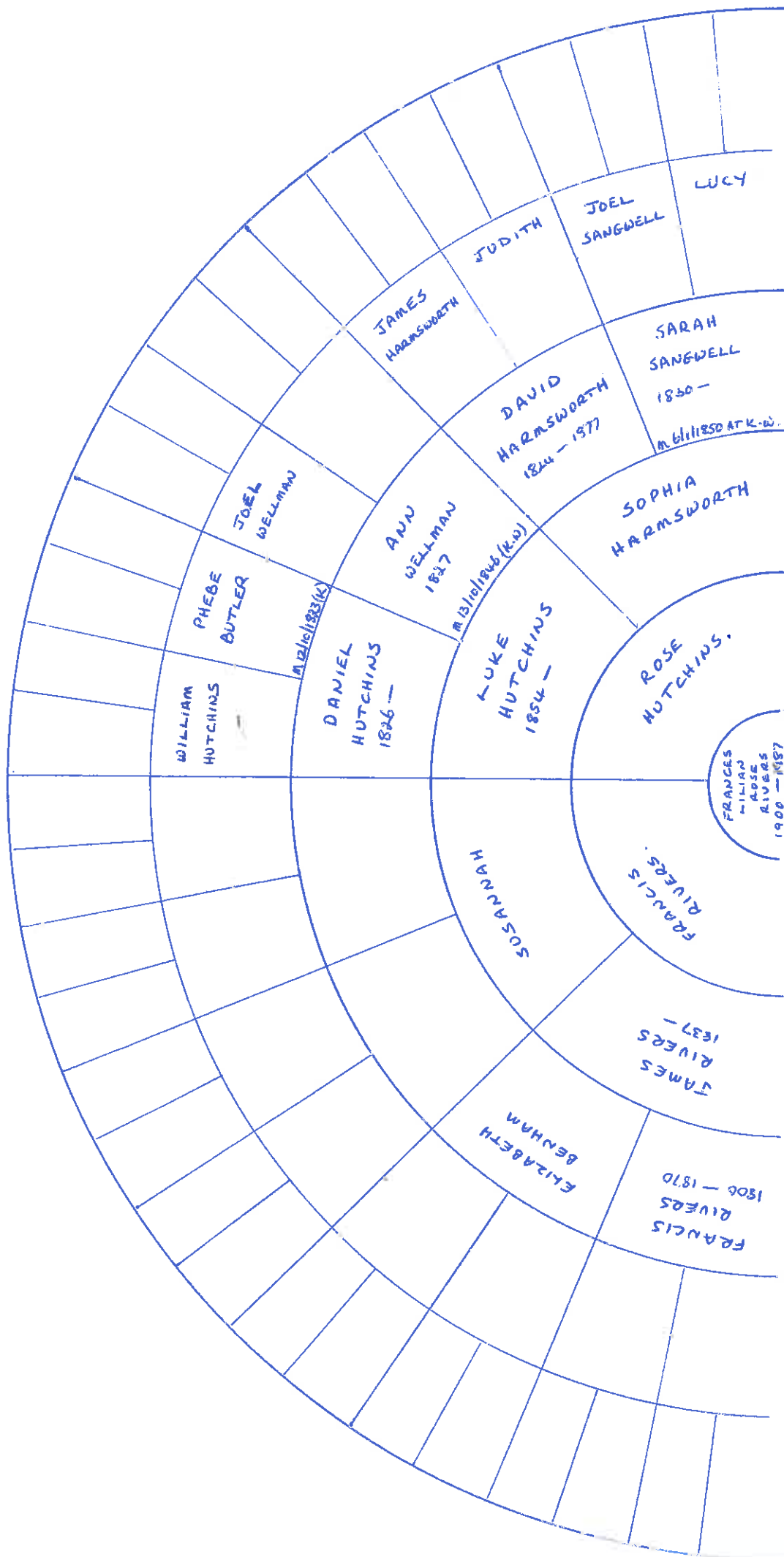

A fellow-researcher has passed on your name and address suggesting that you could possibly assist me with my own research into the distaff side of my fathers' family.

My great-grandmother, Emily Smith, was born at Pamber around 1792/93, the daughter of Richard Smith. In 1863 she married Samuel Rivers of Aldermaston where their first 3 sons were born, after which the family took up residence at Emily's birthplace of Pamber. Here 3 more children were born, my grandmother, Winifred Rose, (3.3.1878), being the only girl.

Grandmother married Frank Blockley of Bentley, Hants., at the Priory, Monk Sherborne on May 25th. 1897. He was a seaman in the Royal Navy and, whilst he was away at sea, she continued to live at her parents home, "Rose Cottage", Pamber Heath. Here my father, Albert Frank Blockley was born on

28th June 1902

For some months past I have been attempting to locate the burial place of Samuel and Emily and that of my grandparents' first child, Mabel Jessie Stockley, who died in 1899 aged 14 months. To date I have been unsuccessful in this, despite help from various local sources, including Hants. Genealogical Society, of which I am a member.

I am also interested in the theory, not proven by me, that Emily, or perhaps her parents, may have belonged to the gypsy family, Smiths.

I would be most grateful if you can pass on any information on this family, however small, and would appreciate it if you would use the enclosed S.A.E. to reply.

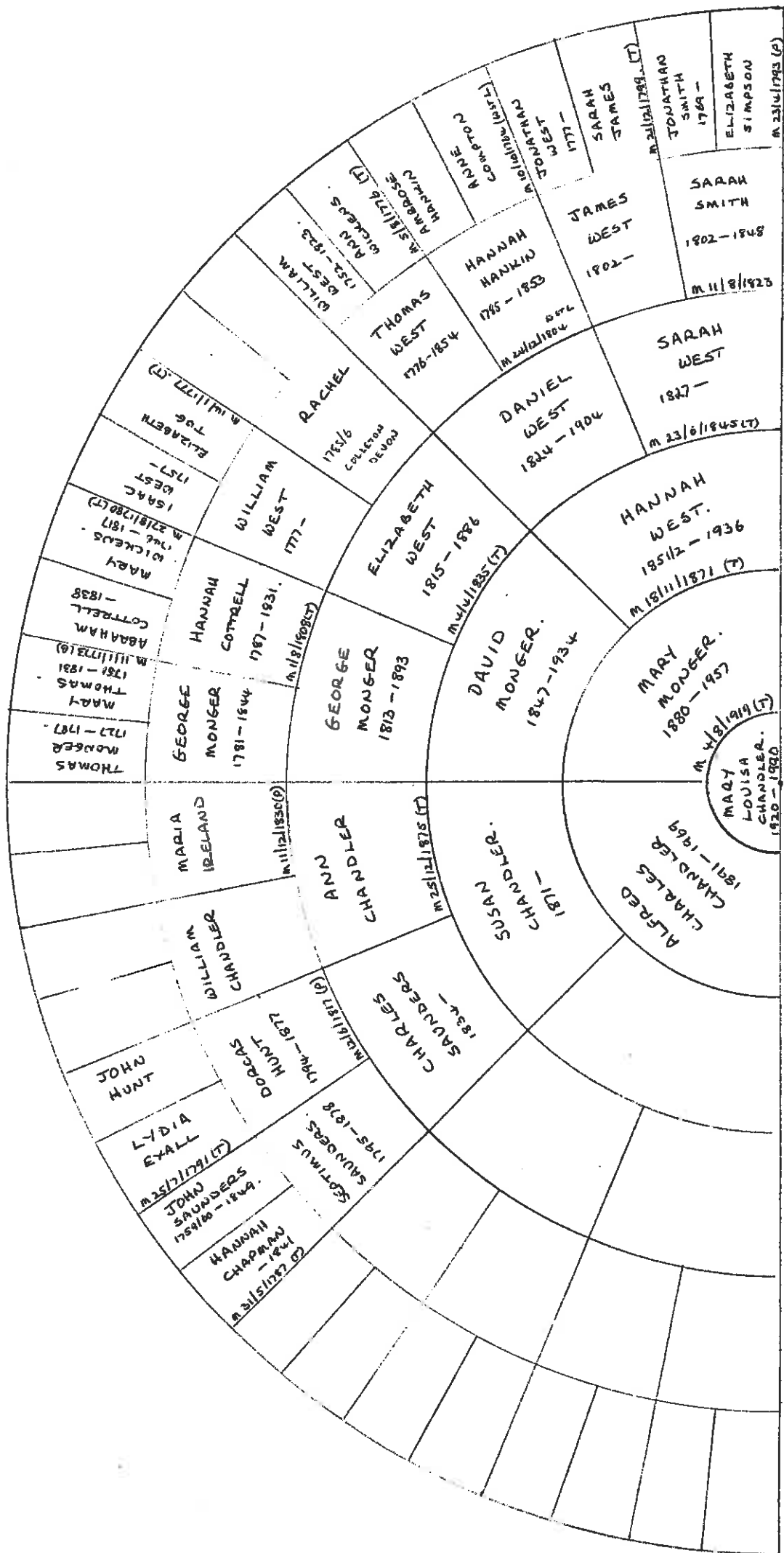

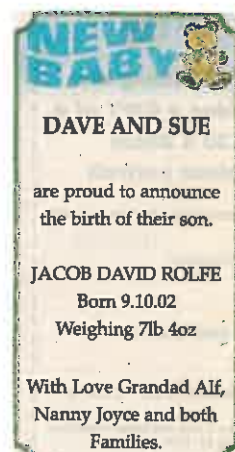

OBITUARY

Mr Teddy Russell

MANY friends and former colleagues of Teddy Russell crowded into St Andrew's Church, Sherborne St John, for the funeral of one of Basingstoke's outstanding characters.

Teddy, as he was known to many, had spent the final years of his life in the village.

He died, aged 90 at Basingstoke hospital a few days after suffering a stroke.

At the service, former Mayor of Basingstoke Mr Harold Redstall, paid tribute to the tremendous work he had done for charity and for the entertainment he provided for the war wounded at Park Prewett.

Teddy was born at Houghton, near Stockbridge, and his parents moved to Old Basing when he was a child of two, subsequently living in Tadley.

From Tadley, where Teddy started school, his parents moved to Radlett, then to St Mary Cray, Kent, and later to Little Faringdon, where Teddy's musical career started after his father bought him a melodian.

It was here, at the age of 12, that he started work on a farm.

His family moved back

to the Basingstoke area eventually to live at Wellock's Farm, Old Basing, with Teddy becoming a milkman for the Basingstoke round.

In the 1920s, soon after marrying Elsie Paice, a postman's daughter, and living in Cross Street, he became a motor roundsman for Wote Street grocers, Tyrell, Smith and Gripper.

At this time, he began his long stint as an entertainer with the Ensign Band, Eric Gill and His Band and eventually forming his own Teddy Russell Dance Band, which played regularly at a number of village halls in the area.

In 1937 he went to work for Kelvin, Bottomley and Baird—now Smiths' Industries, where he organised entertainments.

After the start of the Second World War he became entertainments officer and welfare officer for the Folland Aircraft Company, Hamble, returning to Kelvin, Bottomley and Baird in 1944.

Almost immediately, he started BEST—Basingstoke Entertainment Service for the Troops with many concerts staged at Park Prewett and Rooksdown.

In 1947 Teddy was made redundant at Kelvin, Bottomley and Baird.

Then taking a job as a meter reader for Southern Electricity, he became known to hundreds of households.

When he retired in 1967 he broke up his band to freelance with other local musicians, continuing to entertain until 1986.

He often provided music for the Basingstoke Carnival Mardi Gras in the Market Square and with his band played at Old People's Homes and on Christmas morning at the old Shrubbery Maternity Home.

But it was the handicapped he particularly liked to entertain and also to stage charity events.

In recent years Teddy spent much of his time painting and regularly had studies displayed at Basingstoke Art Club exhibitions.

He was a former member of the Royal Antedeluvian Order of Buffaloes and was also closely associated with the Wote Street Club.

A widower since 1961, he leaves a son and daughter, Brian and Jean, 10 grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren.

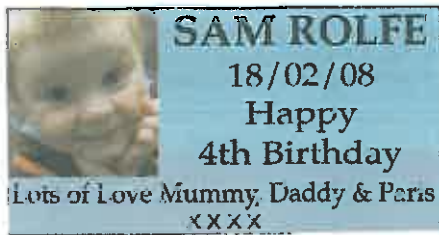

Thanksgiving service for Mr Ian Sapp

A THANKSGIVING service for the life of Mr Ian Sapp was held at Trinity Methodist Church, Sarum Hill, Basingstoke.

Mr Sapp, who was 78, died at St Michael's Hospice, Basingstoke, recently, after a long illness. A cremation service has already taken place.

A businessman well known in the town, he was managing director of A J Sapp & Son, the Hackwood Road building firm, until it was merged with Goodall, Barnard and Clayton.

A Basingstoke man and a devout member of the London Street United Reformed Church throughout his life, Mr Sapp was educated at Tettenhall College before

serving an apprenticeship in building with a Southampton firm.

At London Street, he was secretary of the Sunday school, a post formerly held by his father, Mr Arkas Sapp, and for six years was church secretary. He was also an elder.

He was a founder member of the 8th Basingstoke Congregational Scout Troop, formed in 1928, and eventually became group Scout leader and group chairman. In 1933, he attended the World Scout Jamboree in Hungary.

During the war years, he served with the Royal Engineers in Burma and India.

For many years, he was a member of the National Federation of Building Trades

Employers and he was president of the Basingstoke branch in 1953.

After retiring from Goodall, Barnard & Clayton, he gave much time to voluntary work, driving for the blind and for the Meals on Wheels service. He was a member of the Probus Club of Basingstoke.

Until he moved to Darlington Road, he had lived at Cliddesden Road, Basingstoke, for 39 years.

Mr Sapp leaves a widow Dorothy, two sons Stewart and Alexander, a daughter Sheelagh, nine grandchildren, and a sister Mary.

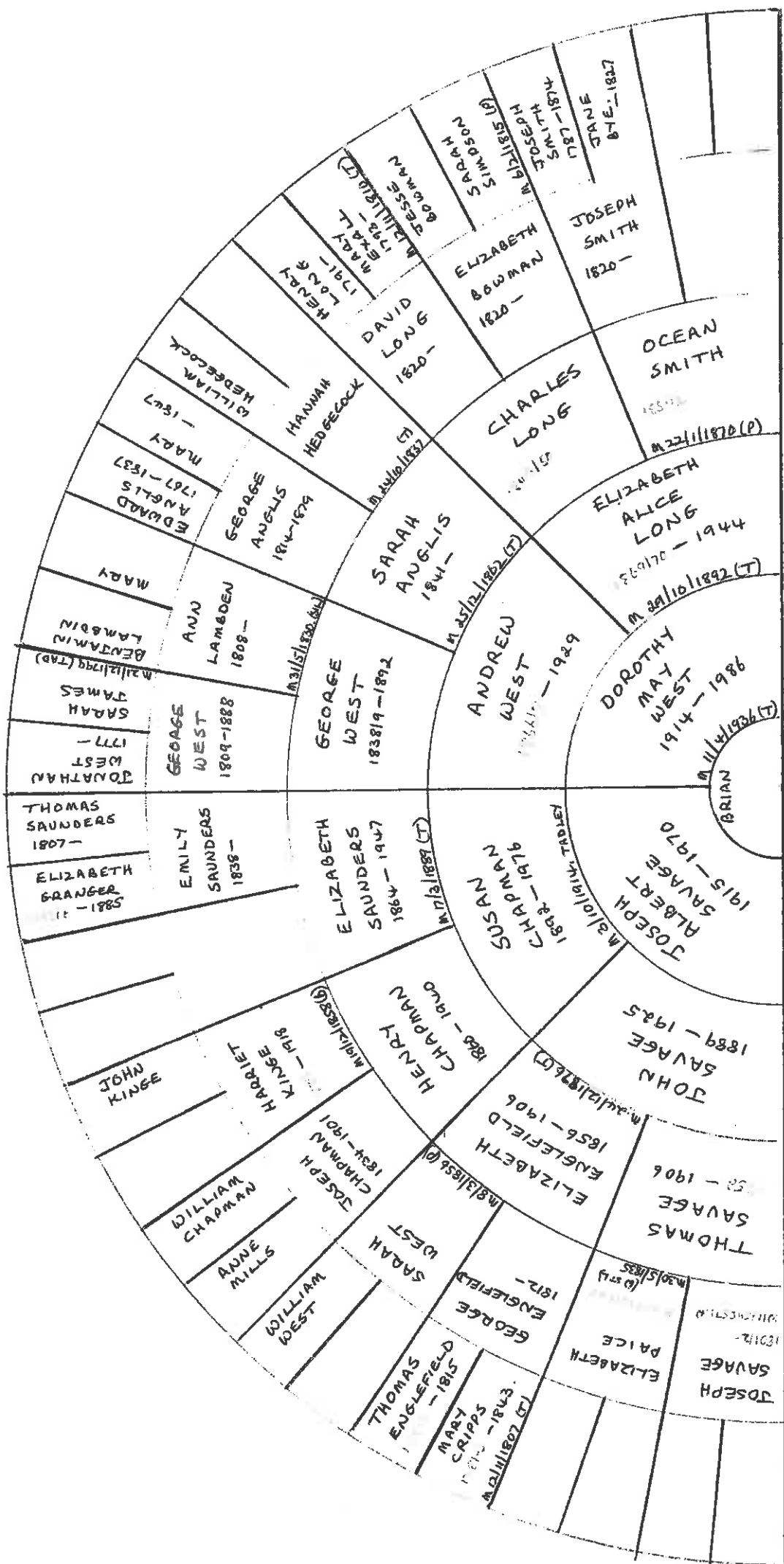
